By the Numbers

The Captains are currently on a 7-game winning streak, which is their longest winning streak of the season. This is the third-longest active winning streak in Minor League Baseball, trailing only Cleveland's Double-A affiliate Akron RubberDucks (9 games) and the Great Lakes Loons (8 games).

Captains INFs Nate Furman and Maick Collado are currently on 12-game and 13-game on-base streaks, respectively. During their streaks, Furman and Collado have recorded a combined 32 hits and 14 RBI, while tallying OBPs of .404 and .561, respectively.

As a team, the Captains have hit 20 home runs so far this season, which are the fourth-most in the Midwest League. Lake County has hit 1 home run so far this series, and has hit 8 in its first 7 games against Fort Wayne this year.

CAPTAINS LOG

LAST TIME OUT: On Wednesday afternoon, the Captains defeated the Fort Wayne TinCaps in the second game of a seven-game home series by a final score of 7-6 at Classic Auto Group Park in Eastlake. This was Lake County's seventh consecutive victory, extending its longest winning streak of the season.

Offensively, after falling behind 4-0 in the top of the fourth inning, Captains SS Jose Devers, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, hit a solo home run in the bottom of the fifth to put the Captains on the board. This was his first career High-A home run and RBI. He eventually singled in his next two at-bats, tallying his third straight 3-hit game. After the TinCaps made it 6-1 game two innings later, Lake County added 3 runs in the bottom half of the inning. 2B Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, hit an RBI double, and RF Angel Zarate and 3B Tyresse Turner eventually hit back-to-back RBI singles. In the bottom of the ninth, 1B C.J. Kayfus hit a game-tying, tworun single to make the score 6-6. Three hitters later, Devers drew a bases-loaded walk to clinch the Captains' second straight walk-off win.

Lake County LHP **Parker Messick** (ND), MLB Pipeline's No. 21 Cleveland prospect, pitched a season-high 6 innings for his second consecutive start. The 23-year-old allowed a career-high 8 hits (tied) and no walks, while throwing 6 strikeouts in 87 pitches (60 strikes). RHP **Jay Driver** (1-0) eventually pitched a scoreless top of the ninth inning in relief to earn his first career High-A win.

21ST SEASON OF CAPTAINS BASEBALL: 2024 marks the 21st season of Captains Baseball. After the Columbus RedStixx were purchased in 2003, they were moved to Eastlake and became the Lake County Captains. In 2,756 regular-season games, Lake County has an all-time record of 1,386-1,370 (.503).

WINNING WAVES: The Captains have had a winning record in 13 of their first 20 seasons, including in each of their last four campaigns. Lake County has made 7 playoff appearances in franchise history (5 Midwest League, 2 South Atlantic League), with its 2010 Midwest League Championship being its sole title in franchise history.

TRENDS & NOTABLES

PLENTY OF '23 IN LC: Six players on the Captains' current active roster were selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the 2023 MLB Draft. INF/OF C.J. Kayfus was drafted in Round 3, C Cooper Ingle in Round 4, INF Alex Mooney in Round 7, OF Jonah Advincula in Round 8, RHP Jay Driver in Round 9, and RHP Zane Morehouse in Round 14.

MOONEY'S STELLAR SERIES: Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, was named the second Captain of the Week, presented by Official League, for his performance in last week's series at West Michigan. The 21-year-old hit 8-for-21 (.381), with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 2 home runs, 6 RBI, one walk, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches. Mooney's 2 home runs (tied for 2m), 5 extra-base hits (3m), and 7 runs (tied for 3m) all ranked top-three in the Midwest League this past week.

STRONG STARTING PITCHING: Lake County's starting pitching staff has been one of the premier units in the Midwest League so far this season. The group ranks top-five in the Midwest League in strikeouts (113, 1st), fewest walks (24, 1st), wins (7, tied for 1st), WHIP (1.18, 2st) innings pitched (104.0, 2st), ERA (3.46, 4st), and runs allowed (42, 5st).

