Tied 10-10 in the bottom of the ninth, a one-out walk was followed by a throwing error on a pick off that moved the winning run to second base. Isaac Collins' fifth hit of the game - a single - moved the runner to third before a sacrifice fly to center field brought home the game winner to put Spokane over the top 11-10. It was the first time the C's lost on a walk-off play this year.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT...: The Vancouver Canadians trailed early, rallied for the lead but lost it late in an

Trialing 4-0 after two. Vancouver matched a season high with seven runs on seven hits in the third. They sent 12 men to the plate and got hits from Davis Schneider (lead-off single, two-RBI single), Rafael Lantgua (two-RBI double), Tanner Morris (RBI double), Sebastian Espino (single), Spencer Horwitz (RBI single), and Phil Clarke (RBI single). The first six men to come to the plate reached base and when the dust settled, the C's led 7-4.

Both teams scored runs in the fifth and sixth. Single runs in the top and bottom of the fifth - an RBI single from Clarke after a Will Robertson double and a single, stolen base and a pair of groundouts for the Indians - kept it a three-run lead before Espino's run-scoring hit in the sixth put Vancouver up 9-5. Spokane responded with three runs in the home half of the stanza to cut the lead to one

The Canadians benefited from an error and Robertson's third hit of the night - a run-scoring single to lead 10-8 in the eighth, but the Tribe bounced back to tie the game in the bottom of the inning by using a lead-off walk, a double and a two-RBI single to make it 10-10.

THE TRIBE HAS SPOKANE: The C's are back at Avista Stadium this week for their second and final trip to Eastern Washington this year. When they were last here in June, Vancouver won four games and outscored the Indians 41-31. These two teams last went head-to-head three weeks ago in Hillsboro, when they split a six-game set and the Canadians scored 28 runs to the Tribe's 23. All told, the C's lead the season series 12 games to six.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS BASEBALL HISTORY: July 30, 2016 - Vancouver rallied from a 4-0 deficit for a 5-4 walk-off win over Tri-City at The Nat. The C's started the comeback in the seventh with three runs, highlighted by Josh Palacios' two-run single. In the bottom of the ninth, Palacios brought home the tying run with a groundout before Nash Knight brought in the winning run on a ground ball to third that was booted by the third baseman. Cavan Biggio had two walks in the game. On the mound, Patrick Murphy got the start and allowed three runs on seven hits in five and twothirds innings of work before Evan Smith worked the final three and a third to earn the win

WALK-OFF WOE: Last night was the first time the Canadians have lost on a walk-off this year. They're now 4-1 when the game is decided on the final play.

BACK-TO-BACK LACK: The C's haven't won consecutive games since July 10-13.

UNLUCKY NUMBER 7: Vancouver has scored seven runs in one inning twice this season but have lost both games: last night's 11-10 defeat and a 16-9 loss against Everett on June 15.

WILL KEEPS THRILLING: Will Robertson continues his torrid stretch since returning from the Injured List last week. His three hits last night gave him his fourth multi-knock showing in seven games back. The Loose Creek, MO native has 16 total bases in his last three games, the most by any C's hitter in that span.

ON THE HILL: Brian Rapp returns to the bump for Vancouver. He last worked on July 24 against Everett, when he worked 2.2 frames and allowed three runs (one earned) on two hits with three walks and a pair of strikeouts. From June to July, Rapp, 25, has improved his ERA by over two points and lowered his opponent's batting average against from .314 to .219. The Mendham, NJ native was signed out of the independent Frontier League, where he was pitching for the New York Boulders after being released by Minnesota before the start of the season. The former Boston College hurler was originally drafted by the Twins in the 26th round (784th overall) of the 2018 draft after finishing his four-year collegiate career with a 10-11 record and a 4.59 ERA in 56 games (23 starts) across 178.1 innings

MLB.com's #7 Rockies prospect Helcris Olivarez gets another crack at the Canadians tonight. The southpaw is 0-3 with a 10.61 ERA across 18.2 innings against the C's in four starts. Vancouver is batting .329 against him this year, but he limited them to just two hits in five innings of work in his last turn on July 7. Olivarez, 20, last worked on July 24 at Tri-City, where he scattered three hits, allowed three runs on a pair of homers, walked one and K'd nine over five innings. Opponents are hitting just .203 against him in five July starts
