FOURTH OF JULY IS AROUND THE CORNER: The Grizzlies return home on Monday with one of their biggest games of the year - the team's annual Independence Day Celebration IA Central Valley tradition like none other, the Grizzlies' July 4th game will feature a matchup between the Grizzlies and San Jose Giants, Single-A Affiliate of the San Francisco Giants. Chukchansi Park's gates will open up at 5.05pm with pregame festivities beginning 4.55p, as always, the Grizzlies are pulling out all of the stops for their Fourth of July celebration. Fans will be able to enjoy specialty cocktails at Michelob Ultra's Fresno Social, the extremely popular Chorizo Mac & Cheese Dog, water slides in the Community Medical Centers Splash Park, and food trucks courtesy of Fresno Street East. ONE YEAR AGO, THE COMEBACK OF THE CENTURY: One year ago today, the Grizzlies walked-off on the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes 10-9, marking one of the biggest comebacks in Fresno history. The Grizzlies trailed 9-2 heading into the bottom of the eighth before they made their largest comeback of the 2021 season. The seven-run differential was quickly erased thanks to four home runs in the final two frames. Ezequiet Tovar (8 HR, Obhiph), Mateo Gi (14 HR) and Colin Simpson (1 HR) each went deep in the eighth, cutting the deficit to 9-7. In the ninth, Tovar made it a one-run game with a double to right. This brought up Grant Lavigne, who whacked a 1-1 prich to deep right field, anding the contest 10-9. His walk-off homer was the third game-winner for the Grizzlies that season and the first via longball. Overall, this was the seventh comeback victory of 2021 and a season-high crowd of 9,197 were able to witness it.

STOCK-PILING SOME FACTS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Athletics Single-A affiliate) conclude their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the fourth series between the clubs in 2022 and the second meeting in Stockton. One name on Stockton's coaching staff that may seem familiar to Fresno fans is hitting coach Kevin Kouzmanoff, who played seven MLB seasons and played against Fresno from 2011-2014. The Ports are managed by Franklin Font, who was initially tabbed to be the assistant hitting coach. Font will continue his managerial career at the helm in Stockton, coming back to the states from France where he served as the manager for the Aigles of France in 2021, an independent team of the ESBL (European Super League of Professional Baseball). He was a part of the Chicago Cubs organization for over 10 years where he started as a development manager and minor league rover instructor in 2008 before being promoted to the major league staff as the assistant hitting coach in 2012 and ultimately a staff assistant from 2013-2020. Finally, Stockton broadcaster Alex Jensen coached Grizzlies righty Cullen Kafka when he played JV baseball at De La Salle High School.

STATEMENT AGAINST STOCKTON: The Grizzlies have found success against the Ports over the past two seasons. Thanks to yesterday's 5-4 win, the Grizzlies improved to 17-3 (+95 run differential, 172-77) against the Ports this year, 34-10 against Stockton over the past two seasons and 21-2 at Banner Island Ballpark (109-36 run differential this year). Fresno has mashed 51 homers over their 20 affairs against Stockton this season, with four contests of five taters or more. On the other side of the ball, the Grizzlies pitching staff has struck out 175 batters over the past 16 contests against the Ports.

ROARING ON OFFENSE: Over the first four games of the series, the Fresno offense plated 54 runs on 66 hits with 18 of them leaving the yard. The Grizzlies tallied another five runs on 10 hits with two more wallops on Saturday. In the top of the first, Hunter Goodman lifted at wor-un shot to left-center field, his California League best 22nd longball of the season. It was the 100th homer recorded by Fresno in 2022 and the fourth by Goodman in the series. In this stuth, Juan Guerrero fielded the second two-run dinger of the contest. It was Guerrero's eighth clout of the year and second straight game going deep. Two innings later, Guerrero pushed the Grizzlies ahead after scoring on a passed ball and two throwing errors by Stockton.

GUERRERO IS THE RBI GURU: Juan Guerrero has had at least one RBI over his last six games (12 RBI overall and seven game hit streak, season-long for him). The last Grizglies batter to accomplish this feat was Colin Simpson, who had a seven-game RBI streak last season from July 9-18. Simpson had 10 RBI in that span.

ZACH ATTACK: Grizzlies outfielder Zach Kokoska has been on a tear over the past few weeks. On June 14th, Kokoska was batting .192. Since then, he has hit safely in 14 of his last 15 games, bumping his average to .251. Kokoska is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak, the longest span in his professional career. In that stretch, Kokoska is 18-for-44 (.409) with four homers, two doubles, one triple, eight RBI, 12 runs and two walks. Of those four homers, three of them have come in the current series against Stockton. Kokoska was selected in the 10th round of the 2021 draft out of Kansas State.

2022: Enters second professional season with the Colorado Rockies organization...named #3 starter 4/10 vs. Stockton...went 3.2 innings, allowing three runs on six hits while fanning six (career-high) 4/10 vs ŠTK...careerhigh five shutout frames, allowing one hit and two walks while punching out five 4/17 at SJ...career-high six solid innings 4/24 vs LE Game 1, allowed six hits and three earned runs while fanning four...struck out a career-high eight over 5.2 innings, earning first 2022 win 5/1 at STK... career-high seven scoreless frames, allowing five hits and one walk while fanning seven 5/8 vs MOD...five innings of one-run ball, permitting six hits and four walks while striking out three 5/15 at VIS...twirled a career-high seven scoreless innings, allowing one hit and three walks while punching out four 5/22 vs RC...was selected as the California League Pitcher of the Week for May 23 - 29...tossed seven and one-third scoreless innings, a career-best and a season-high by a Fresno pitcher, allowed three hits and one walk while fanning a career-high nine over 99 pitches (65 strikes)... has not given up a run over his last two starts, spanning 14 innings...in his last four outings (26.1 frames), has permitted only one run on 15 hits, nine walks and 23 strikeouts...chucked five innings, striking out four 6/5 at MOD...struck out six batters over six solid innings of work 6/12 vs VIS (10 H, 1 BB, 3 R, 2 ER)...took tough-luck loss 6/26 vs MOD after seven innings of four-run ball (two earned), allowed five hits and one walk while fanning seven.

# **CAREER NOTES**

2021: Started professional career with ACL Rockies (rookie ball), appearing in four games, all out of the bullpen...did not allow a run over five innings of work...gave up four hits and one walk while striking out seven...had a 1.00 WHIP and batters hit .222 against him...threw 89% strikes.

Personal: Selected by the Rockies in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB June Amateur Draft out of the University of Central Missouri (Division II)... in last season, started all 18 games on the bump...went an outrageous 16-0, finishing his college career without a loss (27-0)...had one complete game shutout and pitched 104.2 frames...struck out 123 batters and walked 26...became just the sixth Mule to ever reach 100 strikeouts in a single season...as a junior, led the Mules with seven starts on the mound, going 32.2 innings...enjoyed a 2-0 record with a 3.58 ERA...fanned 39 hitters, averaging 10.74 strikeouts per nine innings...started and ended the year striking out eight batters in his first and final start of the year...idi not allow an earned run over his first 15 innings of work...as a sophomore, had a breakout year starting 15 games, pitching to a 9-0 record and 2.88 ERA... led the team with 95 strikeouts and was seventh in the conference...threw 75 innings averaging 11.4 strikeouts per nine innings...hurled six innings in four appearances with one start his freshman year...had a 4.50 ERA with five strikeouts...held opponents to just a .143 (1-7) batting average with runners on base...was a three-time varsity lettervinner at Olathe Northwest HS in Kansas...named the 2017 Sunflower League Player of the Year...helped his team win a regional championship his senior season.
