**GAME RECAP:**

Behind solid pitching from Colton Eastman and a two-run home run from Aldrem Corredor, the Reading Fightin Phils defeated the Somerset Patriots (Yankees) 4-2 on Wednesday. Josh Ockimey reached base in all four of his plate attempts, which included three hits. Corredor hit a two-run homer while Jhailyn Ortiz and Chris Sharpe each picked up an RBI. Eastman pitched seven innings in the start and allowed one run on four hits while issuing one walk and striking out four. JoJo Romero picked up three strikeouts through the final two innings in route to earning the save in an MLB rehab appearance.

**SECOND HALF SUMMER:**

Reading welcomes the Somerset Patriots (Yankees) to FirstEnergy Stadium starting June 28 to lead off the second half of the season. The Fightins finished the first half with a 29-40 record and ranked fifth in the Northeast division of the Eastern League. They claimed two series wins, one over New Hampshire (Blue Jays) and the other over Bowie (Orioles). Somerset (Yankees) finished first in the Northeast division with a one-game lead over Hartford (Rockies). In the Southwest division, Akron (Guardians) and Richmond (Giants) finished in a tie for the top spot, but the Flying Squirrels have the better record for the tie breaker.

**ROMERO REHAB:**

JoJo Romero gave the Fightins' bullpen a lift in Wednesday's game against the Patriots. The left-hander continued his MLB rehab assignment in Reading and pitched the eighth and ninth innings. Romero landed on the 60-day injured list on March 11, 2022 and began his rehab on June 14 with the Phillies rookie club before moving to Clearwater on June 17. Despite allowing runners on base and one to cross the plate, he kept the R-Phils in the lead. Romero picked up the save in the contest. He's expected to make one more relief appearance in Reading during the homestand before making his way back to Philadelphia.

**GUZZY AND CO:**

Jonathan Guzman and Aldrem Corredor each found rhythm at the plate recently. In the last 10 games, Corredor's batting average stands at .317 and Guzman's is at .278. Corredor leads the team with 13 hits and is tied for the team lead with six RBIs in the same frame while Guzman added 10 hits and five runs scored. Corredor has two homers in the last 10 games. One was a grand slam in a 6-1 win over Altoona (Pirates) and the other was a two-run shot on Wednesday against Somerset (Yankees). Guzman hit a home run in last week's win on Tuesday over Binghamton (Mets).

**EASY EASTMAN:**

Colton Eastman continues to shine on the mound for Reading. He provided a boost to the starting rotation, going for six innings in each of his first four starts and seven in his most recent start on Wednesday against Somerset. Eastman picked up his first win of the season as he gave up one run on four hits while surrendering just one walk and striking out four batters. He boasts a 1.80 ERA through 25 innings of work with the Fightins.

**BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:**

The Phillies lost 4-1 to the Braves at home on Wednesday. Rhys Hoskins hit a solo homer in the bottom of the third inning to give the home team a 1-0 lead, but that was the only run of the game for the Phillies. Hoskins totaled two hits while Didi Gregorius and Alec Bohm added a hit apiece. Ranger Suarez took the loss on the mound for the Phillies. He pitched 6.2 innings and gave up four runs on six hits while striking out seven. Mark Appel made his MLB debut in the ninth inning. He kept the Braves scoreless, giving up just one hit and striking out one. each had two hits in the contest.

**ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:**

**June 30, 2004:** At Reading, in a 10-6 loss to Altoona, Ryan Howard goes 2-for-4 with a solo home run, wrapping up one of the most prolific months for any player in Reading history. Howard is the unanimous choice for Eastern League Player of the Month for June as he bats .386 (44-for-114) with 15 HR, 10 doubles, 43 RBI and 28 runs scored.
