TEODO STRIKES OUT EIGHT, RIDERS DROP FINALE IN MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders lost their fourth game in a row on Sunday afternoon, falling 4-1 to the Midland RockHounds from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (44-25), who lost the series 5-1, found the scoreboard first in the top of the first inning on a **Cody Freeman** solo home run off of Midland (40-29) starter Blake Beers (5-5). It was his team-best seventh of the season and the Riders' second of the series. The RockHounds then struck back in the bottom of the first against **Emiliano Teodo**, plating a the tying run on a sacrifice fly from Brennan Milone. Teodo allowed two runs over his four innings while striking out eight and walking three. Denzel Clarke then took over with an RBI single in the fourth and two solo home runs in the sixth and eighth innings to make it 4-1. The Riders outhit the RockHounds 9-7 and received two-hit games from both **Josh Hatcher** and **Keyber Rodriguez**. **Abimelec Ortiz** (arguing safe/out call at second) and **Dane Acker** (arguing check swing call from the dugout) were both ejected in the game for Frisco. Danis Correa threw the last two innings for the Hounds, earning his fourth save of the season.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

Today marks the first day of the second half. After a Midland loss on last Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. In the first half, they owned the best record in all of Double-A at 44-25 and they won the Texas League South by 4.0 games over the Midland RockHounds. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022 and finished with the best record in Double-A for the first time since 2008. The Riders are on pace for 88 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007). Offensively, the Riders finished sixth in the league in batting average (.240), fifth in runs per game (4.8), seventh in home runs (45) and eighth in OPS (.680). Where they shined was on the pitching side, finishing first in ERA (3.49), third in batting average against (.231) and second in saves (19). Their relievers finished with a 2.95 ERA, which was fourth in all of Minor League Baseball.

BROKEN BATS

In their series against the RockHounds, the RoughRiders struggled offensively. Their 12 total runs across six games were last in the league while they slashed .201/.273/.286/.559 with two home runs. Frisco hit seven home runs in their last series against Amarillo. Frisco lost three of the six games last week by one run while losing five of six. It was their first time losing five of six in a series this season and their first time losing five games in a series since 5/9-13/2023 vs. Wichita (lost all five in a rain-shortened series). In that series, the Riders were outscored 54-29 in five games, while the Riders were outscored 19-12.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

With an error on Saturday, it snapped a streak of three-straight games without an error for the RoughRiders. The Riders have the fewest errors in all of Minor League Baseball (38) while also owning the best fielding percentage (.984) in the minors. Frisco's 66 double plays are second among non-Triple-A teams. Frisco are tied for the fewest stolen bases allowed in MiLB (44), throwing out 29 percent of total base runners against them.

THE (BULL)PEN IS MIGHTIER THAN THE SWORD:

Frisco's bullpen has been the best in the Texas League this season, owning a 2.96 ERA, which is also the fourth-best in all of Minor League Baseball. The Riders' pen allowed three runs on Friday, which was more than their previous 12 games, owning a 0.41 ERA (2 ER/43.2IP) over that span. In their last four series, spanning 25 games, Frisco's bullpen has a 1.69 ERA (17ER/90.2IP). In June, **Steven Jenning** has been fantastic, not allowing a run over his seven outings, throwing 14.1 innings.

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 16 games, the Riders have allowed just 31 earned runs over 139.0 IP (2.01 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.55 through the first 20 games. Having won 20 of their last 27 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.17) during that stretch while also being tied for second in saves (11) and second in wins (19) since May 25th. The team with the second-best ERA in that stretch (Kananapolis) has a 2.90 ERA. In those last 27 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just seven times and four times in the last 15 games. Their Tuesday and Thursday 2-1 losses marked their first two losses when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-2 in those games.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 32 games, batting .343 (37-for-108)/.455/.481/.936 with six doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 19 walks, 12 strikeouts and 21 runs. In his last 16 games, he is hitting .368 (21-for-57)/.486/.596/1.082. Two Fridays ago in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

RISP-ECT THIS

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 34 games, they are 21-13, but are hitting .240 (64-for-267) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .269 with RISP.

-Atten ı, go innings in a shortened 2020 season. He was committed to Stephen F. Austin State University.

-Missed a majority of his freshman (elbow surgery for a broken growth plate) and sophomore (torn meniscus) seasons before returning healthy for his junior campaign...as a freshman, was limited to designated hitter duties on the junior varsity team while unable to pitch due to injury

-Signed his professional contract while on vacation with friends and family in Gulf Shores, Ala., and went kayaking, fishing and jet skiing to celebrate.

2024 SEASON

-Stephan began 2024 in Extended Spring Training with a lower back injury before joining the RoughRiders starting rotation.

2023 SEASON

-In Double-A debut on July 4th, pitched in front of 12,045 fans at Riders Field. He left after 4.1 innings with lower back spasms.

-He missed the rest of the season with the back injuries.

-In second start of the season with Hickory, he threw seven shutout innings at home against Bowling Green, striking out 10 batters to just three walks.

-Stephan struck out a career-high 11 batters on June 14th against Bowling Green.

-Threw four quality starts out of 11 total starts with Hickory.

2022 SEASON

-Broke spring camp at Low-A and went 4-4 with a 3.34 ERA (34 ER/91.2 IP) and 102 SO across 18 G/16 GS, earning a mid-August promotion to Hickory where he posted a 2-1 record, 1.54 ERA (2 ER/11.2 IP) and 13 SO over 3 GS.

-115 strikeouts were T6th-most among TEX farmhands and .216 opp. BA was 4th-lowest in the organization (min.80.0 IP).

-Induced ground balls at an over 50% rate in 2022 with both Down East and Hickory.

2021 SEASON

-Pitched in the Fall Instructional League and participated in the Texas Tour against local universities in October, making a start against Dallas Baptist University.
