BIRDS BLANK DRILLERS TO EVEN SERIES: Brandon Komar tied a career high with 9 strikeouts over 5.1 scoreless innings of relief as the Cardinals picked up their 6th shutout of the season in a 3-0 win over the Tulsa Drillers on Friday night at ONEOK Field. Tink Hence struck out 4 over 2.2 innings and Matt Svanson picked up his 18th save of the season to complete the shutout. Chandler Redmond clubbed his 2nd home run in as many games and Jacob Buchberger drove in his 6th run of the series with an RBI single. Matt Lloyd and Nathan Church each had two hits for Springfield.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Kendall Williams** makes his 20th start of the season for the Drillers...Last start came on Friday, July 28 at Frisco when he allowed 3 ER on 5 H over 4.0 IP with 4 BB and a strikeout...Over 4 starts in themonth of July went 0-2 with a 7.85 ERA...In 3 starts against the Cardinals this season is 1-2 with a 5.27 ERA...Springfield is batting .304 against him...Got the win against the Cardinals in his last start against them at Hammons Field when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H over 5.0 IP...Spent the 2023 season between 4 levels (all but Low-A) and went 4-7 with a 3.73 ERA over 17 appearances (16 starts)...Made 8 starts with the Drillers going 3-3 with a 3.92 ERA...Split the 2022 season between Low-A Rancho Cucamonga and High-A Great Lakes going a combined 3-6 with a 4.32 ERA in 27 appearances (24 starts)...Acquired by the Dodgers in September 2020 from the Blue Jays in exchange for RHP Ross Stripling...Selected by Toronto in the 2nd round (52nd overall) of the 2019 draft out of IMG Academy in Florida...23 years old

**CARDINALS VISIT T-TOWN FOR FINAL TIME IN REGULAR SEASON:** The Cardinals head west to pay their final visit of the 2024 regular season to Tulsa, OK for a six-game series against the Drillers (Double-A, Los Angeles Dodgers) this week. Sprngfield won 4 of 5 in Tulsa in a rain-shortened series from April 30-May 5.



#### **CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD**

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

#### **CARDS' RADIO HOME**



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

**RDAD WARRIDRS:** A quality team away from home all season long, the Cardinals have the best road record in the Texas League at 30-18 (.625). Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.75 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland, and tops in the North Division. Springfield has not lost three straight road games during the 2024 season.

IT'S GETTING HOT IN HERE: After a 1-4 start to the 2nd half of Texas League play, the Cardinals have bounced back and come into play Tuesday as one of the hottest teams in the Texas League. Over their last 26 games since June 30 the Cards are 18-8, tied with the Midland RockHounds for the best record in the Texas League during that time. Springfield has only lost consecutive games once since the beginning of July.

**THANKS FOR THE MEMORIES, JULY:** In a season that's featured plenty of peaks, the Cardinals put together their best month yet in July. With a 16-7 record in the month, Springfield set a season-high for wins in a calendar month surpassing the 15 wins the Cards accumulated in April. The Birds finished July with a 4.30 ERA (4th in the Texas League), and batted .272 for the month while averaging 5.3 runs per game (2nd). Springfield's quality July follows back-to-back months under .500 in May (13-14) and June (11-15).

**POWER SURGE:** While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in power numbers this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles during that same stretch. The Cardinals have clubbed 29 homers over their last 26 games, 2nd-most in the Texas League, and have homered in 4 straight and 17 of their last 20 games. Springfield is 2nd in the league with a .427 SLG and OPS of .774 during that time. During the same stretch the Cards have scored 142 runs (5.5/game), 2nd in the league behind Midland (154).

In the 2nd half, the Cardinals have already hit 34 HR and is on pace for 76. Springfield hit just 37 homers in the first half of the season.

**LOOKING FOR THE BIG HIT:** Over their last 8 games, the Birds are just 10-for-73 (.136) with runners in scoring position. Since coming out of the All-Star Break, Springfield is batting .198 (21-for-106) with RISP.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 25 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher Jimmy Crooks has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. During that time the former Oklahoma Sooner is 4th in the circuit among qualified hitters with a .337 average while adding 6 of his 7 HR this season with 19 RBIs with 4 doubles and a triple. Crooks during that stretch is slugging .607 and has a 1.005 OPS. Among qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, Crooks' .867 OPS and .401 OBP tops in the circuit. He is also 2nd in batting average (.303) behind Bryan Torres and 5th in SLG (.466).

**REDMOND'S JULY:** After breaking the Springfield career home run mark with his 60th on July 12 vs Wichita, **Chandler Redmond** has kept on hitting since the beginning of July. The Cardinals' slugger is batting .345 over the last month-plus with 3 HR and 13 RBIs while adding 4 2B. His 1.056 OPS during that time leads the club. Redmond has homered in back-to-back games and has reached base safely in 12 straight games.

**TAKE ME TO CHURCH:** During his current 18-game on base streak, Cardinals OF **Nathan Church** is batting .309 with 3 HR and 14 RBIs while adding 5 2B and is 6-for-6 in stolen bases. The hot streak is a welcome sign for the Cardinals after Church struggled to the tune of a .174 batting average in June.

**BASH-BERGER:** Since coming out of the All-Star Break, Cardinals 3B **Jacob Buchberger** has also been swinging a hot bat. **Buchberger** over his last 9 games since July 20 is batting .333 with a double, a triple and team-high 3 HR while driving in 8 runs. His OPS during that stretch is 1.201.

**SLAM THE DOOR:** Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 18-for-18 and his 16 saves and 38 appearances lead all of Double-A.

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 14.0 IP (0.60 ERA) and is 8-for-8 in save opportunities. Over his last 12 appearances, **Svanson** has been unscored upon, allowing just 8 H with 11 K over his last 14.0 IP.


