Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Charlotte Knights play game two of a six-game series tonight in Charlotte. Nashville won the series opener last night, 6-4. Tonight, right-hander Zack Godley gets the ball for the Sounds against right-hander Reynaldo Lopez for the Knights.

Zack Godley: 31-year-old Zack Godley starts for the Sounds tonight. Godley is making his fourth Nashville appearance and third start. He is 2-0 with a 0.69 ERA in 13.0 innings. His last time out was a start against the Columbus Clippers on May 27. He threw 6.0 shutout innings and earned his second win of the season. The South Carolina native was designated for assignment by Milwaukee on May 10 and joined Nashville on May 12. The Brewers signed Godley on March 19. He has pitched in the big leagues for Milwaukee, Boston, Arizona and Toronto. He was drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 10th round of the 2013 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Tennessee.

Reynaldo López: 27-year-old Reynaldo López starts for Charlotte in game two of the series tonight. The right-hander is 0-2 with a 6.55 ERA in 3 starts for the Knights in 2021. In 11.0 innings, he has allowed 8 runs on 15 hits and 3 walks to go along with 11 strikeouts. Opposing batters are hitting at a .333 clip against him. López last pitched on May 25 in a start against the Norfolk Tides. He got a no-decision after he tossed 5.0 innings in Charlotte's 5-4 loss. He allowed 2 runs on 7 hits and did not walk a batter. Prior to the 2021 season, the last time he pitched in Triple-A was in 2017 when he made 22 starts for Charlotte. He pitched for the White Sox from 2017-2020. López was part of the December 7, 2016 trade that sent outfielder Adam Eaton to the Washington Nationals.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East South-east Division standings in 2021: First: 8, Second: 5, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

On a Roll: Nashville's 13-game winning streak is the longest the club has had in nearly three years and is the longest winning streak in Minor League Baseball during the 2021 season. Triple-A Omaha has won nine consecutive games. The last time a Sounds team won 13 or more games was the 15-game winning streak that matched a franchise record from July 29-August 14, 2018.

Inside the Streak: During Nashville's current 13-game winning streak, the team is hitting .258 (112-for-434) with 32 doubles, 26 home runs and 57 walks. The team has scored 84 runs and is averaging 6.5 runs per game. The pitching staff has compiled a 2.75 ERA (36 ER/118.0 IP) and has allowed 77 hits and 44 walks to go along with 133 strikeouts. Nashville pitchers have a 1.03 WHIP and has limited opponents to a .183 batting average.

Dustin Peterson for Six: Nashville outfielder has hit safely in six consecutive games, the second time in 2021 he has compiled a hitting streak of at least six games. He's hitting .296 (8-for-27) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 8 RBI and 2 walks during the streak.

Reyes Makes it 50: Infielder Pablo Reyes had his second multi-hit game with Nashville last night and his hitting .417 (5-for-12) in his first three games with the team. The multi-hit effort from Reyes was the 50th of the season for the Sounds. Zach Green, Keston Hiura, Dustin Peterson and Corey Ray lead the team with five each.

10+ Hits = A Winning Formula: In Sunday's 9-3 win at Columbus, Nashville collected a season-high 14 hits. It was the eighth time the Sounds have had at least 10 hits in a game in 2021. They are now 8-0 when recording 10+ hits.

In The History Book: The Sounds have the club's best record through the first 24 games of the season at 19-5. The 2003 and 2006 Nashville Sounds' teams each started 17-7 through the first 24 contests.

Grass Is Always Greener: Despite yesterday's 0-for-3 game, Sounds infielder Zach Green is still among league leaders in several offensive categories, including: home runs (1st, 9), RBI (1st, 256, extra-base hits (T-2nd, 13), slugging percentage (3rd, .608), total bases (T-6th, 51) and OPS (9th, 1.001).

Road Warriors: The Sounds have won 10 straight games on the road and are averaging 7.70 runs per game during that span.

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,046-1,926. The 2,046 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
