THE LAST TIME OUT: Mason Martin moved into a tie for the league lead with his 14th and 15th home runs of the season in Altoona's 12-9 win over the Akron RubberDucks on Tuesday night at Peoples Natural Gas Field. Martin gave the Curve a 6-0 lead in the third Team inning with a three-run shot to right-center and added a solo homer in the seventh to lead Altoona to their 30th victory of the season. Martin has homered in four straight games, totaling six round-trippers, stretching back to Saturday's doubleheader at Hartford. At the end of play on Tuesday night, Martin is tied for the league lead with Hartford's Taylor Snyder and leads all Pirates minor leaguers with 15 home runs. Frie Akron Altoona

TODAY'S GAME: The Curve look for their second straight win at PNG Field against the RubberDucks.

GRANDE CASTRO: The Pirates recalled INF Rodolfo Castro from Altoona prior to Tuesday's game and Castro promptly made an impact, drawing a walk in a pinch-hit appearance in the ninth inning and scoring the winning run as the Pirates defeated Atlanta 2-1 last night. RHP **Nick Kingham** in 2018 was the most recent player to be recalled to Pittsburgh directly from the Altoona roster.

THE NEWS IS GOOD: Pirates Director of Sports Medicine Dr. Tom Tomczyk gave an update on Curve RHP Roansy Contreras and INF Oneil Cruz on Wednesday July 7 and stated that both players have "forearm muscle strains" and the team is hopeful that they will be able to resume throwing in 2-4 weeks. Both players were placed on the IL on July 6 (retroactive to July 5).

THE FUTURE: Curve RHP Roansy Contreras has been named to the National League roster for SiriusXM Futures Game taking place on Sunday, July 11 at 3:00 p.m. at Coors Field in Denver, CO. Contreras is the 20th player in franchise history to be selected from the active roster to the game, first since **Ke'Bryan Hayes** in 2018. Contreras along with Greensboro RHP Quinn Priester give the Pirates two participants in the game for the first time since 2012 when Gerrit Cole and Jameson Taillon both were selected

LET'S PLAYOFF: Major League Baseball announced last Wednesday that all leagues at Double-A, High-A and Low-A will play postseason baseball. The top two teams in each league as determined by win percentage, regardless of division, will play a best-of-five series beginning on Tuesday, September 21 playing two games at the #2 seed with an off-day slated for Thursday, September 23 then the series finishing at the #1 seed.

THE POWER PLAYS: Mason Martin has hit six home runs over his last four games, including multi-homer games in the first game of the doubleheader on Saturday at Hartford and on Tuesday night in the series opener against Akron. Martin is tied for the Double-A Northeast League lead with 15 homers leads all Pirates minor leaguers in home runs. He is also tied for first in the league with 45

DAVIS DOES DAMAGE: Jonah Davis recorded his first four-hit game of the season, matching a career-high, on Tuesday night against Akron. Davis swatted his sixth home run of the season in the game, giving him 15 extra base hits out of 27 total on the season (55%).

THE RUBBERDUCKIES: The 'Ducks enter the series after taking 4-of-6 in their series with Bowie. Oscar Gonzalez knocked his team-leading 13th home run of the season before earning a promotion to Triple-A Columbus. The 'Ducks hosted rehabs for RHP Zach Plesac, C Roberto Perez, and OF Franmil Reyes during the series. Manager Rouglas Odor led the club in 2019 and again in 2021. Odor has twelve seasons of managerial experience where he has compiled a career record of 422-442 (.488). When Odor was Akron's hitting coach in 2014, he became the first person to wear the uniforms of the Canton-Akron Indians, Akron Aeros, and Akron RubberDucks. He played 197 games for Canton-Akron during the 1991, 1993-94 seasons, and he was the hitting coach for the Aeros 2012 Eastern League Championship squad. He has three sons and is the uncle of New York Yankees infielder Rougned Odor

FOR ALTOONA: RHP Travis MacGregor makes his ninth start of the season, tenth appearance, after delivering six strong innings in his last appearance in the continuation of a suspended game last Thursday...*For more on MacGregor, see page two.*

FOR AKRON: RHP Thomas Ponticelli will make his eighth start, 12th appearance, of the season for the 'Ducks. Altoona tagged Ponticelli for a season-high six runs, five earned, on six hits and two walks over 3.0 innings pitched on June 9 at PNG Field. Drafted by the Indians in the 12th Round in 2018 out of the University of San Francisco, Ponticelli went 3-4 with a 5.07 ERA in 24 appearances, 12 starts in 2019 with Single-A Lake County. Ponticelli hails from Newbury Park, California and majored in Business Administration while at the University of San Francisco. He earned the Jesse Foppert Fireman of the Year Award as the team's top pitcher as a sophomore in 2017.

2000 - Stephen Sparks pitches his second comeplete-agme shutout of the 2000 season with a five-hit win vs. Reading as the Curve won 5-0. Sparks is one of just two pitchers in team history to throw multiple 9-inning shutouts in the same season.
