

Leading Off

Tonight, Reading begins a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats. It is already the third series of the season between the teams. Hartford took 4/6 in Reading in April and the R-Phils took 4/6 in Hartford in early May.

Looking Back

Reading fell in five-of-six games to Binghamton on Sunday. R-Phils pitchers combined to allow five home runs, which matched a season high. Josh Hendrickson allowed four home runs, the first time an R-Phils pitcher has done that since June 1, 2021 at Somerset. when Kyle Glogoski did it. Offensively, everyone in the R-Phils lineup reached base in an 11-hit effort.

Carlos De La Cruz has been red-hot for the Fightin Phils. He currently holds a 27-game on-streak and is hitting .289 over that stretch, which dates back to May 12. Overall, De La Cruz is hitting 290 on the season, which ranks 10th in the Eastern League.

Rojas Rolling

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Offensively, he hit .423 last week and is .471 against Hartford so far. Rojas also leads all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks fifth in the Eastern League with a .301 average.

Long Ball Disparity

At home this season, Reading piching has allowed a whopping 52 total home runs. On the road, that numberis all the way down to 13. The R-Phils have only played two more home games than road in 2023 so far. Offensively, Reading has 36 home runs at home, compared to 22 away, a similar disparity, but certainly not as drastic as home runs allowed.

Keeping the Zeros Away

Through 56 games, Reading has not been shutout this season. The R-Phils are one-of-two double-A teams to not be shutout, along with Arkansas. In all of minor league baseball, Reading is one-of-nine teams to not be shutout.

Around the Organization

Last night, the Phillies fell to the Arizona Diamondbacks, but JT Realmuto became the first Phillie to hit for the cyle since David Bell in 2004. Lehigh Valley opens a series at home against Toledo tonight. Jersey Shore is back on the road at the Wilmington Blue Rocks. Clearwater, who has already clinched a first-half title, plays host to Tampa tonight. Also, Baron Radcliff homered in his first rehab appearence with the FCL Phillies yesterday.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 13, 2007: At Binghamton, Mike Costanzo's two home runs and three RBI spark the R-Phils to a 6-1 win over the Mets. Landon Jacobsen gives up five hits and one run over 7.0 innings for the victory.

This is the third series of the season between Reading and Hartford. The Yard Goats currently sit in fifth in the Northeast Standings, three games ahead of Reading. Last week, Hartford dropped five-of-six games to Somerset at home, winning on Wednesday. After this week, the Yard Goats return home to host Erie for a six-game series to close the first half.

Goat on the Bump

Righty Gabriel Hughes gets the start tonight for Hartford. Hughes started the season in high-A Spokane and made his Hartford debut last time out, on June 7. He went five innings, allowing three runs on five hits, with three walks and five strikeouts. Overall, he is 4-3 with a 5.48 ERA over nine starts. Hughes was the tenth overall pick bu the Rockies in the 2022 draft out of Gonzaga, and is the 5th-ranked prosp.
