JONES + JACKS: Keith Jones II is the third Spartanburgers player to hit home runs in back-to-back games. Jones's leadoff homer, the second for the 'Burgers this year, came after he popped a solo shot over the left field wall Friday night. Gleider Figuereo was the last Hub City hitter to hit homers in back-to-back games, on May 21 and 22 v. Rome.

OFFENSIVE UPSWING: Hub City's offense lagged behind for most of the first half, posting a .211 batting average, the worst in the SAL. The 'Burgers were bottom-five in the league in runs, hits, doubles and triples. However, HC has 10+ hits in two of its three games against BG, both of which have been losses.

THE SWING OF DREILING: Dylan Dreiling smacked his sixth home run of the season last night, a 372-foot golf shot out to right. After missing two weeks due to injury, Dreiling has six hits in this series.

DAVALILLO TO DOUBLE-A: Monday, the Rangers announced David Davalillo's promotion to Double-A Frisco. Davalillo departs the South Atlantic League as the league leader in ERA (2.12), BAA (.170) and WHIP (0.82). The right-hander won SAL pitcher of the week (April 15-20), Rangers pitcher of the month (April) and SAL pitcher of the month (May) in his short time in Spartanburg.

MOORE'S ON THE MEND: Monday, the Rangers assigned Malcolm Moore to the Arizona Complex League Rangers, as he works his way back from a fractured right hand. Texas's No. 3 prospect had reached base 17 times through his first nine games with the Spartanburgers, including three doubles and a homer (which came against the Hot Rods) before being placed on the IL

ROUND ONE: Hub City and Bowling Green split the inaugural series at Fifth Third Park from April 15-20. The Spartanburgers won their first-ever game at home 5-3, and followed it up with a Wednesday victory, but BG bounced back thanks to two strong pitching performances from Garrett Edwards and Gary Gill Hill. Hub City plated 15 Saturday to cruise to a W, but dropped Sunday thanks to a Bowling Green bullpen game.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-Asaffiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the Down East

Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager, and Chad Comer serves as the first manager in Spartanburger's history.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ball-park seats over 5,000 people. The Johnson



Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Sprartanburgers game is the home opener in 2025 against Bowling Green.




Chad Comer - Manager

Chad Comer is the first ever manager of the Hub City Spartanburgers. He enters his tenth year as a coach in the minor leagues and joins Hub City after two seasons as the manager of the then-High-A Hickory Crawdads. Comer played collegiately for the University of Texas-Arlington. A four-year starter, he was named to the Buster Posey Watch List prior to his senior season. He was drafted in the 29th round of the 2011 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves, and he played two seasons of minor league baseball.



Drew Sannes - Hitting Coach

Drew Sannes joins the Hub City Spartanburgers as the hitting coach for the 2025 season after spending the past two years as the hitting coach for the Hickory Crawdads. In 2022, Sannes served as a development coach for the ACL Rangers. His coaching career began in 2020 when he served as the head coach at North Iowa Community College. As a player, Sannes started his collegiate career at the University of North Dakota. He finished it hitting .275 in two seasons with Concordia University-St. Paul.



Thomas St. Clair - Pitching Coach

Thomas St. Clair begins his fourth season as a coach in the Texas Rangers organization and first as the pitching coach for the Hub City Spartanburgers. St. Clair previously served as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College. The Winston-Salem, NC native played his college ball at Lenoir-Rhyne. He was drafted in the 24th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the St. Louis Cardinals. St. Clair played two seasons in the minor leagues.



Jay Sullenger - Development Coach

Jay Sullenger has served as a player development coach in the Rangers organization since 2019. Previously, Sullenger spent five years as the head coach at Biola University and over a decade as the associate head coach at James Madison University.



Elevys Gonzalez - Development Coach

Elevys Gonzalez began his Rangers coaching career in 2020 as a hitting coach in the DSL. He served as the DSL Rangers manager for two years before coming to the states. Gonzalez is a native of Venezuela and played professionally for six years in the minor leagues.
