LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn captured Tuesday's series opener vs. Wilmington, 4-2... LF Ryan Clifford powered a solo home run in the bottom of the 3rd to start the scoring...Cyclones added 3 more in the 4th on a throwing error and a sacrifice fly by Clifford...Wilmington tallied their only 2 runs in the 5th on an RBI double from 3B Yohandy Morales and a single from C Matt Suggs...Morales went 3-for-3 with a walk, while Suggs collected a pair of knocks...RHP Dylan Hall (3.2 IP) and RHP Jeffrey Colón combined to toss 4.2 innings of 1-hit shutout relief to close out Brooklyn's win...Hall took the victory and Colón was credited with the save.

**ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS:** Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance...The Cyclones are 35-26 in the second half and tied with Jersey Shore (34-27) atop the North Division of the SAL with 5 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn because of winning the season series (15-11).

**KING STANLEY:** OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He added another blast on Saturday and top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He added another blast on Saturday and is 2 home runs (20) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...He and Álvarez are the only two players in franchise history to record a 20-plus home run season...Entering Wednesday, Consuegra is 4th in the SAL slugging percentage (.477), 5th in home runs (20), 8th in extra-base hits (39), and tied for 8th in total bases (163)...Over his last 17 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .258/.329/.621 with a .950 OPS, adding 17 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 6 home runs, and 19 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (6), RBI (19), and total bases (41) in addition to being tied for the lead in extra-base hits (10) and triples (2) triples (2).

JETT THE MET: INF Jett Williams has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .305/.467/.570 with a 1.037 OPS, 33 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 8 home runs, 20 RBI, 44 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 44 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 195 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.467) and OPS (1.037)...He also leads MiLB in walks (44)...On the season, Williams is tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in walks (98)...Among teenagers, Williams leads MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 120 PA) in on-base percentage (.426), OPS (.974), and walks (29)...He is also 2nd in slugging percentage (.528), tied for 2nd in stolen bases (10), 4th in batting average (.287), tied for 4th in extra-base hits (14) and doubles (8), and tied for 5th in hits (31), ...Among SAL players with at least 130 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is 2nd in the circuit in walk rate (20.9%), 3rd in OBP (.446), and 4th in wRC+ (168), wOBA (.441), and 8th in OPS (.974).

**CLIFF NOTES:** OF **Ryan Clifford** has been an on-base machine since joining the Cyclones on August 3...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 13 straight games dating back to the start of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his games dating back to the start of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his debut with the 'Clones, Clifford is tied for 6th in the South Atlantic League in walks (18) and home runs (6)...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 30 fewer games (28 to 58) and 126 fewer plate appearances (124 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 1th-round pick enters Wednesday ranked leading the SAL in slugging percentage (.498), 3rd home runs (22), 4th in OPS (.840), and tied for 6th in RBI (64)...Clifford is also leads in isolated power (.252) by percentage points over teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (.243), and 6th in wOBA (.373) and wRC+ (125).

LUGO LAND: INF William Lugo has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Lugo has reached safely in 11 consecutive games and is 13-for-39 at the plate (.333) with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, 7 RBI, and 7 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .328/.405/.438 with a .843 OPS...Lugo has also scored 7 runs, picked up 5 doubles, a triple, 13 RBI, and 8 walks in 18 games...The Dominican native is tied for 4th in the league lead in hits (21) and 6th in RBI (13) in that span.

**THE AMAZING ALEX:** OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Wednesday, the Dominican native is tied for the franchise record in hits (162) with INF **José Peroza** (162)... He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in walks (69), tied for 2nd in RBI (87) with OF **Stanley Consuegra**, 3rd in total bases (239), runs scored (85), and RBI (86).

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Wednesday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.45 ERA (317 ER in 826.1 IP) over their last 95 games, holding a 52-43 record, which is the

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for the final regular season series in 2023 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: 3B Yohandy Morales (8), LHP Jake Bennett (10), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (13), OF Daylen Lile (14), OF T.J. White (16), RHP Andry Lara (19)...De La Rosa is currently on the 7-day IL and White is on the Development List...Through the first 24 meetings of the season, Brooklyn is 13-12 against Wilmington, including only 6-7 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones are 7-5 this year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...The 'Clones are 39-36 all-time against the 'Rocks.

