He threw seven no-hit innings and allowed just one walk, before retiring the next 20 batters in a row with four strikeouts. It was Binghamton's fourth individual no-hitter in franchise history and third that was in a seven-inning game. It was Binghamton's first no-hitter since June 22, 2021 at Reading (Josh Walker (6) and Andrew Mitchell (3)). It was Binghamton's first individual no-hitter since July 23, 2006 at Portland (Miguel Pinango).

Suarez is Unhittable: Joander Suarez has began his Double-A career with 13-straight no-hit frames with just two walks and 10 strikeouts across his first two Double-A starts. He has thrown 17-consecutive no-hit innings, dating back to his final start for High-A Brooklyn and over his last three starts.

Last Time Out: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies and Hartford Yard Goats split the doubleheader Thursday, with Joander Suarez throwing a no-hitter in the first game and Drew Gilbert hitting two homers in the second game.

September Baseball: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies have built a 6.5-game lead on Portland and Reading for the second playoff spot in the Northeast Division behind Somerset. Binghamton is 1.0 game back of Somerset for first place in the second half in the Northeast Division. Binghamton has won 15 of its last 19 games.

Just Drew It: Outfielder **Drew Gilbert** slugged two home runs in the second game of the doubleheader on Thursday night at Dunkin' Park. It marked Gilbert's third multi-hit game of the season, first in Double-A, and first as a member of the Mets' organization. Gilbert hit six home runs in 60 games with Double-A Corpus Christi and has smashed six homers in 29 games with Double-A Binghamton.

Parada Power: Catcher **Kevin Parada** smashed a three-run homer, as part of Binghamton's six-run third inning on Wednesday night and slugged a solo homer in the first inning in the second game of the twin bill on Thursday. Parada has three homers in his last five games, including two three-run shots. Over his first nine games in Double-A, the 22-year-old has three homers and nine runs batted in. Parada has driven in four runs over his last two games. He has totaled 14 homers across three different levels in 2023.


Lightning Acuña: Shortstop **Luisangel Acuña** slugged two solo homers (to lead off the first and fourth innings) on Wednesday night, recording the first multi-homer game of his Minor League career and his first two homers in the Mets' organization. He hit an RBI single in the first game of the doubleheader on Thursday night. Acuña is hitting .350 with a 1.064 OPS, two homers, and six runs batted in over the course of his last five games. Acuña is tied for seventh in all of Minor League Baseball with 55 stolen bases this season.

Last Start: Hamel struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters over six scoreless innings at home against Harrisburg last Friday. He allowed just three hits and two walks in the win. It was his third time punching out 11 hitters and against the third different team (7/5 @ POR, 7/26 @ REA, 9/1 v. HBG). Hamel is tied with Somerset's Richard Fitts for the most strikeouts in the Eastern League with 147 this season. He sits fifth in the league with 116.0 innings pitched on the year.

World Baseball Classic: Hamel represented Team Puerto Rico in the 2023 World Baseball Classic. He honored his late mother, who passed away 11 days before the Mets selected him in the 2021 MLB Draft. He was WBC teammates with current New York Mets, Francisco Lindor and Edwin Díaz.

2022: Was named the 2022 New York Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year. He led all Mets minor leaguers with 10 wins and 145 strikeouts. Began the season with St. Lucie (A) and pitched to a 5-2 record with a 3.84 ERA in 14 appearances and 13 starts. He tossed 63.1 innings and struck out 71 batters, before he was assigned to Brooklyn (A+) on July 4. He went 5-1 on the mound with a 2.59 ERA in 11 starts for the Cyclones. He struck out 74 hitters over 55.2 innings and opponents hit just .180 against him.

BACKGROUND: Ranks as the Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 10 overall Mets' prospect by MLB Pipeline. He was drafted out of Dallas Baptist University in the 3rd round (81st overall) by the Mets in 2021. Hamel went 13-2 on the mound and racked up 136 strikeouts in his final year at DBU in 2021. He spent his first two years at Yavapai College in Arizona.

Last Start: Tidwell allowed five runs over 3.1 innings on Tuesday night in the series opener against Hartford at Dunkin' Park. He allowed five hits, issued four walks, and struck out five batters in the loss.

2022: Tidwell was drafted by the New York Mets in the second round (52nd overall) of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Tennessee. He threw one inning for the FCL Mets before being promoted to Low-A St. Lucie. He made four starts for Low-A St. Lucie, and allowed two runs on four hits over 8.1 innings with nine strikeouts and six walks.

BACKGROUND: Tidwell ranks as the New York Mets' No. 2 pitching prospect and No. 10 overall prospect. The 22-year-old is in his first full season of professional baseball. In his 17 starts with High-A Brooklyn in 2023, Tidwell held hitters to the lowest opponent batting average in the South Atlantic League (.190), earned the second most wins (8), and carried the third lowest ERA (3.09). The second-round pick out of Tennessee had a decorated collegiate career. As a freshman in 2021, he posted a 3.74 ERA with 90 strikeouts in 98.2 innings. During his final year with the Volunteers in 2022, Tidwell was named to the NCAA Knoxville Regional All-Tournament Team. He was also named to the 2021 SEC All-Freshman Team and earned Freshman All-American Honors from Perfect Game and D1Baseball. Helped lead Loretto High School to 2017 Class A State Title. He hit .557 with 30 XBHs and 6 HR while posting an 8-0 record with 107 Ks in 53 innings as a junior in 2019.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career.
