LAST TIME OUT: In a season-low 2:05 ballgame, the Rocket City Trash Pandas got a complete-game effort from starting pitcher Jhonathan Diaz in a 3-2 win over the Birmingham Barons Thursday evening. Diaz went the distance on only 93 pitches. Rocket City got a two-run homer from Orlando Martinez in the first, and an RBI double from Michael Cruz in the second to take a 3-0 lead. However, Barons shortstop Romy Gonzalez picked up an RBI single to get Birmingham on the board in the third with no one out. Diaz then induced a 6-4-3 double play off the bat of Carlos Perez before Xavier Fernandez ripped a solo homerun to pull the Barons to within one. After that, Diaz allowed only three more baserunners, two of which were erased on double plays as Rocket City turned three for the contest. The southpaw allowed six hits, walked none and struck out seven while allowing the two runs. Barons starter Kade McClure suffered the loss after allowing three runs on four hits with a walk and seven strikeouts in six frames. Martinez led the Rocket City attack by going 2-3 with a homer, single and two RBI. There were no more baserunners for the game after a double-play by Rocket City recorded the first two outs in the top of the fifth

GETTING K'S: The pitchers are racking up the strikeouts against opposing hitters whiffing 757 batters through the first 72 games. That is good enough for first in AA-South. The most the Trash Pandas have struck out in a game was 19, which happened on 6/26 against Chattanooga when former starting pitcher Reid Detmers set a new season-high for Rocket City pitchers with 16Ks followed by reliever Ryan Clark who punched out three more Lookouts. Twice the Trash Pandas have struck out 16 batters. First on 5/11 when they K'd 16 Smokies in a 10-inning loss, then on 6/16 when they shutout Biloxi. The also struck out 15 Smokies in a shutout win on 5/13, 15 more against Birmingham on 5/25, another 15 against Chattanooga on 6/5, then 15 more on 7/22 against Tennessee. Detmers leads the way with 97K's after his 16-strikeout performance. He and closer Oliver Ortega combined to strike out 15 Biloxi batters in the seven-inning game as Ortega tossed a 1-2-3 seventh for the save with one strikeout. The Trash Pandas also struck out 14 Birmingham hitters on 7/16 and appeared to be well on their way to setting a new season-high before rain shortened the game to seven innings.

READY FOR LAUNCH: The Trash Pandas have lived up to the Rocket City moniker by launching 113 homers, which is tops in AA-South, and second in all of AA. 13 of those dingers came in the 7/20-7/26 series against Tennessee, which is the most in any series this season. Earlier in the year, Rocket City lifted 12 longballs against the Smokies in the 5/11-5/16 series, including two grand slams in the series finale on 5/16. Another 12 came in the series against Montgomery (7/6-7/10) with six provided by infielder Luis Aviles Jr. Izzy Wilson is tied for the league lead in homeruns with 17, with teammate and third baseman Mitch Nay right behind him at 16. In fact, the Trash Pandas possess four of the top 10 homerun hitters in AA-South on the team. Designated hitter Ibandel Isabel is seventh with 13 dingers and outfielder Orlando Martinez clocks in a tie for eighth with 12. Rocket City became the first AA team to hit 100 homers in 2021 on 7/21 when Brendon Davis slung a solo-homer over the elevator shaft in left field in the seventh inning.

PANDAS POUNCE AT HOME: Toyota Field has become quite the launching pad for the Trash Pandas. Of the 113 homers hit on season, Rocket City has blasted 70 of them at home. After hitting 12 in the first series against Tennessee, the Trash Pandas hit 18 dingers during an 11-game homestand against Chattanooga and Birmingham. In fact, the home team had at least one homer in 10 of the 11 games. Rocket City tied the 12-homer mark with a dozen in the series against Montgomery, six or which were hit by Luis Aviles Jr. The Trash Pandas' highwater mark came in the 7/20-7/26 series against the Smokies as they blasted 13 homeruns over five games.

IZZY BEEN BUSY: In June, outfielder Izzy Wilson was hitting lights out going 25-77 (.325) with six homers and 17 RBI. The first homerun was especially memorable as he launched a three-run blast off Chattanooga starting pitcher Hunter Greene, one of the top prospects in all of MILB, on 6/4. The following week, Wilson had a night to remember as he went 4-4 with two singles, two homers, two runs scored and two stolen bases on 6/10 against Tennessee. Wilson has followed that up by going 18-68 (.265) in July meaning he is 43-144 since 6/3 (.299). In addition, Wilson stole four bases in the Tennessee series that began on 6/8. He currently has 19 steals in 25 attempts, which is second in AA-South. In addition, his 17 homers are tied for a league lead. He is also second in AA-South in RBI with 41.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER: Southpaw Ryan Smith will make his AA debut tonight for Rocket City. Originally an 18th-round selection by the Angels in the 2019 draft, Smith began the 2021 season at Low-A Inland Empire and went 2-1 with a 1.63 ERA (5 ER/27.2 IP) over five games (four starts) to earn a promotion to High-A Tri-City on June 5. With the Dust Devils, he was 3-3 with a 3.74 ERA (19 ER/45.2 IP) in eight starts. His 96 strikeouts currently rank second among all Angels farmhands. Smith pitched collegiately for Princeton and went 8-10 with a 4.52 ERA (83 ER/165.1 IP) over four seasons.

