PITCHING DAZZLES IN 3-1 WIN

Valente Bellozo, Luarbert Arias and Emmanuel Ramírez combined to hold Gwinnett to one run on three hits on Thursday in Jacksonville's 3-1 victory. A pair of sacrifice flies - one from Griffin Conine in the second and another from Will Banfield in the sixth - made it 2-0 Jumbo Shrimp. The Stripers scored on an error in the sixth inning to halve the lead, but in the eighth, Troy Johnston scampered home on a wild pitch to make it 3-1. Bellozo yielded just an unearned run in 5+ innings. Arias matched a season-high with 3.0 scoreless frames and Ramírez picked up his eighth save.

AND SHE THINKS WE'RE JUST FISHIN'

Over the last 23 meetings between Jacksonville and Gwinnett dating back to 2023, the Stripers hold a narrow 12-11 advantage over the Jumbo Shrimp. Over these 23 contests, Gwinnett has outscored Jacksonville by a thin 93-87 margin. Seventeen of these 23 affairs have been determined by three runs or fewer; the Stripers own a 9-8 advantage in these closely-decided contests. With much else being equal over these 23 games, Gwinnett owns edges in stolen bases (24-13) and strikeouts (186-171). The Jumbo Shrimp own a very small advantage in home runs (18-17).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 17-12 in their last 29 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 20 of those 29 affairs (69.0 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in both fewest runs allowed (109) and ERA (3.41) while ranking second in OPS against (.733), third in WHIP (1.35), fifth in fewest hits allowed (236) and sixth in batting average against (.244).

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine has been stellar since early May. Over his last 54 games, the Duke product is 58for-190, slashing .305/.377/.605/.982 with 13 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 37 RBIs, 22 walks and 35 runs scored. Among the 117 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks eighth in HR/FB (27.0 percent). On the season, he ranks tied for seventh in the IL in extra-base hits (36), tied for ninth in home runs (17), 13th in SLG (.529), 16th in OPS (.886) and tied for 19th in both doubles (18) and hits (77).

QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 24 of the last 28 games, with 20 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and 10 being without an earned run. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 53 runs, 47 earned, on 114 hits (8.5 H/9) in 120.2 innings for a 3.51 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 111 strikeouts (8.3 K/9) against 52 walks (3.9 BB/9) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 14 different pitchers over these 28 contests.

SOULIA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, Troy Johnston, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 40 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 52-for-150, slashing .347/.412/.533/.945 with nine doubles, two triples, five homers, 22 RBIs, 15 walks and 30 runs scored. Johnston has 12 multi-hit games in his last 21 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (99) while also ranking tied for fifth in doubles (21) and 21st in batting average (.286).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 49 of his last 56 games, notching 21 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 72for-221 (.326/.394/.475/.869) with 18 doubles, three triples, three home runs, 35 RBIs, 26 walks and 27 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks sixth in batting average (.300), tied for ninth in doubles (20) and tied for 17th in hits (78).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's starting rotation ERA of 4.39 leads all of Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp's lid-lifters have tossed 399.2 innings, which ranks eighth at the level | Jacksonville relievers have combined for a 4.29 ERA (seventh in Triple-A)... The Jumbo Shrimp are 14-7 (.667) in their last 21

ABOUT KYLE

-Tyler was originally selected by the Los Angeles Angels in the 20th round of the 2018 draft out of the University of Oklahoma.

-In March and April 2022, Tyler was designated for assignment and claimed five different times, finally ending up in the San Diego Padres' organization.

-Tyler made his MLB debut on September 5, 2021 for the Angels in a game against the Texas Rangers. He went 3.0 scoreless innings, yielding one hit and striking out two in a 7-3 Texas victory.

-Following the 2023 season, Tyler signed a minor league deal on November 28, 2023 with

2023 SEASON

-Tyler posted neutral platoon splits. In 272 plate appearances, left-handed hitters batted .293/.369/.418/.787 against him. Comparatively, in 345 plate appearances, right-handed batters hit .280/.345/.447/.792 against him.

Tyler closed the season strong. In three September starts, he went 1-0 with a 2.60 ERA. Over 17.1 innings, he ceded 16 hits (.232 batting average against) with 19 strikeouts against five walks.

2022 SEASON

-Tyler threw a total of 29.1 innings between the San Diego Padres, Triple-A El Paso and Triple-A Sacramento.

-Tyler became a free agent on July 6, 2022 after the Padres designated him for assignment on July 3. He signed a minor league contract with the San Francisco Giants on July 13 and finished the season in their organization with Triple-A Sacramento.

2021 SEASON

-In 12 starts with Rocket City, compiled a 5-2 record and 3.14 ERA. Over 66.0 innings, yielded 59 hits (.236 batting average against) with 67 strikeouts against 20 walks.

-Conversely, as a reliever, Tyler surrendered 5 runs, four earned, on five hits in 6.0 innings for a 6.00 ERA. He struck out six against two walks.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-While at the University of Oklahoma, Tyler majored in planned programming. At Westmoore High School, he maintained a 4.2 GPA.

-The 2015 Oklahoma Gatorade Baseball Player of the Year and a Louisville Slugger All-American, Tyler finished his senior season 10-0, posting a $0.70\,\mathrm{ERA}$ and $102\,\mathrm{strikeouts}$ in 60 innings pitched.