KAYFUS CRUSHING THE BALL: Lake County INF/OF C.J. Kayfus has been one of the Midwest League's premier hitters in his first 14 career High-A games. The 22-year-old ranks top-seven in the Midwest League in slugging percentage (.610, 3"), batting average (.356, 4"), OPS (1.019, 5"), and RBI (17, tied for 7"). He is also currently on a 7-game hitting streak, during which he is hitting .357 with 10 hits, 6 runs, 2 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 9 RBI, 3 walks, and a 1.031 OPS

COLLADO COLLECTING BASES: Captains INF Maick Collado has reached base at an incredible rate in his first 14 career High-A games. The 21-year-old has a .525 OBP, which leads the Midwest League and ranks 5th in all of Minor League Baseball. Collado also ranks top-eight in the Midwest League in batting average (.356, 5th) OPS (.992, 8th), and walks (15, tied for 9th). He is also currently on a 9-game hitting streak, which is tied for the second-longest active streak in the Midwest League. During this stretch, he is hitting .382 with 13 hits, 3 runs, 1 double, 1 home run, 5 RBI, 7 walks, and a 1.000 OPS.

DEVERS DELIVERING AT THE PLATE: Lake County INF Jose Devers, MLB Pipeline's No. 19 Cleveland prospect, has recently been hitting very well. With a 3-for-4 outing on Wednesday, the 20-year-old became the third Captain since 2005 to record 3+ hits in 3 straight team games, joining OF Donnie Webb (8/16-8/19/2009) and OF Delvi Cid (6/27-6/29/2009). Over his last 6 games, Devers is hitting 12-for-24 (500) with 7 runs, 2 doubles, 1 home run, 2 RBI, 2 walks, 1 stolen base, and a 1.246 OPS. His .500 batting average during this stretch is tied for 2nd in the Midwest League, trailing only South Bend's Pedro Ramirez (.522, 12-for-23).

MOONEY MAKES HISTORY: On Saturday, April 27, Captains INF Alex Mooney, MLB Pipeline's No. 20 Cleveland prospect, tied a pair of franchise records. The 2023 seventh-round pick went 5-for-5 with 3 doubles, becoming the 15th Captain to record a 5-hit game, and the 13th to record a 3-double game. Mooney recorded the first 5-hit performance by a Lake County player since Bobby Ison on 8/7/2016 vs. West Michigan, and the first 3-double performance since current Double-A Akron RubberDucks OF Chase DeLauter on 7/9/2023 at Lansing.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on April 26 at West Michigan, **Carter Spivey** (1-0) recorded his first career Minor League victory and quality start, tossing a career-high 6 innings in the 7-1 win. The right-hander struck out a career-high 6 and walked none, allowing just 1 run on a leadoff solo home run in the bottom of the fifth. **Spivey** threw 51 of 77 his pitches for strikes (66.2%). The former East Carolina Pirate struck out as many batters in 6 innings as he did in his first 3 Minor League starts and 9 frames combined.

2024 VERSUS FORT WAYNE: Spivey made his second Minor League start at Fort Wayne back on April 14. He spun a then career-high five innings, allowing 2 runs on 6 hits with 3 strikeouts and no walks in an eventual 8-7 loss. Fort Wayne's lone 2 runs against **Spivey** came on an RBI triple and RBI groundout in the bottom of the third inning.

A NEW FRONTIER: After his five-year collegiate career at East Carolina University ended in 2023, **Spivey** made eight starts in independent ball for the Florence Y'alls (Florence, KY) of the Frontier League from July 22 to September 1. He made 4 quality starts for the Y'alls and posted a 3.06 ERA, the lowest on the team among pitchers that threw 40+ innings. **Spivey** went 7+ innings in two starts (August 3 at Evansville and August 20 at Joliet). Starting with San Diego RHP Brian Tollberg making his Major League debut on June 20, 2000, 52 Frontier League alumni have made the Majors.

