TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Comets (Los Angeles Dodgers) will play game four of their series on Friday at Dell Diamond. First pitch is slated for 7:15 p.m. CT.

E-TRAIN WALK IT OFF

The Express beat the Comets 6-5 in 10 innings last night. RF Marcus Smith homered to put the Express ahead 1-0 in the second. In the third, 2B Justin Foscue belted an RBI double, 3B Cody Freeman hit a sacrifice fly and C Chad Wallach tallied an RBI single moving the E-Train lead to 4-0. CF Justin Dean put the Comets on the board with a solo homer and 1B Michael Chavis hit a two-run homer cutting the deficit to 4-3 in the sixth. Oklahoma City DH Nick Senzel tied the game at 4-4 with a leadoff homer in the seventh. Both clubs traded zeroes in the last two frames sending the game to extras. LF Steward Berroa was caught in a rundown from third and scored on an error as the Comets took a 5-4 lead in the 10th. Freeman hit a chopper to third but the throw sailed over Chavis at first and Crim scored to tie the game at 5-5. Round Rock INF Alex De Goti came in to pinch hit and sent the 12th pitch of the at-bat up the middle for a RBI single. Freeman came around from second and scored the go-ahead run for Round Rock's fifth extra-inning win of the season.

DUGGER'S BACK AT DELL DIAMOND

RHP Robert Dugger makes his first start at Dell Diamond since 2023 when he led the Express in starts (29), innings (146.1), and strikeouts (143). Dugger spent 2024 with Triple-A Las Vegas and started 2025 in the Mexican League. Since signing a minor league deal with Texas on May 6, he made one start at El Paso on May 10. The right-hander took the loss after 2.2 IP, with six hits, seven earned runs, four walks and two strikeouts.

EFFICIENT FOSCUE

INF Justin Foscue has gone nine consecutive games without a strikeout and only has one strikeout through 49 plate appearances in the month of May. Seven of his 10 hits have gone for extra-bases as he slugs a team-best .575 this month. Foscue leads the Express this season with 41 hits, 17 extra-base hits, 23 walks and a .387 on-base percentage.

BULLPEN WORK

Round Rock relievers have recorded the most innings (206.0) in the PCL. Despite throwing 41.1 more innings than Express starters, they have an equal amount of earned runs (105). The bullpen also stands atop the PCL with 231 strikeouts.

FINDING THEIR PITCH

INF Blaine Crim ranks second in the PCL with a 51% hard hit rate and OF Kellen Strahm is sixth at 47.7%. A hard hit ball is any baseball hit over 95.0 miles per hour.

NO WHIFFS

INF Justin Foscue and INF Cody Freeman have the first and second most plate appearances for the Express this month and the duo has just five strikeouts thus far in May. Freeman's 12.2% whiff rate (min. 100 PA) is the second-best rate in the league. As a team, the Express have the fourth fewest strikeouts in the PCL (357).

BIG LEAGUE EXPERIENCE

In total, 22 of the 31 players on the Opening Day roster have logged Major League service time in their careers, including 14 of the 18 pitchers on the staff, Barlow (Rangers), RHP Caleb Boushley (Brewers, Twins), RHP David Buchanan (Phillies, Reds), RHP JT Chargois (Twins, Dodgers, Mariners, Rays, Marlins), Dunning (White Sox, Rangers), RHP Codi Heuer (Cubs, White Sox), RHP Adrian Houser (Brewers, Mets), Latz (Rangers), Pennington (Rangers, Royals), LHP Michael Plassmeyer (Phillies), Robert (Rangers), RHP Hunter Strickland (Giants, Mariners, Nationals, Mets, Rays, Angels, Brewers, Reds, Angels) and Winn (Rangers). Eight of the 13 position players have big league experience: C Tucker Barnhart (Reds, Tigers, Cubs, Diamondbacks), Foscue (Rangers), OF Sam Haggerty (Mets, Mariners), Harris (Rangers), Ornelas (Rangers), INF Alan Trejo (Rockies), C Chad Wallach (Reds, Marlins, Angels).

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2025 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's third season with the E-Train. In 2024, Davis secured his 800th win as a manager on July 12 at Reno. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided the E-Train to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 744-665 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
