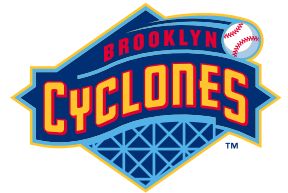

OPENING DAY: The Cyclones open their first series of the 2023 season at home against the Jersey Shore BlueClaws, High-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies...The Cyclones are 14-7 all-time on Opening Day and 15-5 in Home Openers...Brooklyn's last Opening Day win came in an 8-2 triumph on May 4, 2021, at Asheville...The Cyclones captured last season's initial home contest with a 5-2 win vs. Jersey Shore on April 12.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

BEEN A MINUTE: Friday's Opening Day matchup vs. Jersey Shore marks the first time the Cyclones have started a campaign at home since moving to the full-season level...Brooklyn's most recent season opener at Maimonides Park came in a 5-4 win vs. Staten Island on June 14, 2019, as a member of the New York-Penn League.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)... Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell**

vs. JERSEY SHORE: The Philadelphia Phillies affiliate comes to Brooklyn to open the 2023 season. The BlueClaws boast two of Philly's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*, including INF **Hao Yu Lee** (No. 6) and RHP **Tommy McCollum Jr.** (29)...Brooklyn dominated the season series vs. Jersey Shore in 2022, winning 22-of-27 meetings...The Cyclones were 10-2 against the BlueClaws at Maimonides Park.

(2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (12th), RHP **Cameron Foster** (14th), and RHP **Jordan Geber** (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach **Victor Ramos'** staff...C **Kevin Parada** — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF **Chase Estep** (9th) and INF **Brad Malm** (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PITCHING STAFF: The Cyclones have eight starting pitchers on staff, setting up for a piggybacking system to start the season...RHP **Jeffrey Colón**, RHP **Cameron Foster**, RHP **Jordan Geber**, RHP **Raimon Gómez**, RHP **Tyler Stuart**, RHP **Joander Suárez**, RHP **Dylan Tebrake**, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** will all act as starters to begin the season.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

CANARSIE TO CONEY: INF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**, returns to the Cyclones once again in 2023. The Canarsie, Brooklyn native attended Holy Cross High School in Queens - three miles east from Citi Field in Flushing and 30 miles northeast of Maimonides Park - before being drafted by the Mets in the 22nd round of the 2018 MLB Draft.

TRIPLE DIGITS: Per MLB StatCast and HawkEye technology, Gómez's fastball topped out at 100.2 mph on two separate occasions in 2022 with Single-A St. Lucie on August 4 vs. Daytona.

2022: Gómez served primarily as a relief pitcher for the eventual Florida State League champion St. Lucie Mets... Joined the club from extended spring training on May 2...Accrued a 4-5 record with 3 saves and a 3.78 ERA (20 ER in 47.2 IP) in 24 appearances (2 starts)...Entered twice in relief during the postseason...Earned a win and did not allow a run or hit, striking out 5, over 5.1 innings.

START ME UP: Gómez is expected to make his fifth career start on Opening Day for Brooklyn... In his first four between the Dominican Summer League and Single-A St. Lucie, the 21-year-old has an 0-1 mark with a 2.35 ERA (2 ER in 7.2 IP), 3 walks, and 4 strikeouts...Took the loss in his last start on August 10, 2022, at Clearwater (2.2 IP, 3 H, 3 R, 2 ER, BB, 2 K).

TEAM LEADER: With Single-A St. Lucie, Gómez led all pitchers on the staff (min. 40.0 IP) in home runs-per-nine-innings (0.19)...Additionally, the Venezuela native ranked second in walk percentage (9.8%) and FIP (3.04).