2nd lowest in the minors...Tampa Bay's Single-A Charleston (3.39) holds the lowest mark...The Cyclones have hurled 10 shutouts in that span, tied for 2nd most in Mil.B... For the entire season, Brooklyn holds the 7th-lowest ERA (3.77)...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.648), and 4th in hits-per-9 innings (7.34) and batting average against (.220).

**THE DONUT SHOPPE:** Brooklyn collected its 11th shutout win of the season with a 6-0 blanking at Greenville on Saturday...RHP **Robert Colina** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Joe Joe Rodríguez** (3.0) combined on the blanking...With Saturday's performance, the Cyclones have set a new franchise record for single-season shutouts...Before 2023, Brooklyn had accrued 10 shutouts in a season that happened on 4 separate occasions...It previously happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014... The 11 shutouts are tied for the 5th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

GRAB A SEAT: RHP Robert Colina became the 6th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 10 Drive batters on Saturday night...He joins RHP Joander Suárez who whiffed 11 vs. Aberdeen on August 11...RHP Jordany Ventura punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on August 9, RHP Cameron Foster K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP Tyler Stuart struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP Blade Tidwell accomplished the feat on 4 separate ocasions...Only Greenville has as many pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP Dario Álvarez (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP Miller Díaz (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP Robert Gsellman (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP Dawrin Frías (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP John Gant (7/26 @ ABD).

**THE ROCO SHOW:** RHP **Robert Colina** registered one of the best performances of his career on Saturday at Greenville...The Venezuela native set a career-high in innings pitched (6.0) and tied a career-best in strikeouts (10) in a 6-0 shutout...Since his 7-strikeout performance vs. Hudson Valley on June 21, Colina holds a 4-3 record with a 3.30 ERA (16 ER in 43.2 IP)...The 22-year-old has surrendered just 41 hits and walked 7 with 55 strikeouts over his last 12 appearances (7 starts)...Colina's strikeout rate is up 6.7 percent (31.1 K%) and the walk rate is down 7.0 percent (4.0 BB%) from his first 7 appearances (1 start).

**DE RECORD SETTER:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 106 stolen bases in that span, which is 8th most in MiLB...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Christian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Raimon Gómez (24), RHP Layonel Ovalles (28), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasil (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS Jett Williams (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (5), OF Ryan Clifford (6), RHP Blade Tidwell (10), OF Alex Ramírez (11), RHP Christian Scott (12), IF Jacob Reimer (13), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Raimon Gómez (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF Ronny Mauricio (No. 4), RHP Mike Vasil (9), RHP Dominic Hamel (16), and OF Matt Rudick (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100. LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his first loss with Brooklyn in Game 1 of last Thursday's doubleheader at Greenville... Credited with a complete game after allowing 1 run on 2 hits over 6.0 innings...Did not walk a batter and struck out 7... Tossed 74 pitches and 53 strikes (71.6%)...Only run allowed was on a leadoff home run to CF Roman Anthony in the bottom of the 1st...Drive won the lid-lifter, 1-0...Brooklyn captured the nightcap, 7-4.

**DOMINANT DE LA CRUZ:** The 22-year-old hurled his second-straight quality start in Game 1 last Thursday, hurling all 6 innings in the lid-lifter at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher in over 2 years...RHP José Butto was the last to accomplish the feat, tossing 6.0 innings in a 7-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021... Since making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz is tied for 2nd in the league in strikeouts (13).

FELIPE FINISHES WITH A FLOURISH: De La Cruz racked up the strikeouts in bunches over his final month at Single-A... Over his final 8 appearances (7 starts) since his start on July 2 vs. Dunedin, De La Cruz paced the Florida State League and all Single-A players in strikeouts (57)...Struck out 8 more batters than Clearwater's LHP **Danny Wilkinson** (49) who was second...De La Cruz went 1-2 with a 4.33 ERA (17 ER in 35.1 IP) with 18 walks (11.4 BB%) and 57 strikeouts (36.1%).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-yearold led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.4%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.73)... In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz is 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.

**2022:** Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on June 5...Composed a 1-2 record with a 4.83 ERA (17 ER in 31.2 IP), 16 walks (11.6 BB%), and 44 strikeouts (31.9 K%)...
