## **JUMBO SHRIMP STROLL BY IRONPIGS 11-5**

Jacksonville drew 12 walks - their most in a game since 2019 – to beat Lehigh Valley 11-5. The Jumbo Shrimp scored seven runs in the top of the first inning without a hit, earning nine walks and one hit-by-pitch. After the IronPigs scored four times in the bottom of the first, Jordan Groshans lashed an RBI double in the second. Jerar Encarnacion blasted a two-run home run in the fourth inning. Simon Muzziotti homered for Lehigh Valley in the bottom of the fourth, but Jacksonville answered with Dane Myers' RBI single in the seventh to cap the scoring at 11-5.

#### X MARKS THE SPOT

Xavier Edwards was optioned to Jacksonville on May 30 by Miami, but has been on a tear in his return to Triple-A. In the 56 games he's played since he's been optioned, the Coconut Creek, Fla., native is 90-for-230 at the plate, slashing .391/.455/.513/.968 with eight doubles, one triple. six home runs 40 RBIs and 51 runs scored. This hot streak has pushed Edwards up to first in Minor League Baseball in batting average (.369) and second in the International League in OBP (.447). Among the 319 players in the IL with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Edwards has the second-best swinging-strike rate (4.3 percent).

## AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 53 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 54-for-189 (.286/.367/.646/1.013) at the plate with 12 doubles, one triple, 18 home runs, 52 RBIs and 37 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1 percent of his plate appearances at the Triple-A level last season. Allen is fanning just 21.2 percent of the time in 2023.

Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City. In 18 games with Jacksonville, Johnston is 28-for-75 (.373/.447/.653/1.100) with seven doubles, one triple, four home runs and 18 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in every game, including 10 multi-hit contests. Perhaps not coincidentally, since Johnson's return on July 25, the Jumbo Shrimp have posted a 13-6 record. Including his time with Pensacola in 2023, Johnston has driven in 101 runs, the most of any MiLB player, in 101 games.

#### CLOUD NINE

Following their 11-5 on Tuesday over Lehigh Valley, Jacksonville earned their ninth win in the last 10 games. Over this 10-game stretch, the Jumbo Shrimp offense ranks second in Triple-A in both average (.320), hits (114) and onbase percentage (.416) while ranking tied for third in runs scored (78, 7.8 per game), fourth in OPS (.927), seventh in slugging percentage (.511) and tied for 11th in home runs (14). The club has scored at least six runs in all but one games during this stretch. On the pitching side, Jacksonville is second in both runs allowed (40, 4.0 per game) and ERA (3.40) and third in walks (36). The club has ceded four runs or fewer in six of these 10 affairs. Only two of Jacksonville's 10 wins on this run have come by three runs or fewer.

#### IT ALL STARTS WITH THIS

Jacksonville's run that has seen them win nine out of the last 10 games has featured elite starting pitching. During the run. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded three runs or fewer eight times, working 51.0 innings out of the club's 90.0 innings thrown (56.7 percent). Jacksonville starters had tossed 52.2 percent of the team's innings prior to this run. Additionally, Jumbo Shrimp starters are 7-1 with a 3.53 ERA (22 R, 20 ER in 51.0 innings). They have combined for 47 strikeouts (8.3 K/9) against only 15 walks (2.6 BB/9) and 46 hits allowed (8.1 H/9).

## 'PEN PALS

at Columbus

Over the last week, in addition to strong starting pitching, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the seven games since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only eight runs, five earned, on 20 hits (7.5 H/9) in 24.0 innings for a 1.88 ERA. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 34 batters (12.8 K/9) against 16 walks (6.0 BB/9).

## FIRST THINGS FIRST?

The Jumbo Shrimp enter play on Wednesday just a 0.5 games out of first place. Outside of starting the second half of the season 2-0, the club has not resided in first place all season. Jacksonville hasn't been in first place this late in a campaign (by date) since 2010, when they were 32-21 and 1.5 games up on Mississippi in the Southern League South Division.
