LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones erased a 3-run deficit to win 12-5, evening their series with Asheville on Wednesday...Down 4-1 entering the 5th, Brooklyn tied the game on a DH Kevin Parada 2-run double and a CF Alex Ramírez RBI single...Cyclones grabbed the lead for good later in the inning on a 2-run RF Stanley Consuegra home run...Brooklyn added 3 in the 8th and 9th...SS Jett Williams went 3-for-5 with 2 runs scored, a double, 4 RBI, a walk, and a stolen base...The 19-year-old produced an RBI single in the 8th and a 3-run double in the 9th...Ramírez collected a pair of hits — including a double —and 2 RBI...C Drake Osborn also collected 2 knocks and an RBI...All 9 in Brooklyn's lineup reached at least once... LF Rhylan Thomas walked 4 times and 18 Ryan Clifford earned 3 free passes...CF Zach Cole, 2B Tim Borden II, and C John García all tallied multi-hit nights for the Tourists...LHP Felipe De La Cruz went 6.0 innings and allowed 4 runs (3 earned) in his Brooklyn debut, earning the win.

LAST TRAIN RUNNING: Brooklyn scored a season-high 12 runs in Wednesday's 12-5 victory over Asheville...The Cyclones' previous high water mark was 11 on 2 separate occasions...Brooklyn bested Wilmington, 11-7, on both July 27 and 30 at Maimonides Park...The 12 runs scored are the most for the 'Clones since they scored 18 runs in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...RF **Stanley Consuegra** homered in both Wednesday's contest and the game on 8/28/22.

WALK IT OUT: Brooklyn's 10 walks on Wednesday were also the most for the squad in a 9-inning game this season...The Cyclones earned 12 free passes in an 11-inning, 9-8 win vs. Jersey Shore on Opening Day, April 7...The 10 walks were the most for Brooklyn in a 9-inning game since August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...LF Rhylan Thomas earned 4 walks in Wednesday's victory tying 38 Jaylen Palmer for the most by a Cyclone in a single game this year...Palmer accomplished the feat in Brooklyn's 9-8, 11-inning Opening Day win vs. Jersey Shore...The 4 free passes were the most by a Cyclone in a 9-inning game since 28 Mic Gaddis walked 4 times in a 10-3 win at Jersey Shore on July 22, 2022...Since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in 2005, no Brooklyn player has walked more than 4 times in a single game.

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF Stanley Consuegra broke a tie with C Francisco Álvarez for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on Wednesday night...He is 4 home runs (18) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...The 22-year-old tied Álvarez on Tuesday and added a multi-home run game against Hudson Valley on Friday night...The multi-home run night marked the 2nd of the season for Consuegra...Stanley tallied a pair of solo blasts in a 6-4 loss at Hudson Valley on July 19...He and C Kevin Parada (6/23 vs. HV & 7/15 vs. GBO) are the only 2 players to post multi-homer contests for Brooklyn in 2023...Since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005, Consuegra and Parada are just 2-of-3 Cyclones to post multiple 2-plus home run games...INF Nick Evans accomplished the feat in 2005 on July 22 vs. Jamestown and again on August 24 at Williamsport...Entering Thursday, Consuegra is tied for 5th in the SAL in home runs (18) and 7th in slugging percentage (.472).

JETT THE MET: INFs Jett Williams made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and has been stellar all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .345/.497/.646 with a 1.143 OPS, 23 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, 17 RBI, 33 walks, and 14 stolen bases in 33 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 145 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.497)...He is also 2nd in OPS (1.143)...On the season, Williams is tied for 8th in Minor League Baseball in walks (87)...Among teenagers, Williams ranks 2nd in MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 85 PA) in batting average (.343), on-base percentage (.483), OPS (1.112), and doubles (8)...He is also tied for 1st in extra-base hits (12), 2nd in hits (24) and stolen bases (8), and tied for 2nd in walks (18)... Among SAL players with at least 80 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is 3rd in the circuit in wRC+ (199), wOBA (.490), OPS (1.112), OBP (.483), and 4th in walk rate (20.2%).

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: Brooklyn's looking to manufacture a second-straight playoff appearance and has dropped just 2 of their last 9 series since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 6-2-2 in their last 10 sets...The Cyclones are 29-21 in the second half and are 1 game behind Jersey Shore (30-20) in the North Division of the SAL with 16 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

BIG RED DAWG: OF Ryan Clifford was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF Drew Gilbert from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP Justin Verlander on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Thursday ranked 3rd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.496)... Greenville's INF Blaze Jordan (.533) is 1st...He is also 4th in OPS (.843) and tied for 5th in home runs (18)...Clifford is also 2nd in isolated power (.245), and 6th in wOBA (.374) and wRC+ (126).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 33 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF Rhylan Thomas has put up bonkers numbers...He is slashing .364/.437/.464 with a .900 OPS at the dish and a 151 wRC+...Thomas has added 15 runs scored, 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 15 RBI, and 15 walks (11.9 BB%) to only 7 strikeouts (5.6 K%)...Since July 18 at Hudson Valley, the left-handed swinger is slashing .374/.447/.495 with a .941 OPS and 161 wRC+ in 27 games...Since the start of July, Thomas has led the South Atlantic League in batting average (.354) by 24 percentage points and has 7 fewer strikeouts (8) than any other batter (min. 130 PA)...He is also 2nd in on-base percentage (.431).

