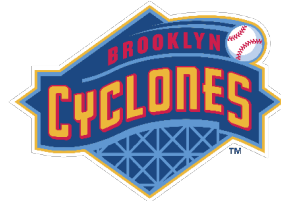

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Brooklyn enjoyed its best victory in franchise history last night, scoring a franchise record 20 runs in a 20-6 victory over Bowling Green Friday night. The Cyclones scored 10 runs in the top of the sixth inning and hit five home runs for the game. OF **Rowdey Jordan** and C **Matt O'Neill** each homered for the first time this year, while OF **Brandon McIlwain**, OF **Jaylen Palmer**, and OF **Joe Suozzi** also left the building. RHP **Grant Hartwig** earned the save, tossing three scoreless innings to finish off the victory.

THE SUOZZINATOR: Brooklyn OF **Joe Suozzi** has been on another level since going through a development program in early May. Since returning to action on May 19, the Long Island native has hits in six of seven games, hitting .450. The former Boston College Eagle is 9-20 with two doubles, two home runs, four walks, and just three strikeouts. Prior to the stint on the development list, Suozzi was hitting just .111 over his first 13 games with a 42% strikeout rate and three walks prior to the break.

BOMBOSAS: Since last Sunday's doubleheader against Hudson Valley, the Cyclones have completely turned around their power at the plate. Since Sunday, the Cyclones have run into 11 home runs in six games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.. In the span, the Cyclones are tied for the third-most home runs in MiLB.

PALM PILOT: OF **Jaylen Palmer**, the Mets No. 14 prospect, according to *MLB Pipeline*, has found his stroke in the month of May with a .826 OPS after a .423 OPS in April. Palmer has hit four home runs in his past nine games and sits three shy of tying his career-high of seven home runs with Rookie-level Kingsport in 2019. At just 21 years old, Palmer is the youngest player on the team and the highest-rated Mets prospect.

FLY ME TO THE MOON: Brooklyn took its first-ev-

vs. BOWLING GREEN: The Tampa Bay Rays affiliate currently leads the South Division of the South Atlantic League with a 25-16 record. Bowling Green and Brooklyn have split the first 10 games of the season series. The Rays have four of their Top 30 prospects with the High-A club, including RHP Seth Johnson (8), OF Heriberto Hernandez (16), 1B Kyle Manzardo (26), and SS Osleivis Basabe (28).

er flight on Monday en route to Bowling Green, Ky. for the first-ever series at Bowling Green Ballpark, flying into Nashville and driving north. The Cyclones have also never played at Greensboro, Rome, Hickory, or Winston-Salem -- all new Brooklyn opponents since the shift to High-A in 2021.

MUCHO POWER MENA: C **Jose Mena** is enjoying the best season of his career, hitting .312 with a .775 OPS and is tied for the team lead with 15 RBIs over 22 games after Wednesday's 4-for-5 performance in game one. With 82 plate appearances already, Mena looks to smash his previous high for plate appearances in a season when he had 112 in 2017 as a member of the GCL Mets. Mena's wOBA sits at .347, while his wRC+ is 107.

ARM ASSISTANCE: RHP **Mike Vasil** and RHP **Carson Seymour** have joined the team in Bowling Green after earning their respective promotions from Low-A St. Lucie. Vasil, the No. 21 prospect in the Mets system, according to *MLB Pipeline*, was drafted out of Virginia in the 8th round last season, while Seymour was selected in the 6th round out of Kansas State last year.

ROUGH N' ROWDEY: OF **Rowdey Jordan**, the Mets' 11th-round selection out of Mississippi State, ranks tied for third in the South Atlantic League with 13 doubles, sitting four behind the league leader Luis Mieses of Winston-Salem. The Brooklyn outfielder leads the team with 54 total bases and leads the team with 16 RBIs.

LAST TIME OUT: Santos pitched last Sunday in game one of a doubleheader against the Hudson Valley Renegades.

HIGH-RANKING MEMBER: Santos ranks as the top pitching prospect on the staff, ranking No. 16 according to *MLB Pipeline* and No. 17 according to *Baseball America*.

NSYNC: Santos has been a much more dominant pitcher in May after a rocky April. In May, the 20-year-old righty has a 2.25 ERA with a 21% strikeout rate and a 12% walk rate after an 8.03 ERA in four April starts with an 18% strikeout rate and 16% walk rate. In April, Santos did not make it into the fifth inning but has lasted into the fifth inning three times in May.

BREAKOUT: The 20 year old pitched with Low-A St. Lucie in 2021, tossing 96 innings which doubles the workload he turned in in 2019 (40.2 IP) and 2018 (45). This season marks the second full season assignment for the righty.

VALUED MEMBER: Santos signed with the Mets in 2018 for \$275,000 out of Santiago in the Dominican Republic.

WEIRD START: Santos struggled in his first start of 2022, lasting just two innings in game one of a doubleheader and 5-1 loss to the Wilmington Blue Rocks on April 9. Santos' clunky start may have been affected by Friday night's postponement. Ready, warming up, and tossing in the outfield minutes before schedule first pitch on Friday, Santos had to shut it down and repeat the process on Saturday after the Cyclones-Blue Rocks game was postponed due to soft infield dirt and "wet grounds."

OPENING DAY STARTER: Junior Santos made Brooklyn's Opening Day start in Wilmington, Delaware on Saturday evening. It was Santos' fourth Opening Day and first Opening Day start since 2018 when he pitched for the DSL Mets against the DSL Angels. In that outing, he struck out six over three innings of one-run ball.
