**SUNDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Curve, 4-1, at The Diamond to seal a series split. **Carter Aldrete** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the second with a solo homer. Altoona's Drew Maggi tied the game, 1-1, in the fourth. Aldrete moved the Flying Squirrels back ahead in the fourth with an RBI double and a run scored on a double play to move the score to 3-1. In the seventh, **Luis Matos** hit a solo homer to stretch Richmond's lead to 4-1. **Carson Seymour** allowed one run over four innings in his start. **Matt Frisbee** and **Juan Sanchez** each pitched two scoreless innings. **Randy Rodriguez** threw a scoreless ninth to pick up his first save.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the opener of the six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. The two teams met for a six-game series at The Diamond from April 18-23, with Richmond winning four-of-six. The SeaWolves return to The Diamond for a six-game set from May 30-June 4 and the Flying Squirrels close the regular season at UPMC Park from September 12-17. The Flying Squirrels are 13-10 against opponents from the Southwest Division and 8-7 in games following a win. They are also 5-0 in series-openers this year.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** are in first place in the division, 2.5 games ahead of Altoona, and split last week's six-game series at home against the Curve. The Flying Squirrels offense is ranked third in the Eastern League in runs (134) and batting average (.241) and fourth in hits (200). The Richmond pitching staff is ranked second in ERA (3.08) and strikeouts (255).

**THE SEAWOLVES** were swept in five games against the Sea Dogs from April 26-30 before taking four-of-six against the Baysox in Bowie last week. The Erie offense leads the Eastern League in runs (136), homers (33) and RBIs (126). Erie's roster includes 10 of MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Wilmer Flores (No. 3), INF Colt Keith (No. 4), RHP Ty Madden (No. 5), INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8), C Dillon Dingler (No. 14), RHP Dylan Smith (No. 15), LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21), RHP Elvis Alvarado (No. 23), RHP Austin Bergner (No. 27) and INF Gage Workman (No. 29). Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes Flores (No. 3), Madden (No. 4), Keith (No. 5), Dingler (No. 7), Smith (No. 17), Perez (No. 19), Hurter (No. 26) and Workman (No. 27). Baseball America also including the following Erie players on their Best Tools list: Perez (best hitter for average), Andrew Magno (best curveball), Flores (best control), Dingler (best defensive catcher) and Workman (best defensive infielder and best infield arm).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Nick Zwack** makes his sixth Double-A start and his second against the SeaWolves. Last time out, he allowed three runs over three innings against the Curve on Wednesday at The Diamond. He faced the SeaWolves on April 20 in Richmond and allowed two runs in two innings of work, both scoring on solo homers. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. **For more on Zwack, see page two.**

**FOR ERIE:** Right-hander Keider Montero makes his second Double-A start. He made his Double-A debut last Wednesday at Bowie and allowed four runs over 3.1 innings. Montero began the season with High-A West Michigan and allowed five runs over in his first two starts before firing back-to-back scoreless starts on April 20 against Dayton and April 26 at Cedar Rapids, striking out 15 batters in eight innings. He spent the 2022 season with the Whitecaps and went 7-7 with a 4.51 ERA over 25 starts.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** On the year, the Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in total attendance (89,450) and average attendance (6,396). They're also ranked ninth overall of the 120 teams in the minors in average attendance. In 2022, the Flying Squirrels led all of Double-A in average (6,160) and total (406,560) attendance for the first time in franchise history.

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** Richmond's relievers have combined for a 2.26 ERA (33 ER/131.2 IP), which is the lowest in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels bullpen also leads the Eastern League in strikeouts (150) and is second in innings pitched (131.2). Richmond relievers are 10-for-12 in save opportunities (83.3%), the highest save conversion rate in the league. **Raymond Burgos** and **Blake Rivera** have both pitched eight games without allowing an earned run, tied for the longest streak in the league.

**RISPY BUSINESS:** For the season, the Flying Squirrels are batting .280 (65-for-232) with runners in scoring position, which leads the Eastern League. Richmond also has the second-best batting average in the league with runners in scoring position and two outs at .269 (29-for-108). With runners on base, the Flying Squirrels are leading the EL with a .284 average (110-for-388). The Flying Squirrels have scored four-or-more runs in a single inning 10 times this year. In last week's series, Richmond was held to 6-for-44 (136) with runners in scoring position, including .077 (2-for-26) over the last four games since Thursday.

