Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, return to action following the Major League Baseball All-Star Break with a three-game series against the Lake County Captains, High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. These are the first games between the two teams in Lansing since the opened the season with one another in April; these are also the final meetings of the the year between the two ballclubs. The Nuts are 7-8 vs. the Caps this season, 1-2 at home.

Off the Field: It's Marvel Super Hero Day, with Black Panther-themed uniforms, a Black Panther Sock Giveaway presented by Capital Area District Library (CADL) and LAFCU Fireworks!

Starting Matchup: Lansing right-hander Stevie Emanuels gets the ball in his 12th start of the year, his 17th overall appearance. This is the fourth time he has pitched against the Captains this year and third start; in 10 1/3 combined innings, he has allowed 12 runs (including four home runs) with seven walks and 16 strikeouts. Emanuels also started once against Lake County last season (4 2/3 IP, 1 R, 5 K). The Caps will start southpaw Rodney Boone, who tossed a complete game seven-inning shutout against the Nuts on July 2nd.

Last Game, July 17: Lugnuts 3, TinCaps 2. The Lugnuts won the final two games against the TinCaps after dropping the first four, edging the Caps on Sunday behind five strong one-hit innings from Jake Walkinshaw, who struck out five.

A Three-Game Series... or a Six-Game Series? This is the Lugnuts' second Friday-through-Sunday three-game series of the year, with every other series going six games. The first was a three-game set to open the season against these very same Lake County Captains. In essence, it was as if the two teams met for three games, declared "to be continued!" and now we reunite for the exciting conclusion.

Roll Out the Red Carpet: 19-year-old SS Max Muncy, the 25th overall pick in the 2021 draft and the No. 4 prospect in the Athletics' organization, was promoted to the Lugnuts from Single-A Stockton during the All-Star Break, joining Tyler Soderstrom (2020's 26th overall pick) as Oakland first-round selections and top prospects in the Nuts' starting lineup. Muncy had 16 doubles, one triple and 16 homers for Stockton, posting a .230/.357/.447 slash line, comparable to Soderstrom, who is slashing .253/.316/.492 with 18 doubles, three triples and 16 homers for the Lugnuts.

No. 20 - OF Denzel Clarke

- Lugnuts OF **Denzel Clarke**, the A's No. 13 prospect, walked and struck out in two plate appearances and made a highlight-reel catch while colliding with the right field wall in the 2022 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on Saturday, helping the American League defeat the National League, 6-4. Fellow A's prospect **Shea Langeliers** homered and caught a runner stealing and was named MVP.
- Former Lugnuts Alejandro Kirk and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. started the game for the American League, with Kirk catching the ceremonial first pitch from Fernando Valenzuela. Jordan Romano was also named an All-Star but did not see action out of the bullpen.

Clean Baseball: The Lugnuts have now committed only five errors in their last 17 games, with 13 fully errorless games. The opposition has only committed seven errors in that span, with 12 errorless games.

Hot in July: The Lugnuts' top hitters this month include INF Euribiel Ángeles, hitting .348/.400/.413, .813 OPS, with three doubles, three walks and an .813 OPS in 13 games this month, striking out just twice; INF Jack Winkler (.346/.433/.500, .933 OPS, five doubles, one HR and 11 RBIs in 15 games); UT Joshwan Wright (.327/.365/.469, .834 OPS, two doubles, one triple, one HR in 14 games) and Tyler Soderstrom (.317/.396/.683, 1.079 OPS, four doubles, one triple, three homers, 12 RBIs in 12 games).

Among the MWL Leaders: Tyler Soderstrom is 2nd in the Midwest League with 61 RBIs, 4th with 148 total bases, tied for 3rd with 37 extra-base hits and 5th with 16 home runs. Reliever Kumar Nambiar is 1st with 31 relief appearances and reliever Trayson Kubo is tied for 4th with seven saves.

