**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn split Sunday's doubleheader at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones captured the opener, 6-4, before dropping the finale, 6-4...In the lid-lifter, Brooklyn took the lead for good with a 4-run 4th inning...CF **Carson Benge** reached base 4 times with 2 singles and 2 walks...1B **Jacob Reimer** drove in a pair with a single and a walk...3B **Jesús Báez** tallied 2 hits and drove in 3...In the nightcap, Jersey Shore jumped out to a 4-0 lead...Brooklyn trimmed a 4-run deficit to 1, but no closer...SS **Boston Baro** posted a triple and a 2-run home run...RF **Troy Schreffler Jr.** added 2 hits, including a triple and an RBI single.

**ALL BÁEZ ON ME:** After recovering from knee surgery, INF **Jesús Báez** has slowly returned to form...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in Friday's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF **A.J. Ewing** won Player of the Week last week, it is the first time Brooklyn hitters have won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native has reached safely in 18-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .393/.500/.590/1.090 with 13 runs scored, 3 doubles, 3 home runs, 18 RBI, 3 stolen bases, and 12 walks to 7 strikeouts...Báez also enters Tuesday with a 10-game hitting streak since May 15 vs. Winston-Salem, going 16-for-30 (.533) at the plate with 9 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, 12 RBI and 7 walks to 1 strikeout...Last Tuesday, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF **Ryan Clifford** on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore...During May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (21) and is 3rd in batting average (.377), on-base percentage (.482), OPS (1.076), and hits (26), 5th in slugging percentage (.594), and tied for 7th in total bases (41).

**BENGE IT LIKE CARSON:** OF **Carson Benge** has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on MiLB.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore...The 2024 first-round pick enters Tuesday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in triples (4)...He is also 2nd in OPS (.991), tied for 2nd in runs scored (35) and doubles (11), 3rd in slugging percentage (.543) and on-base percentage (.448), 4th in extra-base hits (19), 5th in walks (31), tied for 5th in total bases (76), and 6th in hits (45)...The 22-year-old is riding high an 11-game hitting streak since May 8 at Asheville snapped last Friday, but has reached base safely in 18-straight games since May 3 vs. Wilmington, hitting .361/.518/.705/1.223 with 19 runs scored, 6 doubles, 3 triples, 3 home runs, 17 RBI, 19 walks to 13 strikeouts, and 7 stolen bases.

**CAN EW BELIEVE IT?:** IF/OF **A.J. Ewing** has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...and was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week last Monday...In 5 games vs. Winston-Salem, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF **Nick Lorusso** and LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024...Entering play on Tuesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is 3rd in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.373) and stolen bases (32), tied for 3rd in triples (6), 9th in on-base percentage (.462), and 10th in OPS (1.004)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (18)...He is also 2nd in hits (31), tied for 4th in triples (2), tied for 5th in runs scored (19), 6th in batting average (.352), 8th in on-base percentage (.426), and tied for 10th in total bases (43)...The 2023 4th-round pick enters Tuesday riding a 29-game on-base streak since April 18...During the on-base streak, Ewing has hit .357/.451/.500/.951 with 24 runs scored, 5 doubles, 4 triples, a home run, 16 RBI, 20 walks, and 25 stolen bases.

**REIM TIME:** INF **Jacob Reimer** remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...The former 4th-round pick recorded more RBI (8) in the first 2 games of 2025 than he had in 25 outings (7) in an injury-plagued 2024...Entering play on Tuesday, Reimer is tied for 2nd in Minor League Baseball in extra-base hits (26), tied for 6th in doubles (16), 8th in OPS (1.008), and 10th in slugging percentage (.596)...The former 4th-round pick leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (37), OPS (1.008), extra-base hits (26), and doubles (16), and is tied for 1st in hits (50)...Reimer is also 2nd in slugging percentage (.596), total bases (93), and RBI (34), 3rd in batting average (.321), tied for 5th in triples (3), 6th in on-base percentage (.412), and tied for 8th in home runs (7).

**REHAB REPORT:** The Cyclones have a pair of rehabbers on their current roster...RHP **Frankie Montas** is scheduled to make his 2nd Major League rehab start on Thursday night vs. Aberdeen on SNY...The 32-year-old is currently on New York's 60-day injured list with a right lat strain...Montas made his 1st start on Saturday at Jersey Shore, allowing 2 runs on 2 hits, walking 2 and striking out 1, over 1.1 innings and 37 pitches...The Dominican native signed a 2-year, \$34 million deal with the Mets in December...OF **Rafael Ortega** rejoins Brooklyn on Tuesday for his 2nd Minor League rehab stint with the club in 2025...The 34-year-old appeared in 6 games for the Cyclones between April 12-20, going 2-for-24 (.083) at the plate with a double and 2 RBI...Ortega signed a Minor League deal with New York in November.

**SWIPER KEEP SWIPING:** Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win over Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Tuesday with 100 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (120)...The 100 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 45 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 28 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 72 steals through 45 games...The Cyclones' single-season franchise record is 181 steals set in 2024.