A PIRATE'S LIFE FOR SPIVEY: Spivey went 17-4 with a 4.71 ERA in 83 games (15 starts) across five seasons at East Carolina from 2019-23. The right-hander was a teammate of current Cleveland Guardians RHP **Gavin Williams** from 2019-21. In 2023, **Spivey** was a 2nd Team All-American Athletic Conference selection. He went 7-3 with a 4.68 ERA in 24 games (10 starts), moving into the weekend rotation by the end of the season. The Fairfax, Virginia native was also tabbed the 2023 AAC Preseason Pitcher of the Year. **Spivey's** 15 wins over his last two seasons were the most by any AAC pitcher during that span.

HE'S GOING THE DISTANCE: On April 15, 2023 against the University of Cincinnati, **Spivey** pitched a complete game shutout in 7 innings. He allowed 4 hits and no walks, while throwing 3 strikeouts in the 10-0 win.

2022 IN THE JUNGLE: Pitching at Clark-LeClair Stadium, nicknamed "The Jungle," **Spivey** was named the 2022 AAC Pitcher of the Year. He went a perfect 8-0 with a 2.83 ERA and 76 strikeouts in 76.1 innings of work. The 24-year-old was also named the ECU Jungle Pitching MVP. The right-hander was a Collegiate Baseball 3rd Team All-American and a finalist for the NCBWA Stopper of the Year. **Spivey** made 35 appearances, the eighth-most in the country and third-most in a season in program history. In the Greenville Regional, he went 1-0 with a 2.57 ERA and a .214 opposing average. **Spivey** also finished with 5 saves, which ranked second in the AAC behind Houston's Ben Sears.

LAST TIME OUT: Back on April 26 at West Michigan, **Juan Zapata** made his fifth relief appearance of the year, pitching a scoreless seventh inning while striking out 2 and walking 1 in the 7-1 win. **Zapata** has now struck out multiple batters in three of five outings, and is averaging a career-best 10.5 strikeouts per nine innings.

TRAVELIN' MAN: In 2023, **Zapata** was the only pitcher in the Cleveland player development system to pitch at all four affiliated levels (Single-A through Triple-A). In total, the right-hander made 28 appearances (5 starts), going 6-3 with a 4.23 ERA, 60 strikeouts and 19 walks in 78.2 innings.

LIFETIME AS A STARTER: In 41 career starts, **Zapata** is 4-15 with a 4.41 ERA, 130 strikeouts and 52 walks in 190 innings, and is averaging 4.6 innings per start. The 25-year-old has earned 5 quality starts, including a career-high 2 in 2022 with Single-A Lynchburg.

MIDWEST LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE WEEK: Zapata was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week after his last Lake County start and penultimate Minor League start to date, which he made last season. On June 21, 2023 versus Dayton, **Zapata** pitched a career-high 6.2 shutout innings while striking out a career-high 9 in the 1-0 loss.

2023 WITH LAKE COUNTY: While his first quality start against Dayton was his lone start of the season at Lake County, **Zapata** made 20 total appearances as a Captain in 2023. He tossed 54.2 innings, the second-most among Lake County pitchers with under 10 starts. **Zapata** went 5-2 with a 4.28 ERA, 48 strikeouts, and 10 walks in 54.2 innings.

2023 WITH TRIPLE-A COLUMBUS: Zapata appeared in relief for the Triple-A Columbus Clippers on June 4 at Iowa (CHC) and Sept. 3 at St. Paul (MIN). On June 4 against the Iowa Cubs, he earned his first career Triple-A victory, pitching 2.2 innings of no-hit ball in the 10-7 win.

OTHER NOTABLE BANÍ NATIVES: Zapata hails from Baní, Dominican Republic, a capital town of the Peravia Province. Other professional baseball players that call Baní home include: former Captain, 5-time MLB All-Star, and current Cleveland Guardians 3B José Ramírez, 6-time MLB All-Star Miguel Tejada, 2-time World Series Champion Juan Uribe and three-time MLB All-Star Mario Melvin Soto.
