VRIELING AND DEALING: Over four starts in the month of August, Trystan Vrieling went 3-0 with a 1.57 ERA (4 ER / 23.0 IP) with 22 K

and 6 BB. For the month, Vrieling ranked 2nd in ERA, while leading the league with a .145 BAA and 0.74 WHIP.

HUMAN HIGHLIGHT REELS: Somerset's 6-5 win in Binghamton on Monday had two plays featured on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays, with Alexander Vargas' jump-throw to first base coming in at No. 5 and Max Burt's fake slide at home plate to score Somerset's sixth run leading the list at No. 1. The play marked Burt's second time featured on SC's Top 10 over the last month.

COMING OUT OF MY CAGE: During the Patriots' last series at home vs. Reading, they endured their longest homerless drought of the season, going 44 innings between home runs. After Anthony Rizzo's first inning home run on Tuesday 8/27, Somerset did not homer again until the second inning on Sunday 9/1, when Jared Wegner's solo shot spurred the first of three home runs for Somerset. After scoring a combined 3 R on 11 H in their last three games, on Sunday the Patriots erupted for a season-high 15 runs on 16 hits.

RAF RAKES: Rafael Flores starred on Sunday afternoon with 4 H, 4 RBI and 4 R, including his 18th total home run of the season. Over six games in last week's series vs. Reading, Flores went hitless in three, while in the other three games he combined to go 8-for-14 with 5 RBI, 4 R and 3 XBH. Since joining the Patriots on the first day of the second half (6/25), Flores leads the Eastern League with 12 HR.

JONES IS JAMMING: Spencer Jones enters today on an 9-game hit streak since 8/24, signaling his longest hit streak of the season and the longest active hit streak by any batter in the Eastern League. During the streak, Jones is 15-for-36 (.417/. 447/.778) with 10 RBI, 5 R, 9 XBH (1 HR, 2 3B, 6 2B), 1 BB and 12 K. Over his last 31 games since 7/26, Jones is batting .325 (39-for-120) with 18 XBH (4 HR, 2 3B, 12 2B), 24 RBI, 14 R (.558 SLG). In the second half of the season, Jones leads the Eastern League with 30 XBH, while ranking second with a .527 SLG, 9 HR, 40 RBI and 109 TB. Jones was named the Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday for the third time this season, all in the second half. In six games vs. Reading, Jones went 10-for-24 with 6 RBI, 3 R, HR, 1 3B.

DOOM, THEN BOOM: On Sunday, Jared Wegner snapped out of an 0-for-24 skid with his sixth homer of the season, while Tyler Hardman snapped out of an 0-for-23 skid in the same game. Now over Wegner's last six games, he has gone 7-for-19 with 4 RBI, 3 R, 1 HR, 2 2B, 1 BB and 1 HBP. Between Sunday and Monday, Hardman reached base in five straight plate appearances and has now hit safely in two straight games over which he is 4-for-8 with 3 RBI, 4 R, 1 HR, 2 2B and 1 BB. GAME OF INCHES: Since the All-Star break, the Somerset Patriots are 21-15. Of their 15 losses, 13 have been decided by three runs or less. Of 19 wins, 11 have been decided by three runs or less. In Somserset's 36 games post-All-Star break, 26/36 have been decided by three runs or less (rercord: 13-13).

Raul Dominguez enters his second consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 10th overall as a manager and 18th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2023, Dominguez became the third manager in Somerset Patriots Double-A franchise history and in 2024 he will become the first to serve as manager for more than one season. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015.

KEVIN MARTIR: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Kevin Martir begins his first season in Somerset and fourth in the Yankees organization, after serving in the same position for High-A Hudson Valley in 2023 and Single-A Tampa for two seasons in 2021-22. He joined the Yankees organization in 2020 and had been scheduled to serve as hitting coach for former Rookie-Advanced level Pulaski, prior to the cancellation of the minor league season. Martir began his coaching career in 2019 as a development coach for the GCL Phillies East. Martir starred at catcher during his playing career at the University of Maryland (2013-15), where he was a semi-finalist for the Johnny Bench Award in 2015. Martir was drafted by the Houston Astros in the 18th round of the 2015 MLB Draft. He played two professional seasons for the Astros with Rookie-Advanced Greeneville in 2015 and Short-Season Class-A Tri-City in 2016. A native of Brooklyn, New York, Martir graduated from the Grand Street Campus in 2012, after transferring from Xaverian High School in Brooklyn prior to his senior year.

BRETT DeGAGNE: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Brett DeGagne begins his first season with Somerset and fourth year in the Yankees organization. After making his organizational coaching debut as the Single-A Tampa Tarpons' pitch-ing coach in 2021, DeGagne most recently served as the FCL Yankees pitching coach in 2022 and 2023, his staff led the Florida Complex League in strikeouts (587) and finished fourth in ERA (4.47). DeGagne was initially tabbed to be the DSL Yankees pitching coach in 2020, before the cancellation of the minor league season. DeGagne played college ball at the University of North Dakota from 2012-2016. He moved on to grad school at St. Cloud State University, where DeGagne also began his baseball coaching career. He served as the Huskies' pitching coach during the 2017-2018 seasons. He gained additional coaching experience in 2018 as the pitching coach for the Bismarck Larks of the Northwoods League. One year prior to joining the Yankees, in 2019 DeGagne took over as pitching coach for North Iowa Area Community College.

