## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox lost their fifth consecutive game in a 9-2 defeat against the Akron RubberDucks. Akron scored six runs in the first five innings with five of the runs charged to starting right-hander  ${\bf Ryan\,Long}.$  Long went four innings and gave up a season-high five runs on eight hits with three walks and three strikeouts. Chesapeake broke Akron's shutout bid in the eighth on an RBI double by Jeremiah Jackson and sacrifice fly from Silas Ardoin. This is Chesapeake's second five-game losing streak this season, which matches its season-long,

#### CREED CRUSHES

C Creed Willems has been one of the best hitters in the league in the month of May. The Orioles No. 12 prospect is ninth in the league in slugging percentage (.553) and 12th in OPS (.902) this month. This season, Willems is tied for fourth in the league in doubles (10) and tied for third in extra base hits (15). The 21-year-old is the youngest position player on the team.

#### MAX CAN MASH

Since being activated off the injured list on May 3, IF Max Wagner is slashing .273/.314/.515 with three doubles, a triple, a homer and five RBI. Wagner has hit safely in seven of eight games in the month of May and delivered his first homer of the season on Wednesday.

#### WALK THIS WAY

C Silas Ardoin leads the Eastern League in walks (26). Ardoin drew the most walks in the league in the month of April with 18. No player has drawn more walks in the circuit since April 23 than Ardoin. Last season, he drew 47 walks in 104 games.

#### RETZ CAN RAKE

C Adam Retzbach has been one of Chesapeake's best hitters as of late. In his last 10 games, he is slashing .385/.484/.577 with three doubles, a homer and six RBI. Retzbach has reached base in 14 of his last 15 games.

#### NIFTY NESTOR

RHP Nestor German is scheduled to make his Double-A debut as Chesapeake's starter tonight. The Orioles No. 11 prospect earned promotion from High-A Aberdeen on Tuesday. German last pitched on Friday in Jersey Shore and matched his season-high with seven strikeouts in four innings, allowing just one unearned run. The 23-year-old was drafted in the 11th round by the O's in the 2023 Draft out of Seattle University.

#### **BULLPEN BEASTS**

Chesapeake's bullpen holds a 3.11 ERA, which is fourth-best in the Eastern League and fifth-best in all of Double-A. Baysox relievers lead the Eastern League and are second in Double-A in strikeouts (191).

#### ONE RUN WONDERS

Despite having scored the third-fewest runs in all of Double-A (118). Chesapeake currently leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in one-run victories with 11 so far this season.

#### RUBBERDUCKS ON THE ROAD

The Akron RubberDucks are the Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Last season, the RubberDucks won 13 of 18 games against Chesapeake, including a six-game sweep in the last series meeting. Akron's active roster features only three Guardians Top 30 prospects (MLB.com): IF Travis Bazzana (No. 1), C Cooper Ingle (No. 8), and RHP Austin Peterson (No. 29).

#### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Austin Peterson makes his eighth start of the season for Akron. The Guardians No. 29 prospect is the Eastern League's leader in ERA (1.69), is second in WHIP (0.80) and has allowed just four walks in 32.2 innings pitched. Last year, Peterson led all Guardians minor leaguers in innings pitched (160.0). Cleveland's 9th round pick in 2022 holds a 1.38 ERA in two career starts against the Baysox

**2025**: **Promoted to Double-A Chesapeake on 5/13.** Started season in High-A Aberdeen. Made six starts and posted a 3.60 ERA with 37 K over 25 innings pitched over 10 walks allowed. Struck out seven batters in each of his final three starts with IronBirds before earning promotion. At time of promotion, was tied for 10th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts.

**2024**: Spent first season in Minors between Single-A Delmarva as a starter and High-A Aberdeen as a tandem reliever. Struck out 90 batters in 73.2 innings to a 1.59 ERA. Began season in Delmarva. ## **ROBERTO MERCADO**

## Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. #### **CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS**



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

#### **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
