The Lugnuts must win today in order to clinch a series split; a Bandits win would give Quad Cities four wins in six games.

Last Night: River Bandits 4, Lugnuts 3 (10 innings). Quad Cities rallied for three runs in the bottom of the 10th inning, walking off when Lansing was unable to turn a double play. T.J. Schofield-Sam had given the Lugnuts the lead in the top of the 10th with an RBI double, scoring himself on a wild pitch. Corey Avant pitched a career high seven innings with eight strikeouts in a no-decision.

On Deck: The Nuts enjoy a day off tomorrow and return home to welcome in the Dayton Dragons from Tuesday, June 24, through Sunday, June 29.

Plunked: First baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam was hit by his 21st pitch of the season yesterday, what else is new? Incredibly, that tops Schofield-Sam's previous career highs for HBPs (19 in 98 games in 2024, 18 in 109 games in 2022). T.J. has been hit three straight times in this series, which makes this the fourth consecutive series that T.J. has been hit at least three times. After getting plunked four times in April, he was struck seven times in May, and now has been hit 10 times in 18 games in June. In contrast, Randy Arozarena and Ty France are tied for the MLB lead with 13 HBPs. T.J.'s 21 HBPs not only lead the Midwest League, they're tied for 2nd in MiLB with Biloxi's Logan Adams, who led the MWL with 40 HBPs in 101 games for Wisconsin last year, breaking the Nuts' Nick Sinay's single season league record.

On Their Way Back: The Lugnuts' two players on the Injured List, outfielder Jonny Butler and first baseman Darlyn Montero, are both rehabbing with the Arizona Complex League Athletics this week.

Ladies and Gentlemen... Your American League Rookie of the Year: Athletics shortstop Jacob Wilson, who played 23 games for the Lugnuts in 2023, ranks 2nd in the Majors to Aaron Judge in both batting average (.353) and base hits (102).

Tur-mendous! Promoted 2025 Lugnuts right-hander Yunior Tur fired five more scoreless innings for Double-A Midland yesterday. Tur's stats in Double-A: 12 1/3 scoreless innings, 4 hits, 3 walks, 12 strikeouts, 0.57 WHIP, .103 batting average against.

Among the Best in the Minors: Lansing first baseman T.J. Schofield-Sam ranks 1st in MiLB with a .352 batting average; closer Mark Adamiak is tied for 2nd in MiLB in saves (11); 2025 Opening Day starter Gage Jump is tied for 1st with 2021 Lugnut Jack Cushing in wins (8); and 2023 Lugnut Colby Thomas (currently with Triple-A Las Vegas) ranks atop the minors in total bases (159) and runs batted in (66). Thomas led MiLB in extra-base hits last year with 80.

A Little More on T.J.: Schofield-Sam leads the Midwest League in total bases (121) and base hits (82) and is 2nd in OBP (.431), 2nd in OPS (.950) and slugging (.519) and 4th in runs (45).

The Men in the Pen: The Nuts have four of the most heavily used relievers in the league. Blaze Pontes leads the league with 24 appearances, and Mark Adamiak, Hunter Breault and Yehizon Sanchez are tied for 2nd with 22 appearances.

At the Plate: The Lugnuts rank 1st in the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts (476), 2nd in batting average (.256), 2nd in base hits (580), 2nd in doubles (130), 4th in on-base percentage (.351), 3rd in total bases (850) and 4th in OPS (.727).

On the Mound: Lansing's pitching corps is 1st in the league in holds (29), tied for 1st in complete games (2),1st in fewest HBPs (21), 1st in fewest balks (4), 2nd in fewest walks (253) and tied for 2nd in saves (18).

In the Field: The Nuts have turned 73 double plays this season, most in the Midwest League.

Welcome to the Show: Five former Lugnuts have made a name for themselves in the Majors this season, from first-time manager Clayton McCullough (2008-2009) with the Marlins to players Max Muncy (March 27), Gunnar Hoglund (May 2), Denzel Clarke (May 23) and Jack Winkler (May 31), increasing the overall total to 197 Nuts who've worked their way from Lansing to MLB.

History vs. Quad Cities

The Lugnuts are 76-84 all-time vs. the River Bandits, 41-37 at home and 35-47 in Davenport

After not meeting up at all in 2021 and 2022, the Lugnuts and River Bandits played 12 games against one another in 2023. Lansing went 7-5, 3-3 in QC.

Last year, the Nuts went 2-4 at Quad Cities, held in late August. Future Royal Jac Caglianone went 6-for-25, .240, .589 OPS, with 2 doubles, 1 walk, 4 strikeouts. The Nuts batted .188 and scored 20 runs in the series.

No-Hit History: On June 13, 2024, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area; a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean. Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing and died in Jupiter.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who was homeschooled and played for Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg). the Garland family was originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before Jake was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams.