The name was chosen in a name-the-team contest and is a reference to the area's association with the space industry and the determination and ingenuity of raccoons, aka trash pandas.

Trash Pandas, slang for raccoon, was included in the original 10 nominations following several Brandiose-led focus groups in Madison and Huntsville. The ballot descriptor read: Our community is known for engineering, and no creature in our galaxy is as smart, creative, determined and ingenious a problem solver - dedicated to the challenge at hand - as our local raccoons!

In July 2018, after the results from several focus groups in Madison and Huntsville, 10 names were selected, based on their uniqueness and how each name relates to the characteristics of the area: (Alphabetically) Army Ants, Comet Jockeys, GloWorms, Lunartics, Moon Possums, Puffy Head Bird Legs, Space Chimps, Space Sloths, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas. The focus groups were led by San Diego-based Brandiose, the Minor League Baseball industry's premiere branding partner.

Over the next few weeks, two rounds of online voting took place. The first round narrowed the list to Comet Jockeys, Moon Possums, Space Chimps, ThunderSharks and Trash Pandas.

Trash Pandas won the final round with 44.75 percent of the vote to ThunderSharks 19.25 percent. Moon Possums was Comet Jockeys fifth (11.38 percent).

third (12.57 percent); Space Chimps fourth (12.05 percent); and By the way, Trash Pandas dominated both rounds. More than 28,500 nominations and votes were recorded. According to Brandiose, this represented - by far

- the largest community participation in a Name the Team contest in the history of Minor League Baseball. The team name was announced in a local microbrewery in September 2018 with nearly 1,500 fans on hand. Trash Pandas was nominated by Matthew Higley of Lacey's Spring, Ala. He received two box seats for the first five seasons and will throw out the ceremonial first pitch at a Trash Pandas home game.

The regional identifier was also chosen by the community. Out of 13,559 votes cast, 67.4 percent chose Rocket City over North Alabama (18.09 percent) and Madison (14.51 percent).

Press Release From Major League Baseball - March 11, 2021

Major League Baseball (MLB) announced today the testing of a variety of experimental playing rules at various levels of the Minor Leagues during the upcoming 2021 season. These experimental playing rules have been approved by the Competition Committee and the Playing Rules Committee. MLB will closely monitor and analyze the impact of each rule change throughout the 2021 season and report to Clubs on their effects for further analysis. Consistent with the preferences of our fans, the rule changes being tested are designed to increase action on the basepaths, create more balls in play, improve the pace and length of games, and reduce player injuries.



Below is a summary of the experimental rules that will be tested during the 2021 Minor League season:

Double-A (Defensive Positioning): The defensive team must have a minimum of four players on the infield, each of whom must have both feet completely in front of the outer boundary of the infield dirt. Depending on the preliminary results of this experimental rule change, MLB may require two infielders to be positioned entirely on each side of second base in the second half of the Double-A season. These restrictions on defensive positioning are intended to increase the batting average on balls in play.

NOTEWORTHY

THE SMITH FILE: LHP Ryan Smith joins the Trash Pandas for his Double-A debut after a strong start of the season for Low-A Inland Empire and High-A Tri-City. In his third start of the season for the 66ers, Smith recorded a career-high 13 strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless innings in a win vs. Modesto. He was named Low-A West Pitcher of the Week for that dominant outing. In the month of May for Inland Empire, he was 2-1 with a 1.66 ERA (4 ER/21.2 IP) with six walks and 37 strikeouts to start the season. He was promoted to High-A Tri-City on June 5 and won his High-A debut on June 11 at Hillsboro with 6.0 scoreless innings and nine strikeouts. He pitched at least 5.0 innings in seven of his eight starts for the Dust Devils before his promotion to Rocket City.

<u>VS. BIRMINGHAM</u>: Making his Double-A debut, Smith will face the Barons for the first time in his career tonight at Toyota Field.

MORE NOTES

PRO DEBUT: Smith made his debut for Rookie-Level Orem in 2019 and made 19 appearances out of the bullpen for the Owlz. He pitched a season-high 2.1 scoreless innings at Rocky Mountain on August 21 and set a season-high with four strikeouts. He's transitioned into a starter for the 2021 season.

NCAA NOTES: Pitched four seasons for Princeton from 2016-19 and went 8-10 with five saves and a 4.52 ERA (83 ER/165.1 IP) to go with 166 strikeouts over 47 appearances (21 starts). During his senior season in 2019, he led the team in starts (11), innings (75.2), strikeouts (76), and ERA (3.45). His 76 strikeouts were the seventh-most in a single-season in program history while his career total (176) tied for ninth at the time of his graduation. He transitioned from a reliever to a starter during his junior year in 2018.

<u>HIGH SCHOOL NOTES</u>: Graduated from Garden City High School on Long Island in 2015. Lettered in volleyball, basketball, and baseball. In baseball, he was a 2015 All-County and Nassau County All-Star. He was also named a Perfect Game Pre-Season All-American Honorable Mention and named All-Conference in 2014.
