### LAST GAME

The Baysox won a wild back-and-forth affair 9-8 over the Altoona Curve on Thursday night. Bowie jumped out to a 7-1 cushion thanks, in part, to three home runs. Billy Cook notched a go-ahead, two-run home run in the third, before Coby Mayo hit a solo shot - one of three extra-base hits on the night for Mayo - and TT Bowens clobbered a three-run blast in the fifth. Starter Peter Van Loon tossed five, one run frames. However, Altoona did answer with a five-run sixth to make it a 7-6 contest. The Baysox would respond with a pair of unearned runs in the seventh. Despite making four errors on the night, including three in the final two frames, Bowie held off a late Altoona rally, with Kade Strowd picking up the final six outs for his first save of the season.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter tonight's matchup with a record of 33-32 - second place in the Eastern League Southwest division and 2.5 games behind first place Erie with three games to play in the first half. This is already the third matchup between the Curve and Baysox this season, with Altoona holding the 9-5 edge in the season series, including winning four of five at People's Natural Gas Field in April. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost five of six on the road against Somerset. Altoona is a tough team to strike out, as the Curve have the fewest strikeouts (528) in Double-A, and fifth-fewest in Minor League Baseball. Altoona's roster is headlined by five of the Pirates' top 30 prospects, via MLB Pipeline - SS Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 9 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 15 PIT), OF Matt Frazier (No. 21 PIT), and RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 29 PIT).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Anthony Solometo is set to take the ball tonight for Altoona. The No. 9 prospect in the Pirates' system, per MLB Pipeline, Solometo will be making his second start at the Double-A level tonight. This past Saturday, in his debut at the level in Somerset, he took the loss, allowing four runs (two earned) on six hits across five innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts. Solometo's 2.30 ERA across 58.2 innings for High-A Greensboro was second-best in the South Atlantic League, allowing just two home runs and holding opponents to a .207 average in the process. A second round pick for the Pirates in 2021, out of Bishop Eustace High School in New Jersey, Solometo features a low-90s fastball, a mid-80s slider, and a low-80s changeup.

### THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. With his first multi-double game of the season on Thursday, Mayo now leads the Double-A level with 24 doubles, while his 39 extra-base hits lead all of Minor League Baseball. The No. 8 Orioles/ No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in 11 of 12 games, and continues to have success against Curve pitching. Mayo is hitting .327 against Altoona this season, with five of his 13 home runs launched against Altoona, including four at PNG Field. Mayo leads the Eastern League in both slugging (.593) and OPS (1.014), while sitting third in on-base percentage (.421)

### LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is enjoying one of the hottest stretches of his professional career. Cook has hits in 15 of 16 games for the first time in his minor league career, including six straight. He's hitting .344 (21-for-61) in that stretch with six doubles and four home runs. Cook has bounced back nicely in 2023, hitting .307 with 20 extra-base hits over the past two months, after hitting just .103 with one extra-base hit in the month of April.

### SLIPPING UP

Bowie's four errors in last night's contest are the second most it has committed in a game this season. Last night also marks the seventh time the Baysox have made at least three errors in a game this season. Bowie has committed 64 errors on the season - third-most at the Double-A level. The Baysox are on-pace to commit 134 errors in a full 138-game season, after committing just 100 last season.

### STARTING STRONG

The Baysox have benefitted from strong starting pitching performances throughout the season. Bowie's 3.71 ERA from starters is the best in the Eastern League and second-best in all of Double-A. Over the past nine games, Baysox starters have pitched to a 2.52 ERA (11 ER in 39.1 IP). Pitching has been particularly strong across the board on the road as well for Bowie, whose 3.38 road ERA as a staff is also the second-best in Double-A.

## QUICK HITS

- Started the 12th No-Hitter in franchise history (5th Nine-Inning) on 5/19 when firing five innings against Altoona
- Opened the season with 13 consecutive scoreless innings, currently the longest scoreless streak for a Baysox pitcher this season.
- Ranked as the 19th overall prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline, entering the 2023 season.
- Acquired by the Orioles this past July as a part of the Trey Mancini trade. Final start as an Astros farmhand was against Aberdeen, the team he would join four days later.
- Older brother Sean played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season

## CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 6.08 ERA in Bowie across 6 starts and 26.2 innings last season. Held opponents to a .179 average but struggled with 20 walks and 7 home runs given up in a Baysox uniform.
- Made his Double-A debut for Bowie on 8/17 after making two brief appearances with High-A - his first two in the Orioles system. Surrendered 14 earned runs in his first two starts (8 IP) for Bowie, before finishing the season by allowing 4 ER in his final 4 starts (18.2 IP).
- Played two-plus seasons at Ball State. Originally drafted by the Houston Astros in the 4th round of the 2021 draft. Struck out 199 batters for Ball State in two seasons, across 139 innings. Redshirted his first season at Ball State in 2018 while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.
- Comes from a long legacy of Indiana basketball. Older brother Sean, played in the NBA for the Memphis Grizzlies during the 2020-21 season, and collegiately at Butler. Mother, Kim, played at Indiana State. Grandfather, Alan Danner, was a high school basketball coach who won two Indiana state titles, also in the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame. Uncles, Linc and Tige, played at Purdue and Appalachian State, respectively. Uncle Linc was head men's basketball coach at D2 Florida Southern and won a national championship in 2015 - also coached Wisconsin-Green Bay and reached the March Madness tournament in 2016. Linc was Associate Head Coach at Ball State in 2022.

## NOTES BY OUTING\*

- 4/12 Allowed a leadoff single in the first inning, but worked a double play. Allowed two doubles, but did not allow any runners to third base. After an efficient opening, 25 pitches in the fifth inning kept him from going further.
- 4/18 Labored over 21 pitches and two baserunners in the first inning, but retired eight consecutive batters into the fourth. Struck out five over four innings, but an error helped cut his fifth inning short, and a reliever allowed two inherited runners to score.
- 4/25 Relieved Houston Roth in tandem, allowed a triple to the first batter he faced, and a double to the same batter later (Tyler Fitzgerald) Both runs came from the same batter.
- 5/2 Walked first batter and allowed a home run to the second. Allowed a second home run later in the inning. 28 pitch first inning followed by six strikeouts over the next three scoreless innings.
- 5/7 Struck out the first four batters, then allowed a single and two-run home run. Did not allow any more hits while Bowie used two three-run home runs to win.
- 5/13 Worked around two two-out singles in the first inning. Allowed a two-run home run in the second, and had to escaped bases loaded in the fourth.
- 5/19 **12th No-Hitter in Franchise History (Fifth Nine-Inning)** Walked two of the first three batters faced, and then the first two batters of the fourth inning. Did not allow a hit. Nolan Hofman and Easton Lucas each added two perfect innings of relief.
- 5/26 For the second-consecutive start, fired five hitless innings, but walked six more batters. Collected two outs to start the sixth, but allowed a single and two-run home run. Bowie only scored one run.
- 5/31 Once again started with three hitless innings, but walked three batters. Walked a fourth batter in the fourth before allowing a single and sacrifice fly.
- 6/8 Allowed an early run through two early hits and a ground out. Only allowed one more hit over the next four innings.
- 6/11 Allowed runs in the second and third innings, both with two outs. Retired the side in the fourth.
- 6/17 Struck out seven batters over his first three innings. Allowed only run in the third inning, but stranded two runners in scoring position in the frame.
