Rochester Red Wings RHP Spenser Watkins (1-2, 5.03) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Brian Van Belle (1-2, 7.34)

Welcome to June and Summer (Almost) – The Worcester Red Sox face the Rochester Red Wings (AAA-Washington) for the first time this season when they open a 6-game series at Polar Park tonight at 6:45 pm (live on NESN+ as well as on radio on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). Rochester is the final of the "old-school" five International League rivals to play against the WooSox in 2024 as the Sox have already faced Lehigh Valley, Buffalo, Syracuse, and Scranton/WB this season. The WooSox host the Red Wings tonight & tomorrow both at 6:45 pm, Thursday afternoon at 12:15 pm, Friday at 6:45 pm, Saturday at 4:05 pm, and Sunday at 1:05 pm. Nice to know that June is the month with the longest daylight hours of the year.

Wingstop – This series this week/weekend is one of two that Rochester will play here at Polar Park in just over one month's time as the Red Wings will be back in Worcester for another 6-game series next month from July 9-14 leading into the All-Star break. The WooSox finally make their only trip to Rochester all season from September 2-8 for a 6-game set vs. the Wings.

Time Zone – Please note the 6:45 pm weeknight start times this homestand and for the rest of June, July, and August as Worcester begins their usual summer night game times this week after playing at 6:05 pm in April & May. Worcester will revert back to 6:05 pm weeknight starts for their lone homestand in September from September 10-15.

A Few More Toddlers Join WooSox – Affectionately known as The Toddlers – i.e. Portland's stable of premier young prospects – much of the attention this off-season and now season has been heaped upon the Big Three of SS Marcelo Mayer, OF Roman Anthony, and C Kyle Teel. All three are performing extremely well for the Sea Dogs as Mayer is hitting .295/6/27 with 19 doubles to lead the Eastern League, Teel is batting .307/6/34, and Anthony has come on as of late and is at .243/3/13. However, several other Portland players are also worthy of a promotion to Worcester. The first such came on May 7 when reliever Ryan Zeferjahn (0 ER in 13.2 IP for Portland) was promoted to Worcester and on May 26 LHP Zach Penrod (4-0, 2.80 with 53 SO in 35.1 IP for the Sea Dogs) earned the call to Worcester. Now today, outfielder (and also infielder) Matthew Lugo, who is leading the Eastern League with a .315 batting average along with 11 HR (3rd in the league) and 35 RBI (T2nd), has been promoted to Worcester. And also joining the WooSox from Portland today is catcher/1B Mickey Gasper, a New Hampshire native and Bryant University product who was hitting .282/4/22 for the Sea Dogs this season.

Red Sox vs. Red Wings - Worcester leads the recent all-time series over Rochester by a slim 34-33 margin. The Red Wings are 21-14 all-time at Polar Park while the WooSox are 20-12 in Rochester winning 19 of their last 26 games at the Rock. Furthermore, Worcester/Pawtucket is two gams up on Rochester with 358-356 wins in the remarkably close last 44 years of facing each other since the 1979 season. These two clubs (or reasonable facsimiles of each) went 12-12 during their season-series against each other last year as the teams finished 6-6 here at Polar Park and 6-6 in Rochester as well.

Consistency – Worcester is 8-8 in their last 16 games and 16-16 in their last 32 games since April 28. And despite five home losses in a row to conclude their last homestand from May 22-26 vs. Norfolk (their most since a 6-game home losing streak last August 20 & then August 29 – September 2), the Sox have still won 14 of their last 23 home games at Polar Park dating back to April 16.

Last Series and Roadtrip Finale – The WooSox had to settle for a split of their 6-game series in Charlotte last week/weekend. The Sox lost the opener, 9-4; then won the next three games by scores of 5-2, 4-1, and 13-4; but the Knights won both games over the weekend, 7-5 and 3-1 to gain the split. Worcester is 4-5-1 in their first ten series of the season (4 winners, 5 losers, and 1 split).

Rankings – Worcester is 16^{h} in the IL in team batting with a .246 average while Rochester is 4^{th} at .262. On the pitching side, the Sox are 12^{th} in team ERA (5.02) while the Red Wings are 18^{th} with a 5.48 ERA.

Five Below – On May 21 after a 20-4 rout of Norfolk, the WooSox pulled even at 23-23 on the season. On May 28 the Sox had fallen to a season-low of 6-games under .500 at 23-29 (they are now 26-31). Worcester's low point last year was also 6-game under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. The Sox have not been over .500 this season since they were 2-1 on March 31.

Three for All – The WooSox won three straight from May 29-31 for the first time since May 3-5 (at home vs. Lehigh Valley). That 3-game winning streak came on the heels of a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19.

Series Math – Worcester is 4-5-1 in their first 10 series of 2024 (4 wins, 5 losses, and 1 split). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Two for Ones — Worcester was the only team without a 1-run victory this season — until May 16 (and then May 17 as well). The WooSox were 0-7 in 1-run games this year until their dramatic, 13-12 win on May 16 followed by May 17th's 9-8 triumph. They are now 2-9 in 1-run affairs. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 4-7 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (14-16) than at night (12-15).

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – Sox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 44 times this season.

