Mauricio went 2-for-3 and hit a double that was 117 mph off the bat in his first Major League plate appearance. He batted ninth and played second base. The 22-year-old became the third former Rumble Pony to reach the big leagues with the Mets this season, joining LHP Josh Walker and RHP Grant Hartwig. Mauricio became the 346th former Binghamton Met/Rumble Pony to play in the Majors and 177th to make his debut with the Mets.

**Last Time Out:** RHP **Dom Hamel** was dominant for the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, as they held on to defeat the Harrisburg Senators, 6-5, on Friday night at Mirabito Stadium. JT Schwartz had a three-hit game and drove in two-runs. The Ponies scored five runs in the seventh inning to go up 6-0. Eight of the Ponies' nine batters in the starting lineup recorded at least one hit.

**Dominant Hamel:** Right-hander **Dom Hamel** was dominant on Friday night against Harrisburg. Hamel (8-6) struck out a career-high-tying 11 batters over six scoreless innings, while issuing just three hits and two walks. He has recorded 11 strikeouts on three separate occasions this season: July 5 at Portland, July 26 at Reading, and September 1 against Harrisburg. The 24-year-old now leads the Eastern League with 147 strikeouts, surpassing his total of 145 strikeouts in 2022. Hamel also ranks third in the EL in innings pitched (116.0), tied for fifth in wins (8), fifth in opponent batting average (.238) and fifth in WHIP (1.31).

**Recipe for Success:** Over the past three games, Rumble Ponies' pitchers have combined to strike out 39 batters and issue just six walks against Harrisburg. Offensively, the Ponies have drawn 15 walks over the past three games. The Ponies' starters over the last three games have been elite. On Wednesday, **Luis Moreno** struck out nine batters and walked one over 5.2 innings, **Joander Suarez** struck out six and walked one over six no-hit innings on Thursday, and **Dom Hamel** struck out 11 and walked two over six scoreless innings on Friday.

**Action Jackson:** Infielder **Jeremiah Jackson** hit an RBI double on Friday to extend his on-base streak to 15 games. Jackson has reached base safely in 24 of his first 25 games with the Rumble Ponies and he's recorded a hit in 14 of his last 15 games and in 18 of his last 21 games.

**September Baseball:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies have won five-straight games and have built a five-game lead on the Portland Sea Dogs and Reading Fightin Phils for the second playoff spot in the Northeast Division behind Somerset coming into Saturday's contests. Binghamton has won 11 of its last 13 games and eight of its last nine games. The Ponies went 17-9 (.654) in August, which marked their best month of the season.

Last Start: Geber allowed two runs over 5.1 innings at High-A Asheville for the Brooklyn Cyclones last Saturday. He struck out six batters and did not issue a walk, while allowing four hits. Geber earned the win, which was his third at High-A this season.

2022: Signed a minor league contract with the Mets on August 3, during the season. Made six appearances and four starts for Class-A St. Lucie and went 1-0 with a 5.00 ERA over 27 innings with 25 strikeouts. Skipped High-A and was promoted to Double-A Binghamton. Made one relief appearance for the Rumble Ponies and allowed three runs over two innings on three solo homers.

BACKGROUND: Originally signed a minor league contract with the Mets on August 3, 2022, after pitching for the Frederick Keys of the MLB Draft League. The Maryland native began his collegiate career at Mount St. Mary's, where he was a 2021 All-NEC First Team selection. Played at The Mount from 2018-2021 and transferred to Virginia Tech for the 2022 season. Tossed 35 innings for the Hokies in 2022 in 16 appearances and seven starts. Held a 40-to-9 strikeout-to-walk ratio at Virginia Tech. The Hokies were the nation's No. 4 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament, but fell in the Blacksburg Super Regional to Oklahoma. Came out of Archbishop Spalding, just outside of Baltimore.

### **Ponies Field Staff**

#### Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization. Mariano Duncan - Bench Coach - 2nd season with Binghamton - 5th year with Mets organization. Duncan returns to the Southern Tier to begin his second year as Bench Coach with the Rumble Ponies. He previously served as the bench coach for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) in 2021. He is entering his fifth year in the Mets organization.
