TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: The Saints pitching staff managed clean innings in six of the eight innings they threw on Sunday. However, in the other two, Louisville managed to score nine runs on seven hits in a 9-4 loss before the All-Star Break. The Saints scored the first run of the game on a Yunior Severino sacrifice fly. After Aaron Rozek retired the first nine batters of the game, Zack Weiss was tagged for six runs over 2.0 innings. Austin Brice allowed three more to score in the sixth, part of a five-run inning. Ronny Henriquez allowed an inherited runner to score,

but only allowed the single in 1.2 innings of relief. Anthony Prato hit his second homer of the season in the eighth, cutting the hole to 9-4. Caleb Baragar made his return from the Injured List, throwing a perfect inning in the bottom of the frame.

TROUBLE IN TOLEDO: Fifth Third Field has historically been a tough place for the Saints to hit in over the last four seasons. Here is how the Saints offense stacks up among road venues they have played at least 12 games in since 2021, sorted by batting average:

JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE: After his third-inning walk on Sunday, Edouard Julien has reached base in 24 consecutive games, the Saints' longest on-base streak this season. It is the third-longest streak in franchise history and the second-longest single-season streak, trailing only Trevor Larnach - 26 G (2022-23) and Jake Cave - 49 G (2022). During his 24-game streak, Julien is hitting .274/.465/.440 (.905 OPS).

REHAB ROUNDTABLE: After the Minnesota Twins reinstated Zack Weiss and sent him outright to St. Paul, the Saints now have one Major League Rehab assignment on their roster in Brock Stewart. Stewart has made two appearances, most recently on July 12. Over the two outings, he has pitched 2.0 innings, allowed one hit, one earned run, walked two and struck out three.

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .444 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in eight of the 10 games he's played in, drawing six walks and been hit by a pitch four times. <u>He is fourth among full-season minor league players in on-base percentage at .453 across three levels.</u>

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 10th home run of the season on July 10 and the 41st of his Saints career. He is now just two home runs away from tying Mark Contreras for the franchise lead at 43

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 43 games since May 21, he has hit .344 (54-for-157), with 10 home runs, drawing 31 walks to 43 strikeouts, owning a 1.036 OPS. Since June 1, Severino leads the IL in on-base percentage, sporting a .464 clip. He's second in batting average at .352 and fifth in OPS, at 1.054, ranking sixth in slugging percentage with a .590 mark. His 26 walks since the start of June are the fifth-most in the league.

TWINS UPDATE: The Minnesota Twins return from the All-Star Break tomorrow with a two-game series against Milwaukee. In the All-Star Game, Willi Castro went 0-for-1 as the Twins' lone representative to play in the game.

LAST START: 7/13 @ LOU...made 17th start of the season, allowing one earned run on five hits over 5.0 innings, walking two and striking out six...allowed an unearned run in the first inning after errant throw to second on a stolen base attempt came around to score on an RBI single...got out of the first with a lineout and 1-3 double play...retired seven in a row before allowing a solo home run to Blake Dunn to start the fourth inning...gave up an unearned run in the fifth inning after a dropped catch at first base...gave up back-to-back singles with two outs, plating the run...generated nine whiffs, six with the changeup...did not factor into decision in 5-4 Saints loss in 10 innings.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/7 v GWN...made 16th start of the season and second against Gwinnett...allowed two runs on six hits, walking three and striking out five over 4.1 innings of work...first run scored in the second inning, allowing a single to Eddle Rosario and a double to Chadwick Tromp, then retiring the next three batters...had multiple baserunners in each of the first four innings...only recorded one out on a fly ball...allowed a solo home run to Drake Baldwin in the fifth inning, the first home run he allowed since June 8...did not factor into the decision in a 4-2 Saints victory.

SAINTS RANDY: In 2023, Dobnak was a workhorse for the Saints, setting a number of single-season records. He set the franchise record for starts (26), innings pitched (126.1 IP), and strikeouts (115). The 2023 season was Dobnak's third with the Saints and consequently he is the franchise leader in two of those three categories as well: his 33 starts are four more than the #2 pitcher, Simeon Woods Richardson, his 164.1 IP are 12.0 more than Ronny Henriquez, and his 147 strikeouts are just eight shy of Ronny

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often go to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3.380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2.61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield

TWILIGHT SPARKLE MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL.

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything

NOT QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his flancées in full attire.

CANDLESTICKS MAKE A NICE GIFT: Before getting married, some of Dobnak's wedding registry gifts wound up in the Twins game notes on September 20 (Amazon Echo, 67-inch leaf rake and Pine-Sol). All of it was the handiwork of intern lan Kraft. The publicity of their registry becoming public made the soon to be married couple ask fans to donate to St. Jude's Children's Research Hospital, which has always been important to Aerial Dobnak due to her lifelong desire to be involved with children and her experience with the loss of a friend to cancer during her freshman year of college at Alderson Broaddus University, instead of buying them gifts. Their initial goal was \$2,000 and within 8 hours that goal was met. Eventually they raised \$4,093. But the story didn't end there. A representative of St. Jude reached out to her on social media afterward, wondering if the couple would be willing to engage in more significant involvement with the hospital once the wedding buzz had died down. They jumped at the opportunity, and the Dobnak's were flown to the hospital in Memphis for a weekend in January to meet patients, connect with fundraising coordinators and evaluate their options for continued future engagement.

The two other rookies to start in the Postseason for the Twins: Boof Bonser (Game 2, ALDS vs. OAK in 2006) and Les Straker (3 starts in 1987, 1 in ALCS at DET, 2 in WS at/vs. STL)
