YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Bowie Baysox, 15-5. Bowie scored four runs in the first to open an early lead. **Brett Auerbach** hit a solo homer in the third to get Richmond on the board. Bowie answered with five more runs in the fourth to take a 9-1 lead. Flying Squirrels starter **Ryan Murphy** made his Double-A debut and allowed four runs over 3.2 innings. **Shane Matheny** hit a solo homer in the fifth and **Diego Rincones** homered in the sixth to close the score to 9-3. Bowie scored five in the sixth and one in the eighth to pull ahead, 15-3. Matheny drove in two runs in the ninth to pull Richmond within 10 runs.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. This series is the third this year between the Flying Squirrels and the Baysox. They opened the season with a three-game series at Prince George's Stadium from April 8-10, with Richmond winning two. The teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 26-May 1, with the Flying Squirrels winning five games in the set. The Flying Squirrels have been outscored in the series by the Baysox, 36-9.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on Sunday afternoon paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have four-of-five since Saturday. Last week, they split a six-game series at home against the Sea Dogs. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost three and split two this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 798 strikeouts and rank tied for first with 94 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 18-18 on the road this year. Richmond is 19-10 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE BAYSOX finished the first half with the worst record in the Eastern League at 27-42, 13.0 games behind Richmond in the Southwest Division standings. The Baysox are 5-1 in their last six games. Bowie's roster includes eight of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including OF Colton Cowser (4), 3B Coby Mayo (7), 2B Connor Norby (10), INF Cesar Prieto (11), SS Joseph Ortiz (14), OF Hudson Haskin (15), LHP Drew Rom (16) and INF Adam Hall (26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his team-leading 15th start of the season and third against the Baysox. Last time out, Teng worked a season-high 6.1 innings and allowed one unearned run on one hit in a win over the Sea Dogs last Friday. Over his last five starts since June 2, Teng has gone 3-0 with a 3.20 ERA (9 ER/25.1 IP/29 SO/18 BB). Teng faced the Baysox in his Double-A debut on April 9 at Prince George's Stadium and worked five scoreless innings. He pitched against the Baysox on April 27 at The Diamond and allowed six runs in four innings. Teng has allowed three-or-less runs in each of his last six starts since May 26, working at least five innings in five of them. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. *For more on Teng, see page two.*

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Noah Denoyer makes his first Double-A start. He last pitched last Friday at Erie and worked four scoreless innings. Denoyer started the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 4-0 with a 2.40 ERA in five relief appearances. He was promoted to Double-A Bowie on May 10 and has made eight relief appearances for the Baysox. Over his last four outings since June 5, Denoyer has posted a 0.55 ERA (1 ER/16.1 IP). Denoyer was signed as a free agent by the Orioles in 2019.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,198) and total attendance (216,919). Richmond is 11th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 94 home runs this season, which is tied for first in the Eastern League with Somerset. **Sean Roby** is second in the league with 19 homers on the season, with 16 coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 180 home runs. The Flying Squirrels have already hit more homers than entire seasons in 2010 (71), 2011 (83) 2012 (76), 2014 (74) and 2015 (61), 2016 (83), 2017 (93) and 2019 (84).

GO, DIEGO, GO! After hitting .173 (22-for-127) over his first 35 games of the season, **Diego Rincones** is batting .407 (22-for-54) with four doubles, five homers and 16 RBIs over his last 14 games since June 7. He started the stretch with two doubles on June 7 against the SeaWolves and hit his first homer of the season the next day. He collected a season-high three hits in the series finale against the SeaWolves on June 12, capping the game with a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. It was his second walk-off hit as a member of the Flying Squirrels. He has homered in four of his last seven games played.

SHANE TRAIN: Since May 1, **Shane Matheny** is batting .315 (39-for-124) with eight homers, five doubles, a triple and 24 RBIs in 38 games. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They posted the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. From May 14-June 10, he posted a 13-game hitting streak, tied for the longest in the EL this season, even with a 13-game streak for Portland's Pedro Castellanos from May 6-22. From May 1-June 11, Matheny posted a 24-game on-base streak, which was the second-longest in the league this season. In the month of June, he walked 15 times and struck out 15 times in 18 games. In the Eastern League this season, Matheny is ranked fourth in batting average (.300), second in OBP (.429), eighth in SLG (.519) and third in OPS (.948). He is also ranked third in the EL in wRC+ (.162) and wOBA (.415) and first among active EL players.

TOASTY: Over his last 16 games since June 9, **Frankie Tostado** is batting .175 (10-for-57) with three homers and six RBIs. From April 22-June 8, Tostado hit .342 (51-for-149) with seven homers, nine doubles, a triple and 26 RBIs in 39 games. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked fifth in batting average (.291), tied for fourth in hits (71) and eighth in total bases (117).

ROBUST: **Sean Roby** hit his 19th homer of the year on Sunday afternoon against the Sea Dogs, moving ahead of **Jarrett Parker** (2013) and **Mario Lissin** (2014) for the most homers in a season in team history, trailing only **David Villar**'s record 20 homers last season. He is second in the EL in home runs this year, trailing Erie's Kerry Carpenter (22). He has hit 16 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by **Adam Duval** in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

GENO: Since joining the Flying Squirrels, **Ricardo Genovés** has picked up at least one hit in eight of his nine games played to open his Double-A career. On Tuesday, he picked up his first Double-A homer, going deep against rehabbing MLB pitcher Matt Harvey. He added an RBI single in Wednesday's loss. Genovés began the year with Triple-A Sacramento, batting .233 in 38 games with three homers and 21 RBIs.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: **Frankie Tostado** is ranked fifth in batting average (.291), tied for fourth in hits (71) and eighth in total bases (117). **Sean Roby** is second in homers (19). **Shane Matheny** is fourth in batting average (.300), second in OBP (.429), eighth in SLG (.519) and third in OPS (.948). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for fifth in stolen bases (17). **Ryan Walker** is tied for first in wins (6). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (6). **Matt Frisbee** is tied for first in complete games (1).

WHERE THE BAYSOX RANK: In the Eastern League, Gunnar Henderson is second in batting average (.312), first in OBP (.452), second in SLG (.573), first in OPS (1.025), tied for fifth in walks (41) and tied for 10th in runs scored (41). Adam Hall is tied for eighth in stolen bases (16).

JUNE WRAP: In the month of June, the Flying Squirrels went 15-11, which was tied for the third-best record in the Eastern League. The pitching staff was third in ERA (3.72) and second in strikeouts (259). The offense hit .218, which was 11th in the league. **Sean Roby** ranked tied for fourth in the Eastern League in homers (7). **Mike Gigliotti** ranked fourth in OBP (.415), eighth in OPS (.945) and eighth in stolen bases (6). **Bryan Brickhouse** and **Kai-Wei Teng** were tied for first in wins (3). Brickhouse was sixth in ERA (2.25). **Kyle Harrison** ranked tied for first in strikeouts (41). **Matt Frisbee** was second in innings pitched (31.0) and Brickhouse was tied for sixth (28.0). Harrison was tied for fourth in BAA (.170) and Teng was ninth (.207). Brickhouse was sixth in WHIP (1.04).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Ryan Murphy** (10), **Ricardo Genovés** (24) and **Chris Wright** (27). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." **Simon Whiteman** is listed as the system's "Fastest Baserunner." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Murphy (11), **Brett Auerbach** (27), Genovés (29) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (30). Harrison is *Baseball America's* No. 64 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 45 overall prospect.
