REGULAR SEASON BY THE NUMBERS

TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a sixgame home series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at Trustmark Park. This is the second of five series between the two clubs who will meet 30 times (12 at Trustmark Park, 18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium)

REVENGE TOUR: The M-Braves are looking for revenge, having lost 5 of 6 games on the road at Pensacola from May 2-7. The M-Braves suffered three one-run losses and only lost the aggregate score by one run, 19-18.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves lost 6-2, giving Pensacola a two games to one lead

Drew Lugbauer homered for a third straight game on a two-run blast to the Farm Bureau Grill in the fourth. LHP Domingo Robles battled after a three-run first inning, finishing with three earned runs in five innings.

RETURN OF THE COMEBACK KIDS?: The M-Braves have pulled off a ninth-inning or later comeback in two of the last four games. Last season, the club pulled off 10 eighth inning or later comeback wins.

TURNING THE SHIP AROUND: The M-Braves have won nine of the last 14 games since May 9. The club is 15-13 since April 22 when they started the season at 3-10 with an eight-game losing streak. The M-Braves swept Chattanooga in a five-game series at Trustmark Park from May 9-14, outscoring the Lookouts 27-8. The M-Braves starting pitchers allowed just one earned run over 27 innings in the series.

WITH GREAT PITCHING COMES GREAT RE-**SPONSIBILITY:** Both clubs feature pitching staffs that are top five in all of minor league baseball. The M-Braves lead the Southern League in pitching and rank 3rd in Double-A, 5th in MiLB, with a 3.39 ERA. During the month of May, M-Braves pitching ranks 2nd in MiLB with a 2.70 ERA. M-Braves starters rank 5th in Double-A with a 3.43 ERA.

The Blue Wahoos are not far behind, ranking 4th in Double-A and 7th in MiLB with a 3.45 ERA. Pensacola starters are 3rd in Double-A with a 3.23 ERA

TRANSACTION TUESDAY: On Tuesday, the M-Braves received familiar faces in INF Luke Waddell and RHP Kyle Wilcox from Triple-A Gwinnett on Tuesday. OF Jacob Pearson was reinstated from the development list.

In corresponding moves, the M-Braves transferred INF Hudson Potts to FCL, OF Drew Campbell to Dev List, and RHP Daysbel Hernandez to 7-day IL.

PROSPECTING: 6 of Atlanta's Top 30 MLB Pipeline prospects are on the active roster: RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), C Tyler Tolve (29) and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

<u> "KISS IT GOODBYE", BUT NOT AT TRUSTMARK</u> PARK: The M-Braves have 40 homers - 31 on the road. 12 different players have at least one homer with Drew Lugbauer leading the way with a league-leading 10 homers. Lugbauer has four of the club's nine home runs at Trustmark

<u>VIVA LA VALDES:</u> Javier Valdes is currently on a 15-game on-base streak, which began on April 23. The streak is the longest by an M-Braves player this season. Over the streak, the Miami, FL native is batting .360 with four doubles, four home runs, six RBI, 11 walks, and 1.156 OPS.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever allowed a run for the first time on May 20 in his 12th relief appearance. He has four saves (T-2nd, SL). Barger started the season with 15 shutout innings, with 19 strikeouts to seven walks, in 11 appearances. He currently has a 1.02 ERA in 17 2/3 innings.

COUNTIN' ON CONLEY: M-Braves leadoff hitter Cal Conley is on a seven-game hit streak, reaching base in 14 of the last 15. In May, Conley is batting .282 a homer, five doubles, two RBI, eight stolen bases and 13 runs in 20 games.

ALL HAIL KING SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer has homered in three straight games, becoming the sixth M-Brave to do so. Lugbauer achieved the feat from July 25-28 in 2021. He is currently on a 13-game on-base streak.

The first baseman ranks among the league leaders in home runs (10, 1st), SLG (.584, 1st), OPS (.930, 1st), RBI (27, 4th), XBH (18, T-4th), TB (66, T-8th).

Lugbauer recorded his first career M-Braves triple on May 13 against the Lookouts, then another on May 16 at Montgomery. He made his profesional pitching debut on May 17 at Montgomery tossing 2/3 scoreless innings with a strikeout of Logan Driscol on an 87 mph fastball. On May 23, Lugbauer cranked a 117-mileper-hour home run, which would rank 5th among MLB players for hardest hit balls this

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Lugbauer has a club record 56 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record

WINNIN' WITH WILCOX: RHP Kyle Wilcox pitched two shutout innings on Thursday night for his first M-Braves win. He has yet to allow a run in 6.1 innings over five relief appearances with the M-Braves, including no walks to 11 strikeouts.

The right-hander spent time on Triple-A Gwinnett's roster from April 18-May 23, recording a 4.32 ERA in 12.1 innings

Rangel makes his eighth start of 2023 and his eighth career start against Pensacola.
 This will be Rangel's 41st career start for Mississippi over the last three seasons. Rangel pitched 5.2 innings, allowing three runs at Pensacola on May 6.

LAST TIME OUT

 The 25-year-old settled for a no decision, pitching 5.0 innings of one-run ball at Montgomery on May 20. Rangel has allowed two runs in his last two starts over 10.0 innings.
