**Giants, Grizzlies Meet For Low-A West Championship:** The San Jose Giants play the Fresno Grizzlies (Rockies affiliate) this week in the best-of-five Low-A West Championship Series. Fresno hosts Games 1 and 2 at Chukchansi Park on Tuesday and Wednesday before the series shifts to Excite Ballpark in San Jose for Games 3-5 from Friday through Sunday.

**Head-To-Head:** The Giants posted a 14-16 record against Fresno this season. The Grizzlies were the only team in the league that San Jose had a losing record against this year. The Giants went 10-8 at Chukchansi Park during the regular season, but only 4-8 versus Fresno at Excite Ballpark. San Jose won four of six games in Fresno last week to close out the regular season.

**Playoff History:** The Giants are in the Championship Series for the first time since 2015 (swept by Rancho Cucamonga). San Jose last won a league title in 2010 when they defeated Rancho Cucamonga 3-games-to-2 in the California League Championship Series. The Giants are in the playoffs for the 14th time in the last 17 seasons.

**Regular Season Review:** The Giants finished the regular season with a 76-44 overall record. It marked San Jose's best regular season record since 2011 (90-50). The Giants posted a winning record in all five months this season: May 15-9, June 19-7, July 16-11, August 14-12, September 12-5. San Jose was 36-24 at home and 40-20 on the road. The Giants won nine out of their final 11 regular season games and was 21-9 over their last 30 contests overall. San Jose lost only three out of their 20 series' this season, two of which came to Fresno.

**Home Run Record:** Despite the shortened 120-game schedule in 2021, the Giants set a new team single-season home run record this year. San Jose finished the regular season with 150 home runs – second in Low-A West. The Giants broke the previous team record of 143 homers that had been established by the 2005 team (in a 140-game season). Marco Luciano, who was promoted to High-A Eugene on August 4, led the team with 18 home runs this season. Luis Matos was tops among all current Giants players with 15 homers. San Jose had 11 players hit at least seven home runs.

**Strikeout Record Too:** The San Jose pitching staff also set a new team single-season strikeout record this year. The Giants staff amassed 1,439 strikeouts this season (12.0 per game), surpassing the previous mark of 1,345 strikeouts set by the 2015 team (in a 140-game season). San Jose led all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts this season, finishing more than 100 strikeouts above the next-closest team (High-A Greenville with 1,315 strikeouts). Individually, the Giants boast the top four pitchers on the Low-A West strikeout leaderboard: Carson Ragsdale (1st, 167), Kyle Harrison (2nd, 157), Prelander Berroa (3rd, 135) and Ryan Murphy (4th, 116 – now with High-A Eugene).

**Pitching Shines:** In addition to leading all of Minor League Baseball in strikeouts, the Giants pitching staff led Low-A West in ERA (3.59), opponents batting average (.227), WHIP (1.25) and shutouts (11) this season. Kyle Harrison (3.19) won the league ERA title while Carson Ragsdale finished tied for first with eight wins. Out of the bullpen, Clay Helvey's 10 saves ranked tied for third in Low-A West and Randy Rodriguez finished the regular season on a streak of 28 1/3 consecutive scoreless innings.

**Team Awards:** The Giants announced their 2021 team awards during the club's final homestand. Award winners included: Luis Matos (team MVP), Prelander Berroa (Pitcher of the Year), Marco Luciano (Offensive Player of the Year), Casey Schmitt (Defensive Player of the Year) and Randy Rodriguez (Relief Pitcher of the Year).

**Top Prospects:** San Jose's roster features 11 players among the top 30 prospects in the San Francisco Giants organization according to *MLB.com*: outfielder Luis Matos (#3 prospect), pitcher Kyle Harrison (#5), pitcher Will Bednar (#7), catcher Patrick Bailey (#8), infielder Aeverson Arteaga (#12), infielder Luis Toribio (#14), pitcher Nick Swiney (#16), pitcher Prelander Berroa (#23), pitcher Carson Ragsdale (#25), outfielder Grant McCray (#26) and pitcher Tristan Beck (#29). Bailey (2020) and Bednar (2021) were each first round picks of the San Francisco Giants.

**Magnificent Matos:** Luis Matos finished with one of the greatest individual offensive seasons in San Jose Giants history. The 19-year old outfielder hit .313 in 109 games played during the regular season. He led Low-A West in hits (141), doubles (35) and RBI's (86) while ranking fifth in batting average and tied for eighth in home runs (15). Matos also led the Giants with 21 stolen bases. Matos went more than two games in a row without a hit only once the entire season (three games, September 5-9). Matos had the club's longest hit streak this year (16 games) and also had a stretch of nine consecutive at-bats with a hit earlier this month.

**2022 Season:** The San Jose Giants are slated to play a 132-game schedule next season with opening day tentatively set for Friday, April 8. The full 2022 schedule will be released soon.
