WHITE HOT: OF Dairon Blanco continued his hot streak last night, going 2-for-4 in the win. Over his last five games, Blanco is hitting .714 (15-for-21) with nine RBIs, five doubles, and a home run. Blanco had one RBI last night, tying his career-high for a single season at 53 and extending his RBI streak to six games, the longest active RBI streak in the International League.

ROOKER HITTING ROCKETS: OF Brent Rooker launched his fifth home run for Triple-A Omaha last night in just his 10th game in a Storm Chasers uniform. With the Chasers, Rooker is hitting .357 with a .883 slugging percentage and 17 RBIs. He has earned a hit in each of his first 10 games with Omaha, the fourth player to reach the 10-game hit-streak benchmark on the team this season. His streak is tied for the longest active hitting streak in the International League.

SAVE MACHINE: Needing just 10 pitches to strikeout the ninth inning last night, **RHP Andrés Núñez** has now earned a save in each of his last seven appearances. With his seventh consecutive save last night, Núñez joins Greg Weissert of Scranton/Wilkes-Barre as the only two players with a save streak of at least six games in the International League this season. Weissert had an eight-game save streak that lasted nearly a month, ending on August 20. Núñez leads the team in appearances this season, now with 52, setting a new modern franchise record (2005-pres). He is the first player since **Allen McDill** in 1998 to appear in more than 51 games in a single season for Triple-A Omaha.

ROAD FIRSTS: Omaha's 8-7 win last night checked off a couple of firsts for the 2022 campaign. Now leading the six-game series with Columbus 4-0, Omaha has secured a road-series win for the first time this season. Prior to this week, Omaha had been 0-4-7 in series away from home. Last night's victory was also the first time that the Storm Chasers won a game by exactly one run on the road. Omaha entered the game 0-12 in one-run games away from home this season. Although not a first, the Chasers are riding season-best four-game winning streak for the fourth time this season.

CENTURY MARK: INF/OF Nick Loftin has scored 99 runs between two levels this season, needing just one more to become the 12th player in Minor League Baseball to eclipse the 100 run mark this season. **INF Maikel Garcia** is also nearing the milestone, currently with 97 runs scored. Both players have split time between Double-A Northwest Arkansas and Triple-A Omaha this season.

30-30 IN SIGHT: OF Brewer Hicklen is closing in on another milestone that is quite rare in minor league baseball. Hicklen needs just two more home runs to become the seventh player in affiliated Minor League Baseball since 2005 to hit 30 home runs and steal 30 bases in a single season. Hicklen would join Kyle Tucker (2019) and Joc Pederson (2014) as the only players to accomplish the feat solely at the Triple-A level. Hicklen's 28 home runs lead the team this season, needing two more to become the third player in the Storm Chasers era (2011-pres.) to hit 30 homers in a single season, joining **Ryan McBroom** (32, 2021) and **Carlos Peguero** (30, 2014) in the Storm Chasers' 30-HR club.

FOR OMAHA: LHP Angel Zerpa takes the mound to make his fourth start for the Storm Chasers this season. Zerpa is on an MLB rehab assignment after getting placed on the injured list on July 27. In his last start, Zerpa went 1.0 inning, with a walk as his only blemish. Each of his appearances on this rehab stint have been scoreless. The 22-year-old lefty has spent much of the season with Double-A Northwest Arkansas, making 13 starts for the Naturals with 69 strikeouts and just 21 walks in his 64.0 innings of work. He has also appeared in three games for the Royals this season.

FOR INDIANAPOLIS: RHP Xzavion Curry gets the ball to make his 10th start for the Clippers this season. His last start came a week ago when he went 4.2 innings and allowed six earned runs on eight hits and two walks with five strikeouts in a no decision at Louisville. Curry has started two games in The Show this season, including his MLB debut on August 15. He holds a 5.79 ERA and 0-1 record in 9.1 innings with the Guardians. The 24-year-old started the season with Double-A Akron, making 11 starts with two relief appearances for the RubberDucks before getting promoted to Triple-A Columbus on June 29.
