#### Captain's Log

LAST TIME OUT: The Lake County Captains were held to just one run after tallying 18 on Friday, losing 7-1 to the Lansing Lugnuts, snapping their six-game winning streak. Gabriel Rodriguez drove in the only run, on an RBI single, his third run driven in this series. Mason Hickman was the lone Captains pitcher to not allow a run, throwing two scoreless innings, the seventh and eighth. Lake County went 1-for-7 with runners in scoring position.

IS STAT SO?: Alexfri Planez is on a 27 game on-base streak, tied for the second longest streak in the Midwest League this season. Planez has posted a .316/.339/.632 slash line with nine home runs, 24 runs batted in and 36 hits. Planez has just three walks during the streak. The only other man with more consecutive games on base is Diego Hernandez of the Quad Cities River Bandits, who reached in 29 straight contests from May 11th to June 22nd.

YAN AND POPS: In this series, Yan Rivera is serving as the manager for the Lake County Captains in for Greg DiCenzo. Rivera's father Luis is the current third base coach for the Toronto Blue Jays and was the first manager in Lake County history, steering the ship in the 2003 and 2004 seasons. Luis took over in Lake County at 39 years old, Yan is currently 26.

PLANEZ'S PLACE IN CAPTAINS HISTORY: Alexfri Planez hit streak came to end on Thursday, July 14th at 22 games. It is the longest streak in the Midwest League this season. The 20-year-old was just two hits away from the longest hitting streak in Lake County history. Francisco Mejia had a hit in 24 consecutive games with the Captains in 2016. Over the stretch, Planez had a .333/.340/.667 slash line with eight home runs, 23 runs batted in and 32 hits. Planez only walked once during the streak. The streak began on June 14th and ended July 14th.

ON BASE STREAKS: Petey Halpin has gotten on base in his last 17 games. In 13 of the 17 games, Halpin has gained at least one hit. The 20-year old has 11 walks compared to only four strikeouts. Angel Martinez has reached base safely in his last 12 games, smacking four of his eight home runs this season in the span.

2021 DRAFT: Five starting pitchers for the Captains' were selected in the 2021 draft. Today's starter Doug Nikhazy, the 58th overall selection, has totaled 60 innings over 14 starts allowing 23 earned runs. Tommy Mace was taken in the second round, 69th overall via a competitive balance pick, the right-hander has 43 strikeouts in 46 innings pitched. Aaron Davenport, was the sixth round and 186th overall pick in the 2021 draft, his seven home runs allowed is the lowest among qualifying Captains starters. Cleveland selected Jack Leftwich with the 216th overall pick in the seventh round. Leftwich has not allowed a run over 12.1 innings with Lake County. Rodney Boone was an eighth-round selection, pick number 246, and has made five starts including a complete game shutout against the Lansing Lugnuts on July 2nd.

**NEW NAME, SAME GAME**: The Lake County Captains are the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. Cleveland officially changed their name to the Guardians on November 19, 2021.

**LAST TIME OUT**: Doug Nikhazy turned in the best pitching performance in a Lake County loss this season. The left-hander struck out 11 TinCaps, including five through the first three innings. The 2021 Second Round Pick was one out away from completing the first individual complete-game nohitter in Captains history. With a runner on, a groundball was hit and fielded by the third baseman. After a look towards second base with no infielder at the base a throw came to first across the diamond that was not in time to get the runner.

**DOUG DAY:** Each start for Nikhazy at Ole Miss during the 2021 season was known as #DougDay. Nikhazy earned a program record with 12 wins and became the fourth two-time All-American in University of Mississippi history.

**16 K's:** On June 5, 2021, Ole Miss played Florida State in the Oxford Regional. In front of the home crowd, Nikhazy struck out 16 Seminoles, matching a school record. Ole Miss would advance to the Super Regional but lose in a three-game set to the University of Arizona.

**CALLING YOUR OWN SHOTS**: At the professional level, Nikhazy calls his own game instead of a coach orchestrating the decision for the next pitch. He told Mandy Bell of MLB.com "All I had to do was try and think about executing the pitch, not how I want to get ahead or out. Now you have to think about both those things at the same time while you're pitching, so it's a little bit harder."

**FAMILY IN OXFORD:** Nikhazy isn't the only family member affiliated with the Rebels program. His sister Amanda, is currently a graduate assistant, in the athletics department. Amanda played college softball at Stetson University in DeLand, FL. Doug and Amanda would play catch regularly growing up.

#### CAPTAINS TO THE MAINLAND

Six former Lake County Captains have made their MLB debut with the Cleveland Guardians in the 2022 season.

Nolan Jones: The 2016 second round pick, played his first game in the show, on July 8th against the Kansas City Royals. In his first major-league at bat, Jones smacked a RBI double down the right field line. Jones was a Captain in 2018, playing 90 games, compiling 90 hits including 16 longballs.

Oscar Gonzalez: The 24-year-old made his MLB debut on May 26th against the Detroit Tigers going 2 for 4, with a single and double. Gonzalez played 114 games in the 2018 season in Lake County, posting 135 hits, 13 Home Runs and 25 doubles.

Richie Palacios: The Brooklyn born Palacios earned two singles in his first two major league at-bats on April 25th against the Angels. Palacios earned had both his mother and father in attendance. Palacios played 20 games with Lake County in 2018 and had 24 hits.

Kirk McCarty: McCarty took the hill for the first time as a Guardian on Sunday, April 24th at Yankee Stadium. He appeared in the sixth inning, going three innings, surrendering four runs but adding three strikeouts.
