Leading Off

Reading returns to Altoona for the first time since the last week of the 2022 season for game two of this week's six-game series. Altoona won the series 3-2 in Reading from Apr. 25-30.

Ouiet Night

Reading fell in the opening game of this week's series 4-0 to Altoona. Seven Curve pitchers comgined to shutout the Fightin Phils, just the second time Reading was shutout this season. Josh Hendrickson started and went five innings, while Noah Song and Adam Leverett pitched in relief. Matthew Kroon had two hits, but no other R-Phils had more than one. Reading also struck out 12 times and was 0-7 with runners in scoring position.

Pitching Powers

A key reason why Reading has won six-of-nine games has come thanks to its pitching. From July 4-16, Reading had a 2.70 ERA, which is second in the league. Last weekend, Reading issued two-walks per nine innings, which is second in the league (behind Altoona) over the last series.

Hello From The Other Side

This weekend marks a cross-division matchup with Altoona. Reading has a .467 winning percentage against the Northeast Division, and just a .286 against the Southeast Division, in which Altoona resides. Reading is 1-8 vs Richmond and 5-7 against Altoona and Harrisburg combined in 2023.

Taking Down Top Dogs

Reading has excelled against better competition this season. Against Somerset (first-half champion) and Portland (runner up), Reading owns a 15-11 record, including three series wins against those teams over the last month. Against the remaining teams in the Northeast Divison, Reading is 14-22 when facing Hartford, Binghamton and New Hampshire (115-133 combined record). Portland and Somerset are 101-67 in total.

Johan To The Show

Johan Rojas made his big-league debut last Saturday. He had three hits and a remarkable defensive play in center. Rojas became the first player to make it to the bigs who began his career at the Phillies Dominican Academy, which opened in 2017 (HT: Steve Potter/Larry Shenk). With Rojas departed, the R-Phils now have a void to fill in center field. Last weekend, Carlos De La Cruz started two games in center and Madison Stokes the other. Kroon played center yesterday. Manager Al Pedrique said he plans to approach the center field position on a committee basis moving forward.

Around the Organization

The Phillies opened up a series with the Brewers with a 4-3 win behaind a strong outing from Aaron Nola. Lehigh Valley beat Toledo thanks to a late-rally in the ninth and strong start from TJ Zeuch. Weston Wilson also hit his 21st homer. Jersey Shore fell to Winston-Salem 7-6 as Rixon Wingrove hit a three-run homer in the loss. Clearwater lost to Tampa 17-11 as Justin Crawford stole his 36th base of the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 19, 2015: At Reading, Cameron Perkins' double scores KC Serna with the game-winning run in the bottom of the 10th as Reading beats New Britain, 6-5. The Rock Cats had rallied to tie the game in the 9th on Will Swanner's pinch-hit 2-run homer.

Curve Work

Altoona enters tonight with a 6-7 record in the second half, and 40-41 record overall in 2023. The Curve were in New Hampshire last weekend and lost Friday. Saturday was suspended and Sunday's game cancelled due to inclement weather. After this week, Altoona is on the road for a six-game series at Harrisburg. Top Prospects Henry Davis and Liover Pegeuro both are no longer with Altoona and now on the Pittsburgh Pirates roster.

4/29: 3-1 W (7) at REA

Aaron Shortridge gets the start today for Altoona. He is making his 19th start and 17th appearence and is 5-5 with a 4.96 ERA. Over 78 inning, Shortridge has allowed 83 hits, issued 34 walks and has 69 strikeouts. At Reading on Apr. 29, Shortridge went five innings and allowed two-earned runs and a win. He last threw an inning on July 14 at New Hampshire, but hasn't started since July 7 at Erie, when he eanred the win over seven-strong innings of work. Shortridge split 2022 between Altoona and single-A Bradenton. He did not pitch in 2020 and 2021 and spent 2019 with Bradenton and 2018 with West Virginia. He injured his elbow in 2020 while training and subsequently missed all of 2021 and saw limited action last season. He was drafted by the Pirates in the fourth round of the 2018 draft out of Vintage High School in Napa, California.