Nuts to the Show: Pitcher Max Castillo (2018) made his MLB debut for the Toronto Blue Jays on June 19, becoming the 169th all-time Lugnut to reach the Maors and the eighth this year, joining Oakland A's pitchers Zach Logue (2018) and Zach Jackson (2017) and infielder Christian Lopes (2013); Toronto Blue Jays utilityman Vinny Capra (2018) and catcher Gabriel Moreno (2019); Seattle Mariners reliever Danny Young (2016) and Boston Red Sox starting pitcher Josh Winckowski (2019) as former Lugnuts to make it to the Major Leagues this year.

Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

Draft Day: Selected 157th overall in the 5th round, 2020 from the University of Washington (the "Huskies")... scout: Jim Coffman, who also signed Joe DeMers, Jared McDonald and current Oakland A's outfielder Seth Brown... signed for \$400,000... drafted three picks before the end of the draft... one of three of Oakland's five 2020 draft picks on the Lugnuts (1st round - Tyler Soderstrom; 2nd round - Jeff Criswell).

Personal: Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

Hometown: Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Ciara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree hosue) for \$36 million.

Glory Days: Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

Life as a Huskie: Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collegiate Baseball.

UW in The Show: Notable Huskies in MLB history include Tim Lincecum, Mike Blowers, Jim Colborn, Fred Hutchinson, Jeff Heath, Jake Lamb, Andrew Kittredge, Adam Cimber, Austin Voth, Braden Bishop, Jeff Brigham, Kevin Stocker, and the unforgettable Hunky Shaw.

2021 Professional Debut: Opened season as the Lugnuts' Sunday starter... excelled in pro debut, May 9 vs. Lake County: 4 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K... followed up five two-hit scoreless innings at Dayton, May 16... season curtailed due to injury, however, after four starts in May and three appearances in June... set Lugnuts franchise single-game record in last appearance, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four home runs: two apiece by Andy Pages and Deacon Liput in back-to-back innings... made one scoreless appearance in Arizona Complex League before season's end.

2022 - Back in Lansing:

- Piggybacked Jeff Criswell in season debut, Sunday, **April 10 vs. Lake County**, striking out six Captains in three innings... earned win as Lugnuts topped Caps, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep.
- April 23 vs. Fort Wayne, Game 2: tied his own franchise single-game record, giving up four home runs to the TinCaps (Corey Rosier leading off the game, Robert Hassell III hit two, Ripken Reyes hit one) in six innings in Lugnuts' 6-2 defeat.
- April 30 at Lake County, Game 1: struck out seven Captains (tied for season high) in five innings, but allowed two-run homer to Jhonkensy Noel and solo homer to Johnathan Rodriguez, back-to-back shots in three-run 1st, and Lugnuts fell, 3-0.
- May 11 vs. Dayton: dominated the Dayton Dragons with five scoreless innings... four of the five were perfect, with a double (Justice Thompson) and two walks allowed in the third inning before he bore down and stranded the bases loaded... tied career high with seven strikeouts... Lugnuts won comfortably against the first-place Dragons, 6-1.
- June 22 vs. Beloit: Cody Morrisette led off the game with a home run to right, and that turned out to be the only run in 1-0 Beloit Sky Carp victory at Jackson Field... settled in after home run to toss 5 2/3 innings, allowing only four more hits (all singles) and two walks while striking out three... game had a controversial finish: with two outs in the bottom of the ninth, Jared McDonald seemed to have tied the game up with a home run to right field, but umpires Justin Juska and Kevin Levine ruled that the ball hit off the top of the wall and remained in play, awarding McDonald a double... he was then stranded at third base as Gabriel Maciel fouled out to third to end the game.
- 6.80 ERA as a starter (11 GS), 49 IP, 63 H, 9 HR, 31 BB, 45 K, 1.92 WHIP, .309 avg... 4.12 ERA as a reliever (5 G), 19.2 IP, 22 H, 1 HR, 13 BB, 27 K, 1.78 WHIP, .278 avg.
- Left-handed batters are hitting .322 with eight home runs... right-handers .279 with two homers; 46 of 72 strikeouts (64%) have come against right-handers... 25 of 44 walks have come vs. lefties (57%).
- Allowed six home runs in April... then tossed 39 1/3 consecutive innings without allowing a home run before Cody Morissette's leadoff blast on June 22.
