Today's Game
The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at the Chesapeake Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. It is the third-of-12 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-six at Prince George's Stadium in Bowie. Reading went 3-6 against the Baysox in 2024, going 1-2 in Bowie and 2-4 at FirstEnergy Stadium. Chesapeake returns to Reading from Aug. 26-31. The season-series is tied 1-1.

Game 80/81 Recap
It was a tale of two games in Thursday's doubleheader split between Reading and Chesapeake. The Fightin Phils fell 8-0 in the first game of the doubleheader, which marked the R-Phils sixth shutout loss of the season and largest shutout defeat of 2025. Koyo Aoyagi started game one and struggled, allowing five runs on four hits, with four walks and four strikeouts over three innings of work. Reading flipped the script in the second game, winning 9-1. Griff McGarry started and allowed one run on two hits over four innings, with three walks and six strikeouts. The R-Phils broke the game open with three runs in the third and six in the fifth. Reading batted around for the second time this season (first since Apr. 22 at POR) in the fifth, which also tied their season-high in runs in an inning with six (LAST: Apr. 15 vs BNG). The highlights of the night were a two-run single from Alex Binelas in the third inning, a two-run double from Leandro Pineda in the fifth, an inning that also featured an RBI double from Nick Dunn and a grand slam home run from Cade Fergus. Chesapeake committed four errors in game two, which is the most a Reading opponent has committed in a game this season, and three of them came in the six-run fifth inning. The R-Phils pitchers of McGarry, Andrew Walling and Jaydenn Estinista held Chesapeake bats to two hits, which tied a season-best for the Fightin Phils arms on the mound.

He's Fergalicious
Cade Fergus launched Reading's second grand slam of the season in Thursday night's game two win over Chesapeake. The R-Phils other grand slam in 2025 came from Trent Farquhar on May 10 at Binghamton, which also came in a doubleheader. Fergus' grand slam was the fourth of his pro career (dating back to 2022), with the others coming on Aug. 20, 2022, May 16, 2023 and July 2, 2023; all of which with Clearwater (A). Fergus also matched a career-high with four RBI in the game, as he also doubled, a mark that also tied a career-best for runs driven in for a game. Following his grand slam on Thursday night, Fergus is second in the Phillies organization in home runs with 13, trailing Otto Kemp who had 14 with LehighValley, prior to his big-league call-up in early July.

It's Miller Time
Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller has become a threat on the basepaths this season. Miller is currently tied for first in the Eastern League with 31 stolen bases, a mark that ranks second in the Phillies organization. After his 31st stolen base on Saturday, Miller is the first R-Phil to swipe 31+ bags in a season since Roman Quinn had 31 in 2016. Johan Rojas was the last Fightin Phil to have 30, as he did so in 2023. Miller is just the fifth Reading player to have 30+ stolen bases in a year since the 2010 season. Additionally, Miller has been strong since moving to the leadoff spot on June 3. He has 20 walks and 22 strikeouts over 102 plate appearances batting first (20% walk rate), which compared to 21 walks and 53 strikeouts in the two hole across 189 plate appearances (11% walk rate).

The First for DeMartini
Carson DeMartini launched his first Double-A home run on Sunday at Somerset. He enters play on Thursday riding a Double-A high 15-game on-base streak, dating back to June 20 (.369 OBP). DeMartini's 15-game on-base streak is the fourth-longest on-base streak by a R-Phil this season, and the longest amongst active Fightin Phils. DeMartini also has stolen nine bases since his Double-A debut on June 10, which is tied with Aidan Miller for fourth in the Eastern League over that stretch.

Binelas Brings the Boom
Alex Binelas stayed red-hot with two more hits and a pair of RBI on Thursday at Chesapeake. Since June 11 (23 games), Binelas is slashing .338/.379/.558 (.937 OPS), with 13 runs, five doubles, four home runs and 22 RBI. Since June 11, Binelas holds the following Eastern League ranks: 2nd AVG (.338), T-6th HR (4), T-1st RBI (22), 4th SLG (.558) and 5th OPS (.937). Binelas is also riding a seven-game hitting streak dating back to June 29, where he is hitting .308 (8-26) over the streak, which is his longest hitting streak since joining Reading.

This Day in Baseballtown History
July 11, 2018: At Trenton, Jan Hernandez hits a 2-run homer and Deivi Grullon adds a solo shot as the Eastern Division builds a 3-0 lead in the E.L. All-Star Game, only to have Fightin Phils teammate Edgar Garcia squander the lead by surrendering 3 runs in the 5th inning.

