### "FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

**SAINTS HOT STARTS FIZZLES OUT IN SERIES OPENER IN NEBRASKA:** Home runs from Matt Wallner and Jeferson Morales helped the Saints stake a 4-0 lead, but St. Paul couldn't hang on as they fell 7-5 in Tuesday night's series opener from Werner Park. The talk of the town coming into the series was baseball's No. 10 prospect Jac Caglianone, who had hit safely in 19 straight games, including homering in four in-a-row, but the Saints kept him in check with an 0-for-5 night. Wallner erupted for his third home run in four games of his rehab assignment to put the Saints up 1-0; it was the second leadoff homer of the season for St. Paul. Jeferson Morales made it 2-0 when he bombed out his fifth off Omaha starter John Gant in the second. The lead was extended to 4-0 after Wallner walked, Mickey Gasper doubled, Edouard Julien hit a sac fly, and Jose Miranda doubled off the wall in left-center. The game flipped in the bottom of the fifth when the Storm Chasers plated four runs on five hits. Tyler Tolbert broke a 5-5 tie with a two-run single off Randy Dobnak. Julien struck out looking with the tying runs in scoring position in the ninth.

**THE MERRIMACK MISSILE:** Saints UT Mickey Gasper continued to turn heads with a two-homer game in the nightcap of Saturday's doubleheader, his 3rd career multi-HR game. The switch-hitter from New Hampshire now has nine round-trippers in 22 games with the Saints. With another home run in his next two games, he would reach double-digit homers in a Saints uniform faster than any other hitter in franchise history in a single season (see below). With the Saints this year, he is averaging a home run every 11.1 PA, the best HR/PA average of any hitter in the minors at the full-season level this year with at least 5 homers. A switch-hitter, Gasper now has 7 homers from the left-side and is hitting .333/.440/.762 while he has 2 homers from right-side in which he is a .429/.520/.714 hitter. He is the fourth hitter in Saints franchise history with multiple homers from both sides of the plate in the same season:

**PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE:** St. Paul outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez has now walked eight times in his last six games and drawn at least one base on balls in four contests in-a-row. He now ranks 1-4th in the International League in total walks and 2nd in walk-rate, having drawn a free pass in 20.9% of his plate appearances this year, trailing only Omaha's Nick Loftin (21.2%) among qualified hitters in the IL. Rodriguez's 232 walks the past four seasons (2022-pres) are tied for the 16th-most in the minor leagues despite Rodriguez playing in at least at least 90 fewer games than anyone ahead of him on the list. With Rodriguez at the helm, the Saints ranks 1-4th in the IL in walks (221) and are 10th among full-season teams in MiLB in on-base percentage (.365, 2nd in IL).

**PITCHING PARTICULARS:** Despite some recent strong pitching performances, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 83 runs across their last 94.1 innings of baseball going back to the start of their last series in Iowa. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.59 ERA (135 ER, 184.1 IP), the worst mark in Minor League Baseball since the turn of the calendar page. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .849 as an offense is the fifth-highest in MiLB in May, and the best in the International League.

**GOING, GOING, GONE:** After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the International League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 53 round-trippers in their last 38 games since April 14, which rank 3rd in the minors in that stretch, trailing only the Charlotte Knights (58) and Greensboro (57). St. Paul have left the yard at least once each of their last four games and in 18 of their past 22 contests.

**FORGET ABOUT THE CURVEBALL, RICKY. GIVE 'EM THE HEATER!:** The Saints have crushed fastballs this season and lead the International League in batting average (.309) and rank 3rd in slugging% (.500) against fastballs as a team this season. 34 of the Saints' 60 home runs as a team have come against the hard stuff. Some of the Saints' best hitters currently on the roster against fastballs are listed below:

**THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY:** The Saints currently tout three of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list and St. Paul's roster overall features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and Baseball America: OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 by BA.