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has posted a MiLB-low 3.30 ERA (270 ER in 735.1 IP) over their last 84 games, holding a 46-38 record in that span...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.37) is 2nd in the minors...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 3rd in MiLB — in that span and hold a strikeout rate of 27.4% and a walk rate of 10.8%...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.636), hits-per-9 innings (7.12), and batting average against (.215) in that period.

vs. ASHEVILLE: Brooklyn begins a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Astros' High-A affiliate...The Tourists possess 4 of Houston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF Jacob Melton (1), RHP Miguel Ullola (13), OF Zach Cole (18), RHP Nolan DeVos (24)...Brooklyn and Asheville are meeting for the second time in each franchise's history...Both squads met at McCormick Field to open the 2021 season...The Tourists took 3-of-5 games in the series from May 4-9...The final game of that series was canceled due to weather.

BULLPEN BOOM: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at finishing off games in 2023... Entering Thursday, Brooklyn holds the best bullpen ERA (3.53) in the entire South Atlantic League and the 5th-lowest throughout Minor League Baseball...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.21) leads MiLB and Hudson Valley (3.55) is 2nd in the SAL...5 of the top 20 SAL relievers in ERA (min. 20.0 IP) have pitched for the Cyclones this year...RHP Benito García (0.90, 1st), RHP Dylan Tebrake (1.17; 3rd), RHP Brendan Hardy (1.61, 6th), RHP Paul Gervase (1.72, 8th), and LHP Eli Ankeney (2.19; T-17th).

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leader-board despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 6 (85) behind INF **José Peroza** (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (323), hits (158), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (83)...Ramírez is 4 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

WELCOME BACK: C Kevin Parada and INF Chase Estep were reinstated from the Cyclones' 7-day injured list before Tuesday's series opener...Parada landed on the injured list on July 28, while Estep was placed there on August 3...Parada started a rehab assignment with Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...The 22-year-old went 1-for-13 with an RBI and 2 walks in 4 games... Before landing on the injured list, Parada was slashing .301/.361/.525 with a .885 OPS, 7 home runs, and 22 RBI in his last 37 games with the club...Estep was equally hot, posting a .296/.377/.341 slash line with a .718 OPS, 2 doubles, and 7 RBI in his previous 14 games before landing on the IL.

REIM TIME: INF **Jacob Reimer** collected 4 hits — all singles — a run scored and an RBI in Brooklyn's loss to Hudson Valley last Friday night...The 4 knocks were a career-high...Reimer became the first teenager to record 4-or-more hits for the Cyclones in a single game since INF **Gavin Cecchini** accomplished the feat twice on August 17, 2013, vs. Vermont and on August 3 at Jamestown...1B **Nick Evans** is the only other teenager to accomplish the feat since 2005... He went 4-for-4 vs. Staten Island on September 1, 2005...Reimer is the youngest of the three to accrue a 4-hit night.

YO-JOANDER: RHP Joander Suárez continues to hit his stride after returning from Tommy John surgery in June of 2021...With his 7 strikeouts vs. Hudson Valley on Friday night, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is now tied with RHP Blade Tidwell for the franchise single-season record in strikeouts with 112...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...The 23-year-old set a new career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings in a shutout victory vs. Aberdeen last Friday night...Over his last 11 appearances (10 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 3-5 record, but a 3.73 ERA (21 ER in 50.2 IP), 15 walks (7.1 BB%), and 73 strikeouts (34.4 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 7 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 1-4, yet holds a 3.16 ERA (13 ER in 37.0 IP) with 8 walks (5.2 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (35.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez ranks 2nd among SAL pitchers in strikeouts (57) trailing only Greensboro's RHP Thomas Harrington (59).

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Christian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Raimon Gómez (24), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasil (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA'S Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list last Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS Jett Williams (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (5), OF Ryan Clifford (6), RHP Blade Tidwell (10), OF Alex Ramírez (11), RHP Christian Scott (12), IF Jacob Reimer (13), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Raimon Gómez (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF Ronny Mauricio (No. 4), RHP Mike Vasil (9), RHP Dominic Hamel (16), and OF Matt Rudick (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in Milb...Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (118), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (116), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patiño (115), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (114), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (117), and Cardinals prospect OF Milke Antico (117) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 49.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision last Thursday night vs. Hudson Valley...Permitted 5 runs on a career-high 9 hits over 6.0-plus innings...Walked 3 and struck out 3...Induced a double play...Surrendered a 2-run home run to RF Grant Richardson in the top of the 6th...Relieved by LHP Eli **Ankeney** with a man at 2nd and nobody out in the top of the 7th with the game tied at five...Renegades took the lead in the top of the 9th on a 3B Jesús Rodríguez RBI single and defeated the Cyclones, 6-5...Brooklyn led the contest 5-0 entering the 5th inning.

JAWILME'S BIG BITE: Ramírez was outstanding in his High-A and Cyclones debut on August 3...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the 9th inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of 3-run ball...Ramírez allowed 6 hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out 4...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete 8-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a 9-inning complete game since RHP John Gant posted a 1-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

2023: Ramírez joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 31...In 18 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League, the 21-year-old registered a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP)...Issued 23 walks and struck out 61... Has thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with 6 walks and 11 strikeouts in 6 starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramírez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA (33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts.

2022: Started the campaign with the Florida Complex League Mets...Named FCL Pitcher of the Year and a FCL Post-Season All-Star...Composed a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (4 ER in 43.0 IP), 1 save, 6 walks (3.8 BB%), and 40 strikeouts (25.3 K%) in 11 appearances (6 starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 1...Made 2 relief appearances and accrued a 1-0 record...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 3.1 innings, striking out 3 and walking 4.
