NOTES AND NUGGETS

IN GOOD STANDINGS

Omaha's enters today's game in 1st place in the 20-team International League, 25 games over .500 at 45-20 (.683) and the best team in MiLB.
45 wins the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, one ahead of the 44-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .692 winning percentage is also the best, just ahead of the Frisco RoughRiders (41-20 / .672 / Rangers Double-A).
Up by 4.5 games over the 2nd-place Syracuse Mets with 8 games to play, Omaha's magic number to clinch the 1st Half title in the International League is 4, meaning the Chasers need 4 wins or 2nd-place losses to secure a playoff berth.

COMEBACK KIDS

Trailing 2-1 after the fifth inning yesterday, the win marked Omaha's 24th comeback behind win this season, meaning over half (53%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.
The Storm Chasers trailed for 6 innings yesterday Wednesday, tied for the 3rd-most innings the team has spent losing in a game they ended up winning this season.
Wednesday marked the 9th time this year Omaha has trailed by 3+ runs and won.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has a 31-9 record over its last 40 games ... 26 of those 40 games have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 22 of the 31 wins in this stretch.
Omaha is 16-6 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... 22 games decided by 1 run are tied for the most in the Minors ... the Chasers have won their last six 1-run games and 9 of their last 12.
Omaha's relievers had just 4 saves in the first 26 games (15%), but 17 of 40 games since (45%) have had a save awarded to Omaha (from 7 different pitchers), the most saves of any team in the Minors since May 1 ... Will Klein has 5 saves in that span, while Carlos Hernández has 4 Dan Altavilla has 3, Walter Pennington and Sam Long each have 2 ... Steven Cruz and Evan Sisk each have 1 save in the last 40 games.
In total, 43 of Omaha's 65 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or fewer (66%), including 13 of 20 losses this season.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 378 to 298 this season, a +80 run differential.
A +80 run differential ranks as the best in the International League and is the 2nd-highest mark at the Triple-A level trailing Oklahoma City (Dodgers Triple-A) at +97.
Omaha ranks 5th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... Kannapolis and Modesto are tied for the Minor League lead +137 (338 to 201 and 403 to 266).

YOU CAN COUNT ON ME

Two factors contributing to Omaha's success this season include the starting pitchers going deep into games and the offense providing their starters run support.
When Omaha's starter can get through at least 5.0 innings this year, the team has a 21-4 record (.840 winning %), compared to 23-17 (.575 winning %) when starters don't make it through the 5th inning.
When the offense can provide 3+ runs of support, the Storm Chasers are 27-5 (.844 winning %), while the team is just 18-15 when the offense offers 2 runs of support or less to the starting pitcher (.535 winning %).

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen remains one of the best in the International League and even across the entire Triple-A level.
The Storm Chasers bullpen has combined to hold opposing hitters to a Triple-A best .209 average (tied 4th in MiLB), while a 3.72 ERA against the Omaha bullpen is 2nd-best in Triple-A, as is the .678 opposing OPS versus Omaha's relievers.
Including both games of yesterday's doubleheader, Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 16 games this year ... this is an average of once every 4.1 games this year of the relievers combining for a shutout.
Walter Pennington's 69 strikeouts in 26 games (2 starts) are 5th-most in the International League, while 57 strikeouts as a reliever lead Minor League Baseball ... his 39.6% strikeout rate is 2nd in MiLB (min. 40.0 IP).
Will Klein has the team's longest active scoreless streak at 6 games (7.0 innings), since May 22 ... right behind him, Tyler Duffey (5.1 innings) and Evan Sisk (1.2 innings) have each gone their last 3 games without allowing a run.
The two longest scoreless streaks (by games pitched) at the Triple-A level in 2024 have come from Omaha pitchers ... Evan Sisk's 14-game scoreless streak ended Saturday, a stretch of 15.1 innings since April 20 without a run allowed ... Dan Altavilla previous went 13.2 innings scoreless over 13 games from April 23 to May 31.
