FRISCO COMEBACK ATTEMPT FALLS SHORT IN 6-5 DEFEAT:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals 6-5 Friday night from Riders Field. Northwest Arkansas (17-14) put up a big inning against Frisco (16-15) starter **Leandro Lopez** (0-2), who allowed five runs in the second, including a pair of two-run home runs from Connor Scott and Carson Roccaforte. After the Riders found the scoreboard in the bottom of the second on an infield RBI single from **Marcus Lee Sang**, the Naturals countered with another run in the third, making it 6-1. From there, the Riders came back with a tally in the eighth when **Keyber Rodriguez** drove in a run on an RBI groundout and Lee Sang crushed a three-run home run in the ninth to draw within 6-5, but that was all Frisco could muster. Hunter Patteson (2-2) went five innings in his start to secure the victory for the Naturals while Augusto Mendieta took home his first save, recording the final two outs.

COREY'S IN THE HOUSE:

Riders infielder **Corey Joyce** continues to impress on the offensive side this year for the Riders. After being signed as a MiLB free agent on April 8th, he joined the Riders on April 14th. In 18 total games, he is hitting .338 (22-for-65)/.419/.677/1.096 with 4 doubles, 6 home runs and 15 RBIs. Joyce is averaging 1 home run every 12 plate appearances. During his 62 home run season in 2022, Aaron Judge averaged 1 homer every 11 plate appearances. Since making his Riders debut on April 14th, he is 7th in the Texas League with a .338 batting average, T-7th in home runs (6), 10th in OBP (.419), 5th in SLG (.677) and 6th in OPS (1.096). With Double-A Knoxville in the Cubs organization last year, he hit just 2 home runs in 92 games with a .272/.393/.347/.740 slashline.

KEYBRRRRRR, IT'S COLD IN HERE:

Frisco infielder **Keyber Rodriguez** has been one of the best hitters in the Texas League this season. He is now hitting .328/.341/.536/.877 this year and is batting .391 (18-for-46)/.396/.630/1.026 in his last 10 games. His 6 3-hit games this year lead Double-A and more than Akron and San Antonio and the same as Altoona, Corpus Christi and Portland. He is 4th in the league in batting average (.328), 1st in hits (41), T-3rd in doubles (10), 7th in extra-base hits (16) and 3rd in total bases (67). While he is slugging .536 this year, his previous state-side career high was .385 in 2021 with Low-A Down East.

HE'S GOT A BASEBALL BAT, BRO:

John Taylor has been an on-base machine for the Riders this year, reaching in all but one game. In his last 12 games, he is hitting .381 (16-for-42)/.519/.500/1.019 with 3 doubles, 1 home run, 7 RBIs and 10 walks. He is 5th in the Texas League in batting average (.326), 2nd in OBP (.454), 8th in OPS (.959) and T-9th in walks (20). He delivered the walk-off single for the RoughRiders on Thursday, giving him his 9th multi-hit game this season and his 3rd in the last 4 games.

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 13 games, going 8-5. During the stretch, it's been the Frisco offense that's helped them to victory, scoring 94 runs to lead the league (7.2 R/G), slashing .269/.377/.452/.829 with 20 home runs. Frisco's 34 runs in the first inning this year are the second in the minors and the best among non-Triple-A teams, hitting a MiLB best .328 (41-for-125) in the first with 7 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 13 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 10 games this season.

WATCH OUT FOR THE LONG BALL:

Frisco's 45 homers are the most in recorded franchise history (since 2005) through 10 games and 5th in Double-A this year. This year's Wichita Wind Surge team has hit 59 home runs through 31 games for the most in the Texas League since 2005. **Corey Joyce** and **Marcus Lee Sang** lead the team with 6 homers.

LEE SANG IT AND BANG IT:

Marcus Lee Sang has helped to carry the Frisco offense in the last three weeks. In his last 19 games, he has slashed .368 (25-for-68)/.456/.691/1.147 with 4 doubles, 6 home runs and 21 RBIs. In a two-home run game in Amarillo on April 16th, he hit a laser that was 113 mph off the bat and a moonshot over the batters' eye, which went an estimated 466 feet. The former Phillies farmhand is now hitting .316/.391/.541/.932 in 27 games to start the season while ranking 7th in the league in batting average (.316) and 6th in RBIs (24).

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 31 games the RoughRiders are 1st in the Texas League with 289 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.273) and 1st in runs (201, 6.4 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 8 or more runs in 39 percent of their games (12-of-31). The Riders are 2nd in the Texas League in homers (45) while they are 2nd in SLG (.454) and 1st in OPS (.820). For perspective, the Wind Surge led the league last year with a .780 team OPS.

ABOUT DYLAN

-Drafted in 2020 out of Central Catholic High School in Portland, Oregon.

-Named 2019 Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year in junior year, leading all Oregon pitchers in wins (10), ERA (0.51), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (0.71). Led Rams to 6-A State Championship game against Jesuit (nicknamed the "Holy War") and faced now-Phillies pitcher Mick Abel. Jesuit won 2-1 in 13 innings.

-Was named as the No. 2 pitcher in Oregon's 2020 class behind Abel.

-At 13 years old, he pitched for Oregon in the opening round of the 2015 Little League World Series. In 1-0 loss to Texas, he threw 5.2 innings, striking out 12 batters.

-Before signing with the Rangers, MacLean was committed to the University of Washington.

-Opening the season as the Saturday starter for the RoughRiders

2025 SEASON

-Returned from injury to High-A Hub City, dominating at home (2.45 ERA as opposed to a 4.08 ERA on the road)

-After allowing five runs in his second appearance, he dominated in his last 19G (10GS), to the tune of a 3-1 record and 2.70 ERA.

-Started two games in the playoffs, allowing three runs in 8.0 innings, striking out 7 to 1 walk

-Missed the entire season with "Tommy John" surgery.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
