### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox lost last night 4-2 on a walk-off three run homer from Jase Bowen in the bottom of the ninth. Down to his final strike, Bowen hit his sixth homer of the season off **Cameron Weston** to give Altoona its first win of the series. Bowie was held scoreless until the eighth after **Samuel Basallo** grounded home **Frederick Bencosme**. Bencosme gave Bowie its first lead of the game in the ninth with a go-ahead two-out RBI single. Starting righty **Carlos Tavera** threw five shutout innings with three strikeouts.

### START ME UP

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the lowest ERA in Double-A and second lowest in MiLB at 1.86. Over the last four games, the starters have combined to throw 18.1 consecutive innings without an earned run allowed. In this series, Baysox starters have yet to allow a run.

### BASALLO BASHES

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for 2nd in the Eastern League in total bases (167) and is tied for 2nd in hits (103). The No. 3 O's/ No. 11 MLB prospect is shares the league lead with Reading's Gabriel Rincones Jr. for the most hits this month (17).

### BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** made his Double-A debut on Tuesday and recorded his first Double-A hit and RBI on a single to right in the 4th. At the time of promotion, the Orioles 2023 first rounder stole 59 bases, which led the South Atlantic League and was second in all of Minor League Baseball.

### THE FABULOUS FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** retook the Eastern League lead in home runs with his 18th on the season on Tuesday. Amongst all Double-A hitters, he is tied for 4th in home runs. The O's No. 13 prospect has 33 career home runs with the Baysox, the 13th Baysox player in franchise history to eclipse 30 career homers.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

After his second consecutive multi-hit game, OF **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in his last 10 consecutive games and in 78 of 96 played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is 2nd in the Eastern League in walks (55) and tied for 3rd in stolen bases (26).

### WELCOME TO DOUBLE-A

IF/OF **Tavian Josenberger** and OF **Reed Trimble** have recorded their first Double-A hits since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen on Tuesday. Josenberger collected a pair of hits in his debut while Trimble cleared the bases with a double down the line. At the time of their promotions, Josenberger stole 45 bases, 2nd most in the South Atlantic League, while Trimble went 27-for-27 in stolen base attempts.

### SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .322 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .437 and OPS of .810. The 23-year-old has hits in 10 of his last 13 games with multi-hit performances in five of those contests. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 23 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

### TROUBLE WITH THE CURVE

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve are tied for fourth in the Southwest Division with a record of 16-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Pirates has won 10 of the last 11 games against the Baysox. Three of the Pirates top 30 prospects are on the Curve active roster - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 7), LHP Hunter Barco (No. 8), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 18).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Drake Fellows makes his 10th start of the season for Altoona. The 26-year-old is coming off a performance to forget at Portland last Saturday in which he gave up a career-high nine runs on seven hits in just 2.1 innings of work. Fellows faced the Baysox earlier this season on June 19 and conceded three first inning runs on three hits and was pulled after recording only two outs. He is in his first season with the Curve.

**2024: Tied for 6th-most innings (85.0) in O's system this season. Threw only 2.2 IP, gave up 2 R on 3 H with 4 BB on 64 pitches in most recent start on 8/10 vs HBG. Owns a 5.53 ERA in eight second half starts. Recorded a 4.08 ERA in the first half. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Owns a 4.19 ERA in 10 road starts. Baysox are 6-15 when Bright starts. Holds a 4.15 ERA in four career outings vs ALT. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA (9th lowest in EL) over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.**

**2023:** Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

**2022:** Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

**College:** Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
