RIDERS CLINCH PLAYOFFS ON SUNDAY, WIN SEVENTH IN A ROW:

The Frisco RoughRiders took down the Amarillo Sod Poodles 12-0 on Sunday evening from Riders Field. Frisco (43-20) started the scoring in the first inning against Amarillo (26-37) starter Dylan File (2-6). The Riders loaded the bases before Cody Freeman drove in Kellen Strahm with a fielder's choice. Keyber Rodriguez added to the lead with an RBI single, plating Liam Hicks. Maximo Acosta capped off the scoring with an RBI single that brought Freeman across the plate to give Frisco a 3-0 lead. Emiliano Teodo (4-1) wiped out the side with three strikeouts in the second inning on his way to 5.0 scoreless, two hit innings that saw the righty tie his career high with 11 punchouts. He needed just 68 pitches to cruise through five frames. The Riders added a run on an RBI groundout by Rodriguez in the third inning. Frainyer Chavez belted his fourth homer of the season, a two-run shot to give Frisco a 6-0 advantage in the bottom of the fourth. In the home half of the sixth inning, Abimelec Ortiz hammered his second homer in as many days to extend the Frisco lead to 7-0. The Riders added two more in the bottom of the seventh on a two-run single from Rodriguez, plating Aaron Zavala and Freeman to make it a 9-0 game. The Riders used a walk, hit-by-pitch, error and two singles to push across three runs in the bottom of the eighth inning. Triston Polley, Steven Jennings, Ricky DeVito and Robby Ahlstrom combined to toss 4.0 scoreless, two-hit innings in the 12-0 win. Rodriguez led the way with four RBI and Acosta collected three hits.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

After a Midland loss on Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. They have the best record in all of Double-A at 43-20 and they have a season-best 8.0-game lead on the Midland RockHounds in the Texas League South. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022. Frisco has not finished the first half with the best record in Double-A since 2008. Triple-A Omaha (Royals, .706) are the only team with a better winning percentage in all of Minor League Baseball than Frisco's .683. The Riders are on pace for 94 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007).

MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

Keyber Rodriguez has been tearing up the baseball over the last couple of weeks. On top of his walk-off single on Saturday night, in his last 24 games, Rodriguez is hitting .326 (29-for-89) with nine multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, two triples, two home runs, 21 RBIs, seven walks, 11 runs scored and two steals. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .277 and OPS from .371 to .769 over the last 24 games.

THE HATCHER HAMMER

Josh Hatcher has crushed the baseball this season for the RoughRiders. He is fourth in the league, hitting .296, while also tied for second in the league with 40 RBIs. Over his last 17 games, he is slashing .273 (18-for-66)/.314/.439/.753 with three doubles, a triple, two home runs, 13 RBIs and seven runs. In his last five games, he has driven in seven runs with three extra-base hits.

FIRING BLANKS

In their last 10 games, the Riders have allowed just 12 earned runs over 90.0 IP (1.20 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in Double-A during the month of June, at 2.18 through the first 14 games. Having won 16 of their last 19 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.07) during that stretch while also being tied for first in saves (eight) and wins (16) since May 25th. In those last 19 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just four times and once in the last 10 games.

HICKS IS THE PICK

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 28 games, batting .358 (34-for-95)/.466/.505/.971 with five doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 16 walks, 10 strikeouts and 20 runs. In his last 16 games, he is hitting .379 (22-for-58)/.486/.603/1.089. Last Friday in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

CHAVEZ RACKING UP THE HITS:

In his first two seasons with the RoughRiders combined, **Frainyer Chavez** just played 44 games with Frisco, but having played his 52nd game of the season with the Riders on Sunday, he is on fire at the plate. Over his last 13 games, he is hitting .362 (17-for-47)/.412/.511/.923 with two doubles, a triple, a home run, four walks, five steals and 12 runs scored. In his last 26 games, he is slashing .307 (27-for-88)/.371/.443/.814.
