PROSPECT UPDATE: The FredNats roster was star-studded right from the start, but has earned a boost to the Washington rankings with some strong early season performances. In the May 13 update to MLB Pipeline's prospect rankings, Eli Willits jumped into the top five, slotting in at No. 4 in all of baseball. In addition, former early-season FredNat star Ronny Cruz entered the rankings for the first time. Cruz, now with High-A Wilmington, debuts in the rankings at No. 92.

FIRST HALF STANDINGS WATCH: Sunday's game was the halfway mark of the Carolina League's 66 game first half, at game 33. In recent memory, the FredNats have been stronger in the second half than the first (including a second half title clinched on a walk-off grand slam late last season), but currently pace not only the North Division, but the entire Carolina League at 25-12 overall. The FredNats currently lead the North Division by five games over Hill City with Friday's win, with the season series with the Howlers even 6-6. The FredNats will see Hill City for one more series in the first half, June 2-7 at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

GAV IS BACK: One of the FredNats opening day roster's most anticipated pieces was INF/OF prospect Gavin Fien, acquired from Texas in the offseason via the MacKenzie Gore trade. After wrist inflammation has held Fien out since the first full week of the season, the top 100 prospect was reactivated for the first time in nearly a month on May 13. In his return to the lineup on May 13, Fien went 1-2 with a walk in game two against Salem. On May 15, Fien hit his first professional home run to center field at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

THE FRIENDLY CONFINES: The FredNats have been the best team at home in the Carolina League this season, holding a 15-4 record at home. This series, however, has been the bumpiest at Virginia Credit Union Stadium yet, as the FredNats dropped back to back home games for the first time this season on Wednesday and Thursday.

WEEKEND WARRIORS: The FredNats are 16-3 on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays this season. All three losses came together as the only three game losing streak of the season for Fredericksburg, dropping the final three games of the first series in Hill City, their only series loss of the season to date.

ABOUT LAST YEAR: The FredNats finished last season at 65-64 overall under Manager Billy McMillon, following the championship in 2024 by winning the North division's second half title to advance to the playoffs for the second straight year. The FredNats' season concluded with a two games to none loss to eventual Carolina League Champion Lynchburg in the Division Series.

UP TO OUR ARMPITS IN PROSPECTS: The Fredericksburg roster is loaded with some of the top talent in the revamped Nationals organization, headlined by Washington's top prospect Eli Willits, the No. 1 overall pick in the 2025 MLB Draft. Willits is ranked as baseball's 9th-best prospect overall by MLB Pipeline. Overall, the FredNats opened the season with seven prospects ranked in MLB Pipeline's top 20 Nationals prospects.

THE STAFF: Manager Chris O'Neill leads a coaching staff of seven newcomers to the Washington organization, and the average age of the coaching staff is 28.

WE ARE GETTING YOUNGER: The new staff in Fredericksburg follows a trend of young brainchildren charged with working in the Nationals organization this year, with other notable hires within the organization including President of Baseball Operations Paul Toboni (currently the youngest lead executive in MLB), General Manager Anirudh "Ani" Kilambi (aged 31), and Major League Manager Blake Butera (the youngest manager in MLB since 1972 at 33 years old).

FREDNATS BASEBALL NETWORK IS BACK: Once again, all 132 FredNat games this season will be broadcast live on the FredNats Baseball Network, with Luke West Poley and Adam Gotkin beginning their first seasons calling the action in Fredericksburg. Home games are broadcast on MiLB.tv and the Bally Sports Live App to go along with the audio-only stream at frednats.com/broadcast or the MiLB App. For road games, the radio broadcast is available at the same link. In addition, all FredNats games preceded by a 20 minute pregame show and postgame coverage following each night of action.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Potomac Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers and winning the title at Virginia Credit Union Stadium. The franchise has appeared in the Carolina League playoffs in three out of the last four seasons.

Chris O'Neill - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Hitting Coach/Recruiting Coordinator, Virginia Commonwealth University

O'Neill, 36, joins the Nationals organization after two seasons (2024-25) as a hitting coach/recruiting coordinator at Virginia Commonwealth University. Prior to that, he served as an assistant coach and assistant recruiting coordinator at George Washington from 2022-24.

O'Neill is credited with helping fuel major offensive surges at both VCU and George Washington, as both schools set offensive records and contended for Atlantic 10 championships under his watch. O'Neill spent the 2021 season as the director of operations at Duke University and prior to that, he served as an assistant coach at Bucknell University (2020), Marshall University (2018-19) and the University of Maryland-Eastern Shore (2017).

This season will be O'Neill's first time managing since he led the Grand Lake Mariners (Great Lakes Summer Collegiate League) in the summers of 2016 and 2017. A Pennsylvania native, he received his Bachelor's degree in Education from King's College in 2012. O'Neill and his wife Kate have two boys, Easton and Callum.



Luke Dziados - PITCHING COACH

1st Season | Previously: Pitching Trainer - Driveline Baseball (Tampa, Fla.)

Dziados (D-Zay-Dis), 27, comes to the Nationals organization after spending the last two years as a pitching trainer at Driveline Baseball in Tampa, Fla. He capped his college pitching career at Villanova University in 2023 after pitching at Binghamton University from 2018-20. Dziados earned his Bachelor's degree from Binghamton in 2021 and also earned a Graduate Certificate in Leadership from Villanova in 2023.



Jake Scheiner - HITTING COACH

1st Season | Previously: INF/OF - Hiroshima Toyo Carp (Nippon Professional Baseball)

Scheiner, 30, played seven seasons (2017-23) in the Phillies and Mariners organizations. He appeared in 658 Minor League games before signing in 2024 with Hiroshima Toyo Carp of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan. A native of San Mateo, Calif., Scheiner was drafted in the fourth round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft by the Phillies out of the University of Houston.



Luis Villanueva - ASSISTANT PITCHING COACH

Villanueva, 24, was a performance coach at LAVR Performance where he designed and led throwing programs to improve overall pitching performance for more than 50 athletes prior to joining Washington's coaching ranks. Villanueva attended and played baseball for both Kansas Wesleyan University and MidAmerica Nazarene University.



Anthony Ray - DEFENSIVE COACH

Ray, 30, joins Washington after spending the 2025 season as a hitting and outfield coach with the Rocky Mountain Vibes of the independent Pioneer League. - Michael James Tepper...on rehab assignment from High-A Wilmington, added to the FredNat roster on May 11. Previously started one game, allowing two runs in two innings for the FCL Nationals against the FCL Mets on rehab assignment on May 5.
- Drafted in the 15th round, 435th overall by Washington in 2023 MLB Draft from Liberty University.
- Previous stints in Fredericksburg in 2023 (4 apps, 3 starts, 14 ER in 9.1 IP), 2024 (10 apps, 1 start, 3.42 ERA), earned promotion to Wilmington late in 2024.
- Started twice for Wilmington last season before going on the season-long injured list.
- Spent first two collegiate seasons at Mississippi State, transferring after his sophomore year. Also spent two summers with the Falmouth Commodores of the Cape Cod League, holding a sub-5 ERA in both seasons, not allowing an earned run in 9.0 IP his first summer in 2021.
- Transferred to Liberty for junior season in 2023, posting a 5.23 ERA in 16 appearances (15 starts), striking out 78 in 65.1 IP.
- Both brothers played college baseball in home state of South Carolina (Winthrop and Limestone), father, Marc, was drafted from Lubbock Christian (TX) by Cleveland in the 39th round in 1988, spent four seasons in the organization, including two years in the Carolina League as a first baseman with the A-Advanced Kinston Indians in 1990 and 1991.