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 14 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 8 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. The WooSox finished 10-14 in April after going 2-1 in March. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA (129 ER in 238 IP) with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month (232-for-908) with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half sending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The 1st-place Portland Sea Dogs (28-23) open a 6-game series at home vs. Akron tonight. The Sea Dogs have a ½-game lead on Hartford and a 1-game lead on Binghamton in the Eastern League Northeast Division. Akron is tied for 1st in the Southwest Division.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Boston Red Sox today transferred OF Matthew Lugo and C/1B Mickey Gasper from Double-A Portland to Worcester. The Red Sox today also transferred catcher Elih Marrero from Worcester to Portland. Additionally, the WooSox placed RHP Richard Fitts on the temporarily inactive list and reinstated LHP Jorge Benitez and RHP Sal Romano from the Development List. And the Red Sox this afternoon sent OF Tyler O'Neill to Worcester for a brief injury rehab assignment and also recalled catcher Tyler Heineman from the WooSox after placing OF Wilyer Abreu on the 10-day injured list.

O'Neill, who will turn 29 on June 22, has been on Boston's injured list since May 26 with right knee inflammation. In 41 games for the Red Sox this season he is batting .236 with 11 HR & 17 RBI. His 11 homers are tied with Rafael Devers for most on the club. O'Neill also missed 6 games from April 16-23 while on the IL with a concussion. Acquired from St. Louis in exchange for Nick Robertson and Victor Santos last December, Tyler set a new Major League record when he homered on Opening Day for the fifth straight year this past March 28 in Seattle during his Red Sox debut. He homered on Opening Day with St. Louis each year from 2020-2023 and did so again with Boston in 2024 to stand alone as the only MLB player to ever homer on five consecutive Opening Days. O'Neill, who was born and still lives in British Columbia, Canada, was 8th in National League MVP voting in 2021 when he hit .286 with 34 HR & 80 RBI for the Cardinals. In 2020 and 2021 he won a Rawlings Gold Glove Award playing mainly left field.

Lugo, who turned 23 on May 9, is leading the Eastern League with a .315 batting average along with 11 HR (3rd in the league) and 35 RBI (T2nd). He also is 1st in the league in Triples (4), Total Bases (97), Slugging Pct. (.664) & OPS (.1.069) and 5th in On-Base Pct. (.405). In addition, he is tied with teammate Marcelo Mayer for the league lead with 25 Extra-Base Hits. For good measure, Lugo was 9-for-10 in stolen base attempts.

Matthew played 38 games in LF for the Sea Dogs this season along with 1 game in CF and 3 as the DH. He originally broke in as an infielder and last season split time at 3B (33 games) and LF (29 games) for Portland In 2022 with Greenville (A+) he played predominately at shortstop.

A Puerto Rican native, Lugo, who is the nephew of former MLB All-Star Carlos Beltran. He was selected by Boston in the second round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft. Lugo spent all of 2023 with Double-A Portland batting .242 with 5 HR & 37 RBI in 83 games. In 2022, he hit .282 with 26 doubles, 10 triples, 18 home runs, 79 RBI, and 20 stolen bases with High-A Greenville (114 games) and Portland (3 games), leading the South Atlantic League in hits (134), extra-base hits (tied, 53), and triples (tied, 10).

Also joining the WooSox from Portland today is catcher/1B **Mickey Gasper**, a New Hampshire native and Bryant University product who was hitting .282/4/22 for the Sea Dogs this season. Gasper, 28, has played 21 games at 1B, 16 as catcher, and 7 as the DH for Portland this season. His 13 doubles are tied for 3rd most in the league, he is 6th in OBP (.403), 8th in OPS (.861), and T8th in BB (26). Gasper has 26 walks compared to only 22 strikeouts.

Mickey played for Bryant University (RI) from 2015-18 and was named the Northeast Conference Player of the Year as a junior in 2017. He was chosen by the New York Yankees in the 27th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft and played in 315 career games in the Yankees system from 2018-2023 compiling a .258 batting average. Last season, after hitting .269 with 6 HR & 24 RBI in 52 games for Somerset (AA), he earned his first promotion to Triple-A and finished the year playing 22 games for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. The switch-hitting catcher graduated from Merrimack High School (NH) where he lettered in baseball and basketball.

Heineman, 32, has played in one Major League game this season, starting as the Red Sox' designated hitter on April 21 at Pittsburgh. In 22 games with Worcester, the switch-hitter has batted .235 (16-for-68) with 13 runs scored, two home runs, and eight RBI. Originally selected by the Houston Astros in the eighth round of the 2012 First-Year Player Draft, the California native has batted .217 (54-for-249) in 105 career Major League games with the Miami Marlins (2019), San Francisco Giants (2020), Toronto Blue Jays (2022-23), Pittsburgh Pirates (2022-23), and Red Sox (2024).

Worcester has already used 50 players this season (21 position players and 29 pitchers). O'Neill, Lugo, and Gasper will up that total to 53. O'Neill (DH) and Lugo (LF) are in the WooSox starting lineup tonight. The list does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox on May 3 but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on May 12 with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 12 players to Boston in the 10 weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, and INF/OF Jamie Westbrook. Those 11 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, and RHP Nick Pivetta who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa and Kelly are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