**LUCY, I'M HOME:** Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels last Tuesday and made his official Double-A debut on Wednesday night. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On Thursday night, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. He has worked a walk in each of his four games for the Flying Squirrels.

**HEY HEY HADYEN:** After going 0-for-10 to open last week's series, **Hayden Cantrelle** hit his first Richmond homer in the second inning on Saturday night, adding a double and an RBI groundout, and he reached base with a walk and a HBP on Sunday. After going hitless in his first two games of the season, Cantrelle batted .319 (15-for-47, 4 2B, 3B, 8 RBI, 11 R) over a 14-game span from April 12-29 heading into last week's series. Cantrelle scored a run in eight straight games from April 12-20, the longest streak in the league this year.

**FULL MUNGUIA:** After going 0-for-15 over a three-game stretch from April 23-26, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .343 (12-for-35) with a homer, three doubles and five RBIs over his last nine games, including five two-hit games. He kicked off the stretch on April 27 in Bowie with a homer on the third pitch of the game, his second Double-A home run. Munguia is tied for sixth in the league in hits (27) and tied for fourth in runs scored (18). For the year, he is batting .375 (9-for-24) in the first inning.

**MATOS MANIA:** **Luis Matos** reached base in each of his first 17 Double-A games, the longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. He has reached base in five-of-his-seven games since then and in 23-of-25 games overall this season. For the year, Matos has struck out just 11 times in 105 plate appearances (10.5 percent), the third-lowest rate in the league.

**OLD FRIENDS:** Erie's roster includes former Flying Squirrels outfielder Diego Rincones, who signed with the Tigers as a free agent in December. Rincones played 142 games with Richmond over the 2021 and 2022 seasons, batting .269 (140-for-520) with 20 homers and 80 RBIs. Three total former Flying Squirrels are playing with other teams in the Eastern League this year. Pitcher Gray Fenter, who was with Richmond last season and with Bowie in 2021, is now with Somerset. First baseman Frankie Tostado, a member of the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, is now playing for Harrisburg.

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** In the Eastern League, **Tyler Fitzgerald** is ranked fifth in batting average (.324), eighth in OBP (.410), fifth in SLG (.588), fourth in OPS (.998), tied for sixth in doubles (6), first in triples (3), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (11) and tied for 10th in runs scored (15). **Ismael Munguia** is tied for sixth in hits (27) and tied for fourth in runs scored (18). **Riley Mahan** is tied for 10th in homers (4) and tied for seventh in RBIs (16). **Carter Aldrete** is tied for seventh in RBIs (16). **Andy Thomas** is tied for fourth in walks (19). **Luis Matos** is tied for ninth in hits (26) and tied for sixth in runs scored (17). **Kai-Wei Teng** is seventh in strikeouts (32). **Juan Sanchez** and **Nick Swiney** are tied for second in wins (3). **Evan Gates** is tied for sixth in saves (3).

**WHERE THE SEAWOLVES RANK:** Among the Eastern League leaders, Wenceel Perez is seventh in batting average (.307). Trei Cruz is tied for fourth in homers (5). Colt Keith is tied for fourth in homers (5), tied for second in RBIs (19), fourth in hits (31), tied for third in extra-base hits (12) and third in total bases (54). Jake Holton is 10th in OBP (.404). Gage Workman is tied for second in triples (2). Angel De La Cruz is tied or first in games pitched (10).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Luis Matos** (No. 5), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Nick Swiney** (No. 24) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter and Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Matos (No. 7), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

### THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2014, the Flying Squirrels beat the SeaWolves, 7-6, in 13 innings. Richmond led, 5-2, entering the ninth, but the Erie scored three to force extras. After the SeaWolves took a 6-5 lead in the 13th, Myles Schroder won the game in the bottom of the inning with a two-run single. Richmond set a franchise record with eight stolen bases in the game. Kelby Tomlinson set the franchise single-game record with five stolen bases while also collecting three hits.
