BACK TO THE HILLS: After winning their fifth out of the last six series last week, the FredNats dropped the first game of this series in walk-off fashion last night. Tonight, the former Liberty Flame Mikey Tepper returns to the city where he pitched in college to start for the Freddies in his first appearance since being activated from the injured list. Tepper's last FredNat appearance came on May 4. Prior to his injury, he was one of the most reliable long relief arms in the FredNat bullpen. He faces Hillcat lefty Jackson Humphries, who did not record an out in the first inning the last time he faced FXBG at home. The FredNats ended up scoring 10 runs in the first inning that night.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats got off to a good start on offense, scoring four runs in the first three innings. But, the team was held off the scoreboard for the remainder of the game in a 5-4 walk-off loss to the Hillcats. Bryan Polanco pitched six innings of three-run ball. Yohandy Morales and Elijah Green both homered for FXBG, and Caleb Farmer had an RBI double.

CLUBHOUSE SWITCHEROO: When the Nationals traded Lane Thomas to the Cleveland Guardians on Monday, the trade had repercussions in this series. Cleveland sent back Top-30 prospects Alex Clemmey and Rafael Ramirez Jr., both of whom were on Lynchburg's team prior to the trade. Both have switched clubhouses, and Ramirez Jr. will start at shortstop tonight for the Freddies, while Clemmey will make his Washington organizational debut on Saturday in a start against his old team.

YO!: 2023 FredNat and top Washington infield prospect Yohandy Morales began his trek back to the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in a huge way last night with a no-doubter home run in the first inning, plus a single later in the game. Morales broke his thumb in Harrisburg in late May and had not played since then. Last year's second round pick out of Miami, Morales played in 18 games for the FredNats after last year's draft, slashing .390/.448/.571 for an OPS of 1.019. Morales is currently ranked as Washington's 4th-best prospect.

HOT COOP: Everett Cooper III has been the hottest bat in this FredNat order in the month of July so far. This month, Cooper is slashing .304/.391/.411 for an OPS of .803. His wOBA is .386 (.320 is average), and his wRC+ is 139 (100 is average).

DOMINANT STARTS: After heavily relying on the bullpen for the first two months of the season, the FredNat starting rotation has majorly improved over the last six weeks. Since June 11, FredNat starters have logged 173.1 innings and allowed just 36 earned runs for a group ERA of 1.87. In the three weeks prior to that, the starting rotation's ERA was 5.70. In the second half, Fredericksburg leads the Carolina League with a 2.66 team ERA.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 42-8 this season when scoring first, including 35 out of the last 37 wins. FXBG was beaten last night when scoring first for just the second time in the last month.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 196-162 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Mikey Tepper returns to the FredNats after a lengthy IL stint (5/7-7/28), and will make his first start of the year tonight, against the Lynchburg Hillcats.

Mikey was off to a strong start with the Nationals this year out of the bullpen. He had worked to a 2.04 ERA over 17.2 innings, with opponents hitting just .133 against the righty before getting hurt.

ROAD TO FXBG: Tepper began his collegiate career with two years at Mississippi State, where he was teammates with current FredNat Brandon Pimentel on the 2021 title-winning team. Tepper spent one more year with the Bulldogs, then transfered to Liberty University for the 2023 season. He worked as a starter that year, going 4-3 with a 5.32 ERA, with 78 K's in 65.1 innings of work.

REHAB WORK: Mikey started a rehab stint in July in the FCL, and made five outings covering 8.1 innings. The righty struck out 10 men and walked five, while sporting a 4.32 ERA in 8.1 innings.

AGAINST LYNCHBURG: Tepper did face the Hillcats once prior to getting hurt, tossing two innings of one-run ball back on 4/13.