Down by the Bay
Chesapeake enters tonight with a 35-46 overall record and are 4-10 in the second half, which sits in last place in the Southwest Division. The Baysox dropped four-of-six games against Richmond, winning games on Wednesday and Thursday last week. After this week, Chesapeake is at Erie the weekend after the All-Star Break before going to Altoona for six games. Chesapeake's roster features nine of the Orioles' top-30 prospects: Enrique Bradfield Jr. (2), Patrick Reilly (9), Neston German (10), Creed Williams (11), Trey Gibson (14), Braxton Bragg (15), Juan Nunez (20), Trace Bright (25) and Alex Pham (29).

Baysox Arm
Righty Blake Money makes the start tonight for Chesapeake. Money is making his fifth appearance and third start with the Baysox this season since being promoted from Aberdeen (A+) on June 17. With Chesapeake, Money is 1-2, with a 7.02 ERA (13 ER, 16.2 IP); he does have 24 strikeouts (13.22 SO/9.0 IP). With Aberdeen this season, Money went 2-3, with a 3.57 ERA over 11 games and nine starts. Money took the loss July 4 against Richmond, allowing four runs on seven hits over 5.2 innings, with seven strikeouts. He spent all of 2024 with Delmarva (A), going 4-7, with a 3.15 ERA over 25 games and 14 starts. The 23-year old was a 12th round pick by the Orioles in the 2023 draft out of LSU. He pitched for the Tigers from 2021-23, making most appearances out of the bullpen.

King turned in his eighth-straight outing over five innings, as he proves to be a reliable arm in Reading's rotation. Although King did not achieve his fourth-straight quality start, he was still sharp in earning his fourth win of the season. King allowed just one run on five hits over 5.1 innings, and was two outs shy of capturing another quality start. Somerset tagged King for a run in the fourth and that was it. He did allow one base runner in the fifth before being lifted. King was relieved by Andrew Walling in the top of the third inning.

2025 Season:

- After not starting, nor pitching more than 2.0 IP in a game prior to this season, King has started 13-of-15 games this season and has gone over two innings in each outing
- First win of season came on Apr. 13 at Somerset when he pitched in relief (3.0 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 5 SO)
- Tossed a season and career-high six innings twice in back-to-back starts: May 22 at Portland and May 29 vs Erie
- On May 22 at Portland: 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 1 ER, 3 SO
- Allowed a season and career-high 11 hits May 29 vs Erie over six innings
- Has allowed a career-high three home runs three times this season: May 2 vs HBG, May 17 vs NH and May 29 vs ERI
- Went five-shutout innings Apr. 24 at Portland
- Struck out a season/career-high five batters four times this season, including back-to-back starts on June 3 & 8 at Harrisburg
- Earned second win of season, while matching season-high with six innings and five strikeouts on June 14 vs New Hampshire
- Spun second-straight quality start, winning second-consecutive game June 21 vs Hartford (6 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, BB, 3 SO)
- Tossed three-straight quality starts from June 14-27
- Earned fourth win of season July 3 vs Somerset, allowed one run over 5.1 innings pitched
- Has gone 5+ innings in his last eight starts and nine of his last 10 starts on the mound
- Over seven away games, has a 3.23 ERA (14 ER, 39.0 IP), which is compared to a 6.23 ERA (24 ER, 34.2 IP) over seven home contests; also 12-of-14 home runs have been allowed at home
- Posted a 3.60 ERA (6 ER, 15.0 IP) in four April outings and a 7.11 ERA (20 ER, 25.1 IP) across five May appearances (all starts); had a 3.54 ERA (11 ER, 28.0 IP) over four June starts
- With RISP, opposing hitters slashing .173/.177/.240 (.417 OPS)
- Has allowed the most home runs (14) of any pitcher in the Eastern League, has not allowed a HR in four of last six outings, and just two total over last six appearances (33.1 IP)
- Ranks 10th in the Eastern League in innings pitched (73.2); since May 22 (eight starts), he is third in the league in IP (45.1)

2024 Season:

- Spent majority of season with Jersey Shore (A+), making 31 appearances out of the bullpen
- On 7-day IL (oblique strain) from June 10 through July 23, which included rehab appearances with Clearwater (A) and FCL-Phillies (ROK)
- Promoted to Reading (AA) on Sept. 11, making one relief appearance prior to end of season
- After compiling a 4.58 ERA (19.2 IP, 10 ER) over first 18 appearances, finished season with 3.48 ERA (20.2 IP, 8 ER) over final 15 outings
- Held LHH to .175/.224/.213 (.437 OPS) slash line, while RHH hit .293 (22-75) against