AARON BOSSI: Defensive Coach (3rd year)

Aaron Bossi returns for his third consecutive season as the Patriots' defensive coach. Under Bossi's leadership in each of the past two seasons, infielders Jesus Bastidas (2B, 2022) and T.J. Rumfield (1B, 2023) were each awarded Rawlings Minor League Gold Gloves for their work in the field. Bossi has also overseen Somerset's baserunning program each of the last two seasons, leading the team to an Eastern League-best 205 stolen bases in 2022 and a Double-A-best 256 stolen bases in 2023. Bossi made his coaching debut as Hudson Valley's defensive coach in 2021. Prior to his coaching experience with the Yankees, he spent 2017-2019 assisting rehabbing players at the organization's minor league complex in Tampa. The St. Louis, Missouri native was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Yankees on June 24, 2016 as a catcher/infielder. He played in 22 games for the GCL Yankees East in 2016

2024: The Yankees assigned Vrieling to Double-A Somerset to start the 2024 season without any pitching experience at any level of the Yankees minor league system. In his third career game on 4/19/24 vs. HFD, Vrieling started and went 7.2 hitless innings, before being lifted at 100 pitches in a scoreless game. In what wound up being a one-hitter for the Patriots, the game ended with a Ben Rice leadoff, walk-off home run in the bottom of the ninth inning for a 1-0 win. Following the outing, Vrieling was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on 4/22/24. Following his first month of professional baseball with Someset, Vrieling was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for April. In his first four career starts, Vrieling ranked among the Eastern League leaders with a 1.88 ERA (4th), 0.75 WHIP (1st) and .145 BAA (3rd).

2022-23: Vrieling did not pitch following the 2022 MLB Draft. Following the draft, the Yankees shut him down and put him on a weight-training and diet routine to become stronger. During Spring Training of 2023, he sustained a stress fracture in his pitching elbow and wound up spending the entire 2023 season on the 60-day Injured List. However, following the 2023 season, Vrieling was sent to the Arizona Fall League to pitch for the Mesa Solar Sox. In his first affiliated pitching experience, Vrieling started five games for Mesa, combining for 10.2 IP with 15 K, 6 BB and a 5.06 ERA.

College: Appeared in 42 games over three seasons at Gonzaga from 2020-2022, going 5-7 with a 4.31 ERA and 178 strikeouts in 137.2 innings. Vrieling worked primarily out of the bullpen his first two seasons, including in 2021 when he made 20 of his 22 appearances in relief and was a WCC All-Conference Honorable Mention. In 2022, he transitioned to the starting rotation, when he went 4-4 in 15 starts.

Personal Notes: Born in Lewiston, ID and moved to Kennewick, WA when he was 5-years-old. Attended Kamiakin High School (WA), where he took basketball more seriously than baseball to begin with. He stopped playing basketball as a junior, after he broke his ankle. As a senior on the mound, he posted a 0.56 ERA with 63 strikeouts in 55 innings and was named MCC Pitcher of the Year and First Team pitcher.

Career Notes: Selected by the Yankees in the third round of the 2022 MLB Draft, signing on July 25, 2022 for a slot value bonus of \$611,400. Had been ranked by MLB.com as the No. 71 Draft prospect in 2022.

Seigler graduated from Cartersville with Jacksonville Jaguars quarterback and 2021 No. 1 overall draft pick Trevor Lawrence, whom he played football with during elementary school. During high school, Seigler also played for USA Baseball's U18 National Team, winning the 2017 U18 World Cup. He was committed to play at the University of Auburn prior to signing with the Yankees. Seigler is of Navajo descent and would join Jacoby Ellsbury as the second Navajo to play in the Majors. Named after the late Tony Phillips, an 18-year Major League veteran infielder and friend of his father's. Growing up in Cartersville, GA, Seigler's favorite plater was Chipper Jones.

Career Notes: Selected by the Yankees in the 1st round of the 2018 MLB Draft, making him the third catcher to be chosen by the Yankees in the first round of the MLB Draft (David Parrish, 28th overall and Thurman Munson, fourth overall).

2023: Began his professional career as a member of FCL Yankees. Wegner homered in his first two Professional games on 7/29 and 7/30. After going 4-for-9 with 2 HR and 6 RBI over two games with the FCL Yankees, Wegner was promoted to Single-A Tampa on 8/2. He played three games with Tampa, go-ing 3-for-12 with 2 RBI before being promoted to High-A Hudson Valley. Wegner rounded out his debut

campaign with 19 games for the Renegades, over which he hit. 254 with 2 HR and 6 RBI. **College:** Wegner was a four-year starter at Creighton from 2019-22, before transferring to Arkansas for his fifth year of eligibility. As a freshman, he earned All-Big East 2nd Team honors, batting .264 with 20 RBI and 1 HR, which came in the form of a grand slam in his first collegiate game. In 2017, he jumped to the 18Ŭ league as a 15-year-old. Vargas was part of the first signing class which allowed Cuban players to be signed by MLB teams without having to defect.
