- Manuel Beltre delivered a two-out, two-strike walk-off single in the 10th inning to push the Blue Jays past Jupiter 6-5 on Thursday night.
- In his return from the IL, catcher Nic Deschamps went 2-3 with a 2-run homer in his first at bat of the game, in the third inning.
- After surrendering four runs, Jays' starter Grant Rogers finished his outing with two scoreless frames.
- Trailing 4-3 in the seventh, Dunedin took their first lead of the game on Yhoangel Aponte's two-out single to left field.
- Jupiter tied the game in the ninth, as Angelo DiSpigna reached on a pop-up that turned into a double to start the inning, and later scored on a sac fiv.
- After Keiner Leon worked a 1-2-3 top of the 10th, Beltre punched a ball into the gap with the bases loaded to end the game in the bottom half.

EXTRA SATISFYING

Dunedin's 10-inning victory last night marked its first extra-innings win of the season (1-3). It was the Blue Jays' first walk-off win since Manuel Beltre's two-run walk-off homer on April 7 vs Lakeland. Since that walk-off win, the Jays had been walked off five times, including three times last week at Fort Myers.

LOOKING FOR A STREAK

The Blue Jays will have an opportunity for a third straight win this evening. Dunedin hasn't won three straight games since they strung together a six-game win streak April 6-12. Since that win streak, the Jays have won back-to-back games just twice.

LATE MAGIC

Dunedin continued its trend of scoring late runs last night with Yhoangel Aponte's go-ahead single in the seventh inning. The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in 13 of their last 14 games. The Blue Jays hold a +11 run differential in the final three innings this season (61 runs scored, 50 runs allowed).

JAYS JUICE

The Blue Jays have homered in five straight games - the team's longest homer streak of the season. Across that stretch, six different players have gone deep. Dunedin ranks third in the Florida State League with 23 homers.

BACK IN A BIG WAY

After spending a month on the injured list with a shoulder injury, Blue Jays catcher Nic Deschamps went 2-3 with a homer, RBI triple and a walk in his first game since April 14 on Thursday. Deschamps has a hit in all five games he's played to open the season.

HITS ON HITS ON HITS

The Blue Jays offense has tallied eight or more hits in four straight games. The streak is the first of its kind for Dunedin this season. Across the last 10 games, the Blue Jays are hitting .241 as a team after hitting .163 in the prior 10 games.

STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION

Blue Jays outfielder Jean Joseph is off to a strong start in Single-A, having reached in all 15 games he's played with Dunedin. The on-base streak is Dunedin's longest streak of the season and one of five active on base streaks 15 games or longer in the league. Joseph has batted leadoff in each of the last six games he's played.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

24 of the Blue Jays 36 games this season have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 9-15 record in those games.

BRAVO, BULLPEN

The Blue Jays' bullpen has turned in nine innings of one-run, three-hit ball across the last two games. Wednesday's shutout effort marked the first time in five games the bullpen did not surrender a run.

FERNANDO'S FIP

Tonight's starter, righty Fernando Perez, comes into action with a 3.90 ERA, but a 2.63 FIP. FIP, fielding independent pitching, calculates what a pitcher's ERA would look like if the pitcher were to experience league average results on balls in play. The 1.27 point difference between Perez's ERA and FIP (the 10th largest in the league), indicates Perez has been unlucky through six starts.

- Native of Rivas, Nicaragua located in southwestern Nicaragua. Also the hometown of MLB reliever Erasmo Ramirez (currently with Tampa Bay).
- Is a consensus top-30 Toronto prospect due to impressive command of strike zone... often described as "polished."
- Boasts best control in the Blue Jays' system, according to Baseball America's 2024 Best Tools list.
- Arsenal features a mid-90s fastball, changeup, curveball, and slider.
