OPENING DAY: The Cyclones open their first series of the 2023 season at home against the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, High-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies...The Cyclones are 14-7 all-time on Opening Day and 15-5 in Home Openers...Brooklyn's last Opening Day win came in an 8-2 triumph on May 4, 2021, at Asheville...The Cyclones captured last season's initial home contest with a 5-2 win vs. Jersey Shore on April 12.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

BEEN A MINUTE: Friday's Opening Day matchup vs. Jersey Shore marks the first time the Cyclones have started a campaign at home since moving to the full-season level...Brooklyn's most recent season opener at Maimonides Park came in a 5-4 win vs. Staten Island on June 14, 2019, as a member of the New York-Penn League.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)... Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell**

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate comes to Brooklyn to open the 2023 season. The BlueClaws boast two of Philly's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*, including INF Hao Yu Lee (No. 6) and RHP Tommy McCollum Jr. (29)...Brooklyn dominated the season series vs. Jersey Shore in 2022, winning 22-of-27 meetings...The Cyclones were 10-2 against the BlueClaws at Maimonides Park.

(2nd round), RHP Tyler Stuart (6th), RHP Dylan Tebrake (8th), RHP Paul Gervase (12th), RHP Cameron Foster (14th), and RHP Jordan Geber (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach Victor Ramos' staff...C Kevin Parada — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF Chase Estep (9th) and INF Brad Malm (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PITCHING STAFF: The Cyclones have eight starting pitchers on staff, setting up for a piggybacking system to start the season...RHP Jeffrey Colón, RHP Cameron Foster, RHP Jordan Geber, RHP Raimon Gómez, RHP Tyler Stuart, RHP Joander Suárez, RHP Dylan Tebrake, and RHP Blade Tidwell will all act as starters to begin the season.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America...They include C Kevin Parada (No. 3 MLB Pipeline/No. 4 Baseball America), OF Alex Ramírez (4/5), and RHP Blade Tidwell (7/9)...OF Stanley Consuegra ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per MLB Pipeline.

CANARSIE TO CONEY: INF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**, returns to the Cyclones once again in 2023. The Canarsie, Brooklyn native attended Holy Cross High School in Queens - three miles east from Citi Field in Flushing and 30 miles northeast of Maimonides Park - before being drafted by the Mets in the 22nd round of the 2018 MLB Draft.

Joined the club from extended spring training on May 2...Accrued a 4-5 record with 3 saves and a 3.78 ERA (20 ER in 47.2 IP) in 24 appearances (2 starts)...Entered twice in relief during the postseason...Earned a win and did not allow a run or hit, striking out 5, over 5.1 innings.

START ME UP: Gómez is expected to make his a fifth career start on Opening Day for Brooklyn... In his first four between the Dominican Summer League and Single-A St. Lucie, the 21-year-old has an 0-1 mark with a 2.35 ERA (2 ER in 7.2 IP), 3 walks, and 4 strikeouts...Took the loss in his last start on August 10, 2022, at Clearwater (2.2 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K).

TEAM LEADER: With Single-A St. Lucie, Gómez led all pitchers on the staff (min. 40.0 IP) in home runs-per-nine-innings (0.19)...Additionally, the Venezuela native ranked second in walk percentage (9.8%) and FIP (3.04).
