SERIES EVEN: The Delmarva Shorebirds bounced back from a shutout defeat on Tuesday with a 3-1 victory in another pitcher's duel on Wednesday. Each starter was excellent for their respective teams as **Moises Chace** tossed four shutout innings with no hits and six strikeouts while **Jose Ramirez** went five innings allowing an unearned run on one hit and four strikeouts. With the game tied at one in the bottom of the eighth, **Stiven Acevedo** delivered the goods for the Shorebirds with a base-hit into right field to score ahead the go-ahead run. **Samuel Basallo** added an extra insurance run with an RBI single following Acevedo to make it 3-1. **Reese Sharp** slammed the door, stranding the tying runs on the base paths with back-to-back to preserve a game two win for Delmarva.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Jared Beck gets the ball for his third start of the year and his second against Salem on Thursday night and he'll face off with **Jedixon Paez** who makes his third start as well and first against the Shorebirds. Paez has gone four innings in his first two starts against Carolina and Lynchburg and produced a solid line versus Carolina but was roughed up by Lynchburg last time out last Thursday by allowing 9 runs (6 earned) on 10 hits, taking the loss in a 13-4 defeat to the Hillcats.

BASALLO ON FIRE: Samuel Basallo has on a roll during his first month of action in Single-A as the 18 year old is second for the Carolina League lead in RBIs with 19 and held an RBI streak of six consecutive games until his run was snapped on Tuesday. Basallo has also been a strong defender at catcher and first base and has show-cased his strong arm behind home several times as he has thrown out 8 base stealers this season, good for fourth in the Carolina League. Delmarva as a team has caught a total of 14 base stealer which is also second most in the league behind Augusta (15).

SHARP ON THE MOUND: Reese Sharp is one of the top arms in the back of the Delmarva bullpen as the 20th Round pick from Indiana is tied for the team-high in strikeouts with 17 in just 9.2 innings on the mound, giving him a strong 15.8 K/9 innings. Sharp earned his first professional victory on Wednesday by retiring the final six batters and has struck out three or more batters in all five of his outings this season.

SWISS ARMY KNIFE: Adam Crampton has become a super utility defender for the Shorebirds as he started at five different position through the first 16 games. Crampton has made multiple starts at 3B, 2B, 1B, and LF. He made his first start at his natural position, shortstop on Wednesday night as the reigning Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year has become a reliable defender no matter where he's been in the field.

STARTER SUCCESS: The starting pitching staff for the Shorebirds has dealt a strong first two games against the Salem Red Sox as **Juan Nunez** and **Moises Chace** have combined to throw 9 innings in their two starts and have allowed no runs on just one hit with 13 strikeouts. The Delmarva pitching staff has been effective getting outs at the plate as they are currently 5th in the Carolina League with 170 Ks.

CLUTCH STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo has been off to a terrific start in his first full-season in Single-A as he's batting .328 through his first 14 starts of the year with multiple hits in seven of those starts, including a two double performance last Friday against the Fred Nats with a new career-high of 3 RBIs in the game. Acevedo has a hit in 12 of 15 games this season and has developed the clutch gene as he has three hits this season in the eighth inning or later that has either tied the game of given the Shorebirds the lead. All of those hits for Acevedo have come with two outs in the inning.

LATE INNING MAGIC: The Shorebirds offense has been spectacular putting up runs in the final innings of the game. Of the 117 runs Delmarva has put up, 63 of them have come in the 7th inning or later, registering 53% of their runs entering Tuesday's game.

TODAY'S STARTER: Jared Beck makes his third start of the season on Thursday and his second versus the Red Sox. This will be his fourth appearance overall as he's made on relief appearance this season.

LAST OUTING (4/20 vs FBG): Beck took the loss in his last start a week ago today against the Fred Nats by allowing 6 runs (4 earned) on 7 hits across 3.2 innings in an eventual 12-6 defeat to Fredericksburg. However, Beck impressed by collecting a young, career-high of 6 strikeouts during his start while his velocity with his fastball touched 95-96 mph.

vs. SALEM: The southpaw will be facing the Red Sox for the third time in his career and second time this season. He was the starter in game two of the regular season and tossed four shutout innings with three strikeouts and three walks, allowing just one hit. He did not factor in the decision in an eventual 15-8 extra innings win.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Beck appeared four times out of the bullpen for the Shorebirds after being drafted in the 13th Round of the 2022 Draft by the Orioles from Saint Leo University in Florida. He was effective in his brief action in Delmarva that covered 10 innings with 10 strikeouts and 4 earned runs allowed. At Saint Leo's, he led the team in strikeouts with 105 in 68.1 innings as he concluded his final college season with a 4-4 record in 13 starts.

FELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003.
