**WEDNESDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Bowie Baysox, 4-3, in 10 innings at Prince George's Stadium. **Luis Amaya** made his first professional start, working 3.0 scoreless, hitless innings to open the bullpen game. Amaya walked a career-high five batters, including three in the first inning when he stranded the bases loaded. The Flying Squirrels broke a scoreless tie in the top of the fifth inning with a two-run homer by **Vince Fernandez**, his second home run in the last two games. Bowie took a 3-2 lead in the bottom of the seventh with a three-run, bases-clearing double by Robert Neustrom. In the top of the eighth, **Heliot Ramos** tied the game with a solo home run. In the top of the 10th, **Andres Angulo** scored on a wild pitch by Bowie reliever Felix Bautista. **R.J. Dabovich** struck out the side in order in the bottom of the tenth for his third save at Double-A.

**TODAY'S GAMES:** The Flying Squirrels play the third and fourth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in their first trip to Prince George's Stadium this year. Bowie won four-of-six games at The Diamond from May 18-23. The Baysox return to Richmond for a six-game series from July 27-August 1. The two teams meet for a second series in Bowie from August 10-15.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have won four of their last five games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 3.0 games behind first-place Bowie. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .234 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked tied for fourth in the league with a 3.95 ERA for the season.

**THE BAYSOX** have lost five of the last seven games since June 30 and 12 of the last 17 games since June 18. The Baysox are ranked seventh in the league with a .244 team batting average. The Bowie pitching staff is ranked seventh in the league with a 4.22 ERA. The Bowie roster includes seven of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects including C Adley Rutschman (No. 1/No. 2 overall), RHP Grayson Rodriguez (No. 2/No. 19 overall), LHP D.L. Hall (No. 4/No. 53 overall), RHP Mike Baumann (7), INF Terrin Vavra (10), OF Kyle Stowers (22) and INF Joseph Ortiz (29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Caleb Kilian** makes his eighth Double-A start in Game 1. He last pitched on Saturday against Binghamton at The Diamond and allowed one run over 6.0 innings while matching a Double-A career high with nine strikeouts. He opened the season with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in four starts with 32 strikeouts in 21.2 innings. He was named High-A West Pitcher of the Week twice in the three weeks he spent with the Emeralds. He was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round in 2019 out of Texas Tech, where he was a First-Team All-Big 12 pitcher. **For more on Kilian, see page two.**

Left-hander **Michael Plassmeyer** makes fifth Richmond start and his first against Bowie in Game 2. Last time out, he picked up his first Richmond win after allowing one run over 5.1 innings against Binghamton in Game 2 of a double-header on Friday. Plassmeyer was traded from the Tampa Bay Rays to the San Francisco Giants on June 11 in exchange for right-handed pitcher Matt Wisler. He began the season with Double-A Montgomery in the Double-A South. Plassmeyer was originally drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round in 2018 out of the University of Missouri, but he was traded to Tampa Bay after one professional season. In his first season with the Rays organization in 2019, his first full professional season, Plassmeyer posted a 1.91 overall ERA, which was the third-lowest for a pitcher in Tampa Bay's minor league system in the history of the franchise, trailing only a 1.41 ERA by Blake Snell in 2015 and a 1.77 ERA by Dylan Floro in 2013. **For more on Plassmeyer, see page three.**

**FOR BOWIE:** Left-hander John Means makes a rehab start in Game 1. He is working back from a left shoulder strain. He made his first rehab start on Sunday for Aberdeen and allowed one run over 2.0 innings. It was his first live game action in nearly a month after leaving his start on June 5 against Cleveland after retiring just two batters before being placed on the injured list the next day. On May 5, Means threw a no-hitter at Seattle. Overall with Baltimore this season, he has gone 4-2 with a 2.28 ERA in 12 starts. Means was drafted by the Orioles in the 11th round in 2014 out of West Virginia University. He spent parts of three seasons with Bowie from 2016-2018, combining to go 14-21 with a 4.34 ERA in 52 games (49 starts).