**vs. ABERDEEN:** After taking 4-of-7 from Jersey Shore, Brooklyn returns home for a 6-game series with the Iron-Birds...Aberdeen enters the series after splitting a 6-game homestand with Wilmington...The IronBirds are 12-12 on the road this season and dropped 4-of-6 to Brooklyn in Aberdeen from April 15-20...Aberdeen boasts 8 of the Orioles' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Vance Honeycutt** (5), INF **Griff O'Ferrall** (7), RHP **Michael Forret** (8), RHP **Trey Gibson** (15), INF **Aron Estrada** (16), C **Ethan Anderson** (18), INF **Leandro Arias** (21), OF **Austin Overn** (30)...Forret is currently on the injured list...In 269 meetings since 2002, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 141-128 (.524)...Brooklyn is 72-71 (.503) in 143 games at Maimonides Park.

**DOUBLE THE FUN:** The Cyclones and BlueClaws played their 2nd doubleheader in 3 days on Sunday afternoon, splitting the contests...Last Friday, Brooklyn swept a twinbill from Jersey Shore, capturing the opener, 10-1, and the nightcap, 9-3...The 'Clones outscored Jersey Shore, 19-4, and outhit them, 23-9, in the double-dip...Brooklyn split its first doubleheader in 2025, losing Game 1 vs. Hudson Valley on April 12, 2-0, and winning Game 2, 2-1...Brooklyn is now 1-0-2 in doubleheaders in 2025, holding a 4-2 overall mark...In 2024, the Cyclones were 2-1-3 in doubleheaders, having a 7-5 record overall...Friday marked Brooklyn's first doubleheader sweep since August 11, 2024, vs. Hudson Valley...The Cyclones won the opener, 4-2, and the finale, 3-1.

**HOW SWEEP IT IS:** With May 18's 7-6 walk-off victory vs. Winston-Salem in 10 innings, the Cyclones completed their first 6-game sweep since 2022 and their first at home since 2021...Brooklyn had not completed a 6-game sweep since taking all 6 contests at Jersey Shore from August 23-28, 2022...The Cyclones outscored the BlueClaws, 53-18, in that series...It was Brooklyn's first 6-game sweep on Coney Island since July 20-25, 2021, vs. Wilmington...The 'Clones outscored the 'Rocks, 41-22, in that set...Brooklyn's 6-game winning streak was snapped Tuesday at Jersey Shore...It was the first time the team had won 6-straight games since September 3-9, 2022, vs. Wilmington and at Winston-Salem...The Cyclones clinched the Second Half South Atlantic League North Division crown during that win streak...Additionally, the Cyclones' 30-15 record through 45 games is tied for the franchise's 2nd best record through 45 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn opened the 2007 season with a 31-14 mark through 45 contests.

**KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING:** The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 45 games of the 2025 season on Sunday at Jersey Shore...Through Brooklyn's first 8 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 6-0-2 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 3-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13...The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 8-0-2 in a series of any length.

**MARCO POLO:** IF **Marco Vargas** has not stopped hitting since joining the Cyclones at the end of April...The 19-year-old has reached safely in all 20 games played with Brooklyn, and in all 33 contests he has appeared in this year between the Cyclones and Single-A St. Lucie...During the 33-game on-base streak, Vargas is hitting .288/.403/.364/.767 with 25 runs scored, 4 doubles, a triple, a home run, 17 RBI, 23 walks, and 10 stolen bases.

**HOMER HAPPY:** Brooklyn's offense erupted in the 2nd inning on May 9 at Asheville...RF **Eli Serrano III**, DH **A.J. Ewing**, and CF **Carson Benge** clubbed back-to-back-to-back home runs with 1 out in the frame off Asheville's RHP **Yeriel Santos**...It marked just the 2nd time Brooklyn had hit 3-straight home runs in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...2B **Luke Ritter**, 1B **Joe Genord**, and C **José Mena** first accomplished the feat with back-to-back-to-back shots in the 6th inning on June 20, 2021, at Wilmington...SS **Jesús Báez** added a 4th home run in the frame, marking the first time in MiLB's Digital Era that the Cyclones powered 4 long balls in a single inning...The feat has been accomplished just 2 other times in MiLB this season...Miami's Double-A Pensacola accomplished the feat with 4 homers in the 3rd inning on April 26 vs. Knoxville...Chicago-NL's Triple-A Iowa blasted 5 home runs in the 7th inning on April 16 vs. St. Paul...Brooklyn enters Tuesday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in home runs (41)...Since 2005, only the 2021 team (49) has hit home runs through the team's first 45 games.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY:** On this date in 2022, the Cyclones set a franchise record for runs scored in a single game during a 20-6 rout at Bowling Green...Brooklyn powered 5 home runs in the game...RF **Joe Suozzi**, LF **Rowdew Jordan**, C **Matt O'Neill**, CF **Jaylen Palmer**, and DH **Brandon McIlwain** all went deep...All 9 Cyclones batters produced at least 1 hit and 7 of 9 brought in at least 1 run...Suozzi finished with 3 hits and 5 RBI, while 2B **José Peroza** added 4 hits and 3 RBI...In 2023, RHP **Christian Scott** tossed 5.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball, striking out 8, in a 7-2 win vs. Winston-Salem...RHPs **Joshua Cornielli** and **Wilkin Ramos** tallied 7 more K's out of the bullpen as part of Brooklyn's 15-strikeout performance.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 11 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), INF **Jesús Báez** (7), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (12), INF **Boston Baro** (13), INF **Marco Vargas** (14), RHP **Nate Dohm** (18), INF **Jacob Reimer** (20), C **Chris Suero** (21), OF **Eli Serrano III** (22) and C **Ronald Hernández** (26), and OF **A.J. Ewing** (27)...Of those 11, 5 have previous experience playing in Brooklyn...The Cyclones also possess 10 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per *Baseball America*...The list features Báez (3), Benge (7), Baro (15), Santucci (16), Vargas (17), Suero (20), Reimer (21), Dohm (23), Ewing (24), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (26)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from **Joe DeMayo**...Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Tuesday night at Jersey Shore...Yielded 2 runs on 4 hits over 4.1 innings...Walked a season-high-tying 3 and struck out 4...Induced a double play...Surrendered a solo home run to RF **Dylan Campbell** in the 2nd...Relieved by LHP **Ryan Ammons** with a runner at 3rd and 1 out in the bottom of the 5th and Brooklyn in front 3-2...Bequeathed runner did not score...Cyclones carried a 4-2 lead into the bottom of the 7th, but SS **Bryan Rincon** delivered a go-ahead grand slam for the BlueClaws in the bottom of the 7th...Brooklyn dropped the series opener, 6-4.

