GARDENHIRE WINS 300TH GAME AS SAINTS TAKE RUBBER GAME: Manager Tobey Gardenhire won his 300th game on the bench for St. Paul as the Saints hung on for a 5-3 victory on Sunday against Indianpolis at CHS Field. After a scoreless Top 1, the Saints loaded the bases on the first three batters of the home half and cashed in when Carson McCusker laced a double down the left field line to score two and get him to 20 RBI on the season. Matthews, who before Sunday had never walked more than two batters in any of his previous 46 career minor league games, walked the bases loaded in the fourth, but coaxed a fly ball out of Indy catcher Brett Sullivan to get out of the jam. He departed with a 3-0 lead in the fifth, but reliever Alex Speas allowed both of the runners he inherited to score on a two-run single by Nick Yorke, trimming the lead to one. The Saints added insurance runs on RBI hits by Mike Ford and Ryan Fitzgerald in the seventh and eighth innings, respectively. Matthews walked a career-high four, but only gave up one hit following a double to begin the game. The St. Paul pen combined to allow one run over the final four frames. Gardenhire has more wins in franchise history than any Saints manager aside from George Tsamis, who won 954 from 2003-20 during the club's last 17 seasons as an independent club.

HAUNTED HUNTINGTON: The Saints return for their second trip to Huntington Park this season after dropping the last four games of a shortened five-game series at the beginning of the month. It's a place where the Saints have historically struggled, owning just a 13-34 record all-time, which checks in as the fifth-worst winning% for a road team at one ballpark since 2021, the Saints' first season in Triple-A:WORST ROAD RECORDS AT ONE BALLPARK, Triple-A(2021-Present, min 18 0P)

SAVE SOME FOR TOMORROW: The ups and downs of the St. Paul offense continued last week vs Indianapolis with the Saints scoring as many as 16 runs in Tuesday afternoon's opener, while also being shutout for the fourth time this season in game one of Friday's doubleheader. The Saints now rank 13th out of 20 International League teams in runs-per-game, averaging 4.5/gam entering play on Tuesday. The Saints' low run-scoring rate is despite the team ranking fifth in team batting average (.258) and fifth in OPS (.763) in the International League so far this year. In their 11 wins, the Saints have scored 70 runs (an average of 6.4/game) while in their 13 losses, they've scored just 29 (2.2/game). One of the Saints inconsistencies in run-scoring has been due to hitting with runners in scoring position. After going just 2-for-23 between Friday & Saturday, St. Paul went 6-for-16 in Sunday's win and they now rank 6th in the International League with a .271 average (62-229) w/ RISP. In their 11 wins this year, St. Paul are hitting .348 (48-138) situationally and just .154 (14-91) in their 13 losses. The .190 batting average differential between RISP numbers in wins and losses is the third-largest gap in Triple-A this year.

Mccusker Mashing: Saints outfielder Carson Mccusker is crushing the ball to open the season McCUSKER MASHING: Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 2 nd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). The 6-8 slugger is one of 21 hitters in the minors with at least 6 homers this year and he is tied for the 2nd-most HR in the minor leagues since April 9, the date of his first homer. McCusker has two of the top-5 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and four of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity in Saints history. While his top-end exit velos are impressive, he also ranks 4th in the International League with a 62.0% hard-hit rate (min 40 PA), meaning over 60% of his batted balls are put in play at 95 mph or

STRAIGHT GAS: The Saints pitching staff are tied for the third-hardest throwing staff in Triple-A to start the season with an average velocity of 89.5 mph that ranks as a harder throwing staff than 20 Major League teams. Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 11th in K-rate (24.8%) 20 Major League teams. Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 11th in K-rate (24.8%) and 9th in whiff-rate (28.8%). By average velocity on fastballs only, St. Paul ranks sixth in Triple-A and third in the IL. Ryan Jensen (96.8, 15th) and Alex Speas (96.5, 19th) are both top-20 in the Triple-A circuit in average fastball velo among arms with at least 100 pitches thrown.

SWING AND A MISS: The Saints bullpen has had two of the better swing-and-miss arms in the league to start the season with relievers Kyle Bischoff (47.4%, 4th) and Ryan Jensen (46.5%, 5th) both ranking among the top-5 pitchers in the International League in whiff-rate to start the season (min 100 pitches thrown). Anthony Misiewicz also ranks t-33trd in the IL with a 37.7% whiff-rate. The St. Paul staff rank 9th out of 20 teams in whiff-rate (28.8%) overall.

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints' current roster features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and nine according to Baseball America while also touting four of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No 2. MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37, on Paschall Americals list. No. 37 on Baseball America's list.

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (13-16) have won a season-high four straight after ITWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (13-16) have won a season-high four straight after pummeling the Guardians 11-1 in Cleveland last night; Ryan Jeffers went 2-4, HR (1), 2B, 3 RBI. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (12-8) have won six of their last 8 games and travel to Frisco this week. Outfielder Kyler Fedko, a 12th round pick out of UConn by the Twins, has reached base in 16 consecutive games to start the year and is hitting: 3.15 with a 1.051 OPS that leads all qualifying Minnesota farmhands. High-A Cedar Rapids (12-8) snapped a three-game losing skid to end last week and host South Bend (CHC). Twins No. 4 prospect Kalen Culpepper has hit safely in a season-high eight straight, a stretch where he is 11-for-29 (.379), HR, 4 XBH, and 4 BB.

Low-A Fort Myers (12-9) won their last two games in Clearwater and settle in for the week at home hosting Jupiter (MIA). 19-year-old outfielder Byron Chourio leads the Florida State League with 22 walks and has a .452 on-base percentage & .747 OPS while reaching base in 18 straight.

