SHOREBIRDS HOLD ON TO END LOSING STREAK: The Delmarva Shorebirds snapped their eight-game losing streak on Friday night as they defeated the Lynchburg Hillcats 7-6. Carter Young got the scoring started in the first as he scored Stiven Acevedo on a sacrifice fly to make it 1-0 after an inning. The Hillcats tied the game on a passed ball in the second but Delmarva retook the lead by scoring on a wild pitch in the bottom half to go ahead 2-1. In an eventful third inning, the Hillcats scored three runs to take their first lead at 4-2, but Delmarva would respond with five runs of their own on a solo home run by Noelberth Romero, followed by two run singles by both Randy Florentino and Carter Young to give the Shorebirds their largest lead ay 7-4. The Hillcats would chip away by scoring a run in the sixth and seventh inning, but thanks to strong bullpen work by Joe Kemlage who threw three scoreless in his debut, with Eris Rodriguez getting the final seven outs to earn the save, preserving a 7-6 win for Delmarva.

**TODAY'S OPPONENT: Deivy Cruz** gets the ball for Delmarva, making his 11th start of the season and he'll face **Yorman Gomez** who is set to start his 5th game versus the Shorebirds this season. Gomez has delivered a pair of terrific starts against Delmarva where he allowed just 1 run across 5.2 innings, and another where he tossed 6 scoreless. But Delmarva has also beat him twice, scoring a total of 7 runs in 5.2 innings. The right-hander allowed two runs or more in all five of his starts in July.

**HEY STIVEN: Stiven Acevedo** has come out of the All-Star break hot as he's reached base in 14 of 18 games he's played in since the break. He has especially thrived batting in the leadoff spot in his last 14 starts as he has 6 multi-hit games while scoring 9 runs, and stealing 5 bases in that short span. His run at the top included a leadoff home run on the first pitch of the game versus Kannapolis on July 25.

**HEATING UP AT THE HOT CORNER:** Third basemen **Anderson De Los Santos** has begun find his stride at the plate. De Los Santos is coming off his best month of the season in July where he batted .267 with an OPS of .785 with 7 extra-base hits and 12 RBI. Most notably, De Los Santos has trimmed his strikeout rate as he has struck out 25 times since the month of June after striking out 25 times in April and 29 in May.

**TWO MORE MOVE UP: Samuel Basallo** & **Trendon Craig** are the latest Shorebirds to earn promotions to the High-A club in Aberdeen. Basallo was not just the best offensive performer on the Shorebirds, but in all the Carolina League as the 18 year old had his way in his debut season in affiliated baseball as he became a Top 100 overall prospect. Craig moves up after a strong 39-game run with Delmarva where he batted .302 with 14 extra-base hits, along with 18 stolen bases. With the promotions of Basallo and Craig, there have now been a total of 11 Shorebirds from their Opening Day Roster who have earned a call-up to the next level.

**NEW MONTH, FRESH START:** The Delmarva Shorebirds will look to right the ship after a tough finish to the month of August where they lost 10 of their final 12 games, including losing 5 of 6 in their last two series against Charleston and Kannapolis. Delmarva has had success this season against the Lynchburg Hillcats as they've taken four of six games in each of the first two series, giving them an 8-4 overall record against the Cleveland Guardians affiliate.

**TODAY'S STARTER:** Deivy Cruz gets the start in game five against the Lynchburg Hillcats, making his fourth appearance this season against the Guardians affiliate.

**LAST OUTING (7/29 @ KAN):** Cruz took the loss in his last outing but did throw a five-inning complete game in a weather-shortened game last Saturday night. Cruz allowed two runs on six hits with five strikeouts. After allowing a run in the first inning with two outs, Cruz's scoreless inning streak of 18.2 came to end, but it is the longest mark by a Shorebird pitcher this season.

vs. LYNCHBURG: Cruz will look to continue his strong run against the Lynchburg Hillcats this season as he's set to face them for the fourth time with this being his third start. Cruz on the season is 2-0 versus Lynchburg and has allowed just 2 runs in 13.2 innings. His latest outing against the Hillcats was on June 29 when he tossed five scoreless inning as the starter to earn the win.

**2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS**: At 18 years old, Deivy Cruz was a bright spot in the in the Orioles organization pitching most of the season in Delmarva. He began in the FCL and made 3 starts that covered 13 innings, striking out 17 with 4 earned run allowed. Was moved up to the Shorebirds on June 21 and would appear in 13 games, 12 starts where he finished with an ERA of 4.02 and a 2-5 record. Opponents hit .224 against Cruz as he struck out 52 with 37 walks during his time in Delmarva. He was very effective in his first two months in a Shorebird uniform as he allowed just 3 earned runs across his first 6 starts that covered 26.1 innings in June & July.