2025: Broke camp with Brooklyn...Did not receive a decision in his High-A debut, striking out a career-high 5 on 4/6 vs. WIL (2.2 IP, 3 H, R, ER, BB, 5 K)...Suffered the loss in his 1st appearance of the year in relief on 4/12-1 vs. HV (3.0 IP, 3 H, 2 R, ER, 3 BB, 4 K)...Earned the 1st win of his professional career in relief on 4/23 @JS (3.0 IP, 4 H, R, ER, 2 BB, 2 K)...Tossed a career-high 4.0 innings and tied a career-best with 5 K's in a no-decision on 5/1 vs. WIL (4.0 IP, 4 H, 4 R, 2 ER, 5 K)...Earned the win and struck out a career-best 9 over a career-long 5.0 innings on 5/13 vWS (5.0 IP, H, R, ER, 2 BB, 9 K).

WHAT'S IN A ROLE: Girton has split time in 2025 between Brooklyn's rotation and bullpen...The 23-year-old started the year in a piggyback tandem with RHP **Joel Diaz** before moving to the rotation full-time after LHP **Zach Thornton**'s transfer to Double-A Binghamton...In 3 starts, Girton has a 1-0 record and a 3.60 ERA (6 ER in 15.0 IP) with 12 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 23 strikeouts...In 2 appearances out of the bullpen, the right-hander is 1-1 with a 3.00 ERA (2 ER in 6.0 IP), 7 hits allowed, 5 walks, and 6 punchouts.

2024: Signed with the Mets on 7/20 and assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on 8/28...Made his professional debut in relief, striking out the side in order on 8/29 vs. Jupiter (1.0 IP, 3 K)...Took a no-decision in his first and only pro start on 9/3 at Clearwater (1.0 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 2 BB, 1 K)...In 3 appearances (1 start), did not receive a decision and tallied a 12.00 ERA (4 ER in 3.0 IP) with 5 hits, 4 walks, and 5 strikeouts.

OKLAHOMA! ON BROADWAY: Girton is one of three Oklahoma natives on the Cyclones' Opening Day roster...Girton (Gage, Okla.) joins RHP **Jace Beck** (Tuttle, Okla.) and OF **Carson Benge** (Yukon, Okla.) as Sooner State natives with Brooklyn.

BOOMER SOONER: Girton spent the 2024 collegiate season at the University of Oklahoma...Girton grew up about 177 miles northwest of the university in Gage, Okla... Corralled a 0-1 record with a 7.32 ERA (29 ER in 35.2 IP), 1 save, 44 hits, 31 walks, and 47 strikeouts in 16 appearances (10 starts) for the Sooners...In first outing as a Sooner, went 4.0 innings and surrendered 1 run on 3 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts in a win vs. No. 9 Tennessee on 2/17...Tossed 4.0 innings of 1-hit ball with 2 strikeouts in a win at TCU on 3/16...Started and struck out a pair in 2 postseason appearances vs. Kansas (5/24) and vs. UConn (6/2).

RED RAIDER NATION: The 23-year-old started his college career at Texas Tech University...During his 3 years with the Red Raiders, Girton compiled a 7-2 record with a 5.21 ERA (54 ER in 93.1 IP), 1 save, 77 hits, 57 walks, and 77 strikeouts in 42 outings (9 starts)...Named to the All-Big 12 Academic Second Team in 2023...Named Big 12 Pitcher of the Week on 2/20/23 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings out of the bullpen on Opening Day vs. Gonzaga...Had his 2022 season cut short due to injury.