LAST APPEARANCE: Made his third consecutive start with the Twins since being recalled by Minnesota on April 11. Started on the hill Wednesday against the White Sox and for the third consecutive start left the game with no earned runs scored on his ledger (both inherited runners he put on scored against reliever Cole Sands). Threw 23 four-seam fastballs, 15 sliders, 12 changeups, and three sinkers while generating eight swings-and-misses, five of which came on the four-seamer. Recorded four of his five strikeouts on the changeup, matching a career-high in both the MLB and Triple-A levels (had struck out five w/ the changeup one time before at each levels).

LATE-BLOOMER: A late-adopter to pitching, Festa did not start toeing the slab until his senior year of high school at Seton Hall Prep. He was initially committed as a shortstop to a Division 3 school entering his final prep season, but when his high school ran out of pitchers during a tournament, Festa was handed the ball for the first time and never looked back. He continued to play shortstop for the rest of the year, but also went 4-0 with a 1.50 ERA while striking out 44 over 30 innings on the mound. He chose to walk-on to nearby Seton Hall University as a pitcher instead, getting a good recommendation from his high school head coach Mike Sheppard Jr, who's brother was the head coach of the nearby Big East program. Festa was mostly a fastball-changeup pitcher in college, mixing in an occasional slurve, and credits the Twins development program for helping him develop a slider, which as become his bread-and-butter out pitch, accounting for 65 of his 166 (39%) strikeouts between the Majors and Triple-A last year.

A PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES: In just his ninth professional pitching appearance, Festa was a major part of a no-hitter. On May 10, 2022 with Fort Myers, he threw 6.0 no-hit innings, striking out a career-high 11 batters in a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels. Jaylen Nowlin followed with 2.0 perfect innings and struck out three. Hunter McMahon tossed 1.0 hitless inning to finish it off, a 3-0 win.

ONE, TWO, THREE, YOU'RE OUT!: On July 24, 2022 with Single-A Cedar Rapids, Festa allowed three consecutive singles between the third and fourth innings. The final two batters of the third inning reached, as did the first of the fourth. Festa got three outs, but did not retire a batter because promptly picked off each of the three batters, one after the other

THE SLIM REAPER IDOLIZING THE deGROMINATOR: While he's worn the No. 58 jersey for both the Twins and Saints so far in his career, Festa came up through baseball wearing number 48, a tribute to his favorite player growing up, Jacob DeGrom. The two-time Cy Young award winner had his most dominant seasons in 2018-19, the summers before Festa's first two years of college ball at Seton Hall University, located about 35 miles West of Citi Field in Flushing.

你好: While attending Seton Hall Prep in New Jersey, Festa was a member of the National Chinese Honor Society... The National Chinese Honor Society (NCHS) was established in 1993 to recognize those accomplished high school students who study Chinese as a world language. The National Chinese Honor Society is a scholastic organization that promotes and recognizes students who demonstrate citizenship, leadership, and community service. A member must be a full time high school student (grades 9-12) who has studied Chinese for four semesters in high school with an average of B or higher.

BIGGER, FASTER, STRONGER: Festa's goal in the offseason leading up to 2024 was to add some muscle, so he can be prepared to go an entire season. He said it's sort of tough for him to do certain exercises given his height and narrowness. Last season he was listed at 185 pounds and came into Spring Training in 2024 10 pounds heavier at 195.

LAST APPEARANCE: Made the start in game one of Wednesday's doubleheader vs Indy and failed to reach five innings for the second straight start after back-to-back five-inning scoreless appearances to start the year. Labored, but allowed just an unearned run due to a Saints error in the 1st inning. Used 26 cutters, 25 four-seamers, 14 changeups, 9 sinkers, 6 sweepers, and 2 curveballs (73% fastballs between the 4SFB, CT, & SK). Induced only four swings-and-misses, including recording a strikeout on a four-seamer & a changeup.

ON THE FAST TRACK: In just his second full-season in the minors last year, Morris ascended through three levels of the minor league ladder to finish the year making his first six starts at the Triple-A level. It's not the first time that Morris has accelerated at a faster pace than his peers. He graduated high school at just 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS: Although he was born in New York City, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from NYC as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska, and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that's where he lived the longest.

LET'S GET FUNKY: Lacking the prototypical build of a frontline starter, Morris' unusual delivery has been noted as a reason why hitters have such a hard time picking up his pitches. Fangraphs prospect writer Eric Longenhagen noted in last year's mid-season report that "Morris' delivery is weird. He has a high front side throughout his delivery and creates a slight crossfire angle with stride direction before throwing out of a high arm slot. It's rare for cross-bodied pitchers to also have a north/south arm slot this extreme and it seems to disorient hitters."

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Before transferring to Texas Tech for his senior year, Morris pitched for three years at Division 2 Colorado Mesa University, helping his team reach the DII National Championship Game in 2019 as a freshman (Mesa finished as Runner-up to Tampa that year). Morris was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year for his efforts that season and was a Division 2 2nd-Team All-American in 2021 before transferring to Texas Tech as a redshirt junior.

MAD MORRIS: Morris' mound routine can involve arguing with himself or talking to himself on the mound. "I'm really just analyzing the last pitch, moving on to the next pitch and what it should be," Morris remarked. "Sometimes there are not-so-nice words involved, but reall it's 'Trust it. Throw it to the mask' Other times, 'it's good left side, how can we work off of that? What's next, and then next?' There's lots of things going through my head.'