Right-hander Mike Baumann makes his eighth start of the season at Double-A in Game 2. Last time out, he worked his longest outing of the year to date on Friday at Akron, allowing one run in 5.0 innings. Baumann was a teammate of Richmond pitcher **Sean Hjelle** at Mahtomedi High School in Minnesota. He was drafted by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round in 2014 but opted to attend Jacksonville University. He was selected by the Baltimore Orioles in the third round of the 2017 MLB Draft. He first reached Double-A in 2019 with Bowie and went 6-2 with a 2.31 ERA. Last year, he suffered a right flexor strain while at the Orioles' alternate site, ending his season. He began his year with the Low-A Delmarva Shorebirds.

**TOASTY:** Over his last 25 games since June 6, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .330 (32-for-97) with six homers, seven doubles and 28 RBIs. In the last road series, he hit go-ahead, two-run homers in the ninth inning in back-to-back games on June 25 and 26 at Hartford. Last week, he hit a three-run homer in the second game of Friday's double-header against Binghamton and added a bases-clearing, three-run double on Sunday night in the series finale. On Tuesday, he hit a two-run homer in the series opener at Bowie. His ten-game hit streak ended on Wednesday. He has at least one extra-base hits in eight of his last 11 games.

**BREAKING OUT:** After going 0-for-14 over four games from June 10-15, **David Villar** has hit .362 (25-for-69) with five homers and 11 RBIs over his last 19 games since June 16. In the last road series against Hartford, Villar hit three homers. For the season, Villar leads the Flying Squirrels with 10 home runs.

**SIMON SAYS:** **Simon Whiteman** started his Double-A career 0-for-17 in his first four games from June 15-18 after being promoted from High-A Richmond. In his last 16 games since June 19, Whiteman is batting .302 (19-for-63) with five doubles and one homer. He hit his first Double-A homer in the second game of last Friday's double-header against Binghamton. On Saturday, he picked up a game-winning, RBI double in the seventh inning. He has picked up an RBI in four of the last six games. Since joining the Flying Squirrels, Whiteman has picked up seven stolen bases, which leads the team for the season.

**SAY HEY!:** Since the calendar turned to July, **Jacob Heyward** is batting .313 (5-for-16) with two homers and four RBIs. He has homered in two of his last three starts. The stretch comes after hitting .077 (1-for-13) over his last seven games in June. The 2019 Eastern League All-Star Game MVP is in his second overall season with Richmond.

**PITCHERS WHO RAKE:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels lead the Double-A Northeast with nine hits, six walks and six RBIs by pitchers at the plate. On the year, Richmond has gone 26-14 (.650) against National League affiliates, but have gone 4-10 (.286) against affiliates of American League clubs. After back-to-back series against National League affiliates Hartford and Binghamton, the Flying Squirrels now face American League clubs for the remaining four sets in July and will use the designated hitter.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked eighth in the Double-A Northeast with 38 RBIs and ranked tied for ninth with 55 hits. **Shane Matheny** is ranked fourth with 28 walks. **Norwith Gudino** and **Patrick Ruotolo** are tied for fourth in the circuit with five saves. **Joey Marciano** and **Frank Rubio** are both tied for fourth with 19 games pitched.

**BACK TO THE FUTURES GAME:** Outfielder **Heliot Ramos** has been selected to participate in the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Coors Field in Denver on Sunday during the MLB All-Star Week festivities. It is the third time Ramos has been selected to play in the Futures Game. In 2018, Ramos played in the Futures Game at Nationals Park in Washington, D.C., and went 1-for-1 with a pinch-hit single. In 2019, Ramos played in the Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland and entered the game to replace Taylor Trammell, hitting a single to center field in his lone plate appearance. Along with Ramos, shortstop Marco Luciano will represent the Giants on the National League team. The 2021 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game will air live on MLB Network and will be streamed on MLB.com on Sunday, July 11 at 3 p.m.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have five players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Will Wilson** (10), **Tristan Beck** (13), **Sean Hjelle** (14) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. **Simon Whiteman** is rated by *Baseball America* as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and **Diego Rincones** is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Five players, including Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.