**TWINS REPORT:** The Twins (30-24) evened the series at Steinbrenner Field with a 4-2 win over the Rays yesterday. Joe Ryan picked up the win, firing a quality start with 6.0 innings, one run allowed. Kody Clemens hit his fifth home run of the season; all five round-trippers have come with the Twins and Clemens is now 17-for-63 (.321) in 21 games since coming to Minnesota. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (24-22) blanked Tulsa 11-0 in the homestand opener as Minnesotan Aaron Rozek went the first five innings in a combined team shutout. INF Tanner Schobel extended his hit streak to 14 straight. Kyler Fedko hit 2 homers and is tied with Carson McCusker for the most among Twins farmhands at 10 apiece. High-A Cedar Rapids (25-20) were clipped 4-3 by Lake County (CLE). Low-A Fort Myers (21-25) won their series opener vs Bradenton (PIT), 6-3. Payton Eeles went 1-for-3 and is hitting .267 in 9 games on his rehab assignment on the Saints' IL.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Started game two of a doubleheader on Thursday night vs Norfolk and turned in the second quality start by a Saints pitcher this season. Struck out five of the first seven hitters he faced, including fanning the side in the second. Threw 38 sliders (43%), 33 four-seam fastballs (38%), 12 splitters (14%), and five curveballs (6%). Notably did not throw a changeup despite using it more than 10% of the time in the big leagues this season. Generated 19 swings-and-misses, the most by a St. Paul pitcher this year and tied for the 4th-most by a Saints pitcher in the pitch-tracking era (2023-pres), led by 10 whiffs on the fastball. Recorded five strikeouts on the slider and three on the four-seamer.

**IT'S NO LONGER HIGH NOON:** Last season's breakout for Sim came in his first season after making some significant mechanical adjustments. During the offseason leading into 2024, he changed his arm angle to no longer come straight over the top. Instead of a 12 o'clock arm angle, he dropped down about six inches in hopes of getting his velocity back up to 93-94 mph. In addition, SWR added about 10-15 pounds to his frame.

**IT'S NOT HOW YOU START, IT'S HOW YOU FINISH:** It was a tale of two different halves for SWR in 2023 with the Saints. From April 9-June 8 he was 0-5 with a 8.08 ERA (42.1 IP/38 ER) while walking 26 and striking out 36 as opponents hit .322 against him in 10 starts. After skipping a start, SWR was electric over the final three months of the season going 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP/24 ER) with 35 walks, 60 strikeouts, and a .205 OBA in 14 games (12 starts). He rejoined the Saints for a couple of starts to begin 2024 and was optioned back on April 19 to make one more Triple-A appearance before he spent the rest of the year in the Twins rotation, and ranked top-5 among AL rookies with at least 125.0 IP in both batting average against (.246) and OPS against (.695).

**AND IN TOKYO IT WAS WHAT TIME:** When Woods Richardson was traded to the Twins he he was in Tokyo for the Olympics. The call came in at 2 a.m. in Tokyo. When he answered the phone he was half asleep and wasn't sure whether he was dreaming or if the call was real

**OLYMPIC EXPERIENCE:** Participated in the 2020 Summer Olympics (took place in 2021) where he won a silver medal (did not pitch in a game). Took a picture with Luca Donic while at the Olympics

**CALLING A LIFELINE:** Following Woods Richardson's trade from the Mets to the Blue Jays, he scrolled through the phone for someone to call and help him handle the news. He stopped on his former travel ball coach, 14-year MLB veteran, Adam Dunn. Dunn told him he was once traded for a bucket of balls and that he was just traded for Marcus Stroman

**TRADING IN BLUE AND ORANGE FOR RED AND BLUE:** Traded from the Mets to the Blue Jays along with LHP Anthony Kay for RHP Marcus Stroman on July 28, 2019. Was driving to Port St. Lucie with his parents trailing him in their RV after being called up to High-A when he was informed he'd been traded to the Blue Jays and should now head to Dunedin.

**BUFFALO WILD WINGS, YOU HAVE TO BE HERE:** Was hanging with friends at a Buffalo Wild Wings in Sugar Land, not thinking he was going to get drafted because teams soured on him because of a bout of tonsillitis during his senior season which held him out two weeks, when he got a call from his agent a little after 11 p.m. He saw his face on the TVs in the bar and all of it caught him completely off guard

**LATE BLOOMER:** After showing up to Kempner HS in Sugar Land, TX at 5'4 and 120 lbs, a growth spurt between freshman and sophomore year put him on scouts radar that added eight inches and 40 pounds. He was committed to the University of Texas before the Mets drafted him in the second round and signed him for \$1.85 million.
