FROM THE DOG HOUSE

HAUGH YOU DOIN': Right hander **Aidan Haugh** will take the ball for Charleston in game three of their series at Augusta. Across five starts this season, Haugh has registered a 8.72 ERA with 23 strikeouts over 21.2 innings of work. Last Saturday versus Fayetteville, he tossed five innings of four-run ball to earn his first professional win. He mixes in a four seamer, curveball, cutter and changeup, the latter of which induced a 44 percent whiff rate at North Carolina last season before he was selected in the sixth round by Tampa Bay.

A BODACIOUS START: Rays No. 12 prospect **Caden Bodine** was named **Carolina League Player of the Month** Tuesday after a torrid start to 2026. Over 24 games, he is second in all of professional baseball in hitting (.402 - Jonah Cox, .429, 99 PA, Double-A Richmond) and leads the RiverDogs with 4 homers. Moreover, across 25 games, he has collected 14 multi-hit performances, as well as at least one knock in 21 of them. His 3.4 percent strikeout rate (4 K/117 PA), is the lowest of any hitter in Minor League Baseball with at least 100 plate appearances. In 60 games for the Chanticleers in 2025, the switch hitter slashed .318/.454/.461 with five home runs, anchoring one of the nation's most dominant teams. He was acquired in the Shane Baz trade from Baltimore last December.

FIRST PLACE: After taking five of six from Fayetteville last week, the RiverDogs have leap frogged Hickory for first place in the Carolina League South Standings. Charleston has won nine of its last eleven games dating back to April 22 at Kannapolis. In the process, the club is batting .273 (4th in Single-A), has scored 68 runs (T-8th) and posted a .779 OPS (7th). On the mound, they've posted a 3.95 ERA (8th). Over the last 15 games, **Caden Bodine** (.450, 27-for-60, 3 HR 17 RBI) and **Cooper Flemming** (.364, 20-for-55, 2 HR, 17 RBI) have been red hot. The two rank one and six in the Carolina League in OPS (Bodine - 1.056, Flemming .976) and were just added to Baseball America's **Top 100 Prospects** list, ranking **No. 95** and **No. 97** respectively.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Charleston native **Trey Pooser** was named Carolina League Pitcher of the Week after a dominant performance versus Fayetteville. Pooser is the second RiverDog to be recognized by Minor League Baseball this season, joining infielder **Daniel Pierce** who was named Player of the Week in April. On Sunday versus the Woodpeckers, Pooser entered the game in the top of the second, and made his presence felt immediately, striking out the side in order. Overall, the right hander tossed a season-high five hitless innings while fanning six. The outing marked the fourth time he's completed five innings or more in his career. After a strong start a week prior at Kannapolis on April 26, Pooser has allowed just one earned run on four hits over his last ten innings of work.

WHIFF CENTRAL: The RiverDogs pitching staff earned their second 20 strikeout performance on Tuesday night. Charleston is the first team with 2 20+ strikeout performances (at any level) in the same month since MIN in September of 2024 - and the first team to do so twice in the first month of the season since Chattanooga in 2023. Since 2005, there had only been two other instances in RiverDogs history before this season. There have only been two other 20+ strikeout games this year across every level of pro ball

FLAIR FOR THE DRAMATIC: The RiverDogs earned an exhilarating 4-3 win in ten innings Tuesday night after **Cooper Flemming** delivered a walk-off sacrifice fly to center. Each of the last five home wins for Charleston have come after the club has entered at least the fifth inning trailing. In the process, they've earned three walk off victories. Last night's win marked their first extra-innings victory of the season.

- Tossed career-high six innings versus COL on 4/18... began with five shutout frames but allowed 3 ER in final inning
- Made pro debut on 4/4 vs Myrtle Beach: 3 IP, 4 R, 3 K
- Pitch mix includes 'lively' four-seam fastball that sits 92-94 (touches 96), 'sharp' 12-6 curveball (low 80s), and upper 80s changeup
- Curveball is described as best pitch by *Baseball America* – generated 41 percent whiff rate...changeup has late break... induced 44 percent chase rate
- In two seasons at North Carolina, program went 94-31 and reached College World Series in 2024
- Appeared in 17 games and made 14 starts for North Carolina in 2025
- Posted a 3.72 ERA over 75 innings while fanning 84 hitters....9th best ERA in the ACC
- 32 strikeouts looking were second most in ACC...opponents hit just .240
- Part of the pitching staff that had the third-best team ERA in the country (3.47) and the best in the ACC for the second straight season
- Catcher Luke Stevenson (1st Round – SEA), P Jake Knapp (8th Round – CHC), and seven other arms from that staff were also selected
- **Was also drafted by the Twins in the 16th round of the 2024 draft but decided to return**
- Made 22 appearances and eight starts for Tar Heels in 2024...posted 4.83 ERA over 54 innings
- Started year in bullpen and then transitioned into flex role
- Played first two college seasons at Fayetteville Tech (NC) in 2022 and 2023...combined to make 23 starts and pitch 110.1 innings while posting 12.8 K/9
- Played four years of varsity baseball at East Wake High School

- Was acquired by the Rays in the Jason Adam trade alongside OF Home Bush Jr. and C J.D. Gonzalez
- No. 56 prospect in all of baseball by MLB Pipeline in 2024
- Prior to trade, spent season with High-A Fort Wayne and pitched to 6.46 ERA over 16 starts
- Embarked on his first professional season in 2023 and made 12 starts between three levels: 33 IP, 5.45 ERA, 52 K, 22 BB...Finished season as Padres No. 2 ranked prospect and No. 100 in all of baseball
- Selected by the Padres 15th overall in the 2022 draft
- Underwent Tommy John Surgery in April before the draft
- Was committed to Vanderbilt... was one of the top pitching prospects in his draft class
- Named Gatorade National Player of the Year in 2021 as an underclassman after posting a 0.35 ERA over 60 innings with 112 punchouts
- Fastball was sitting in mid 90s and touched 97
